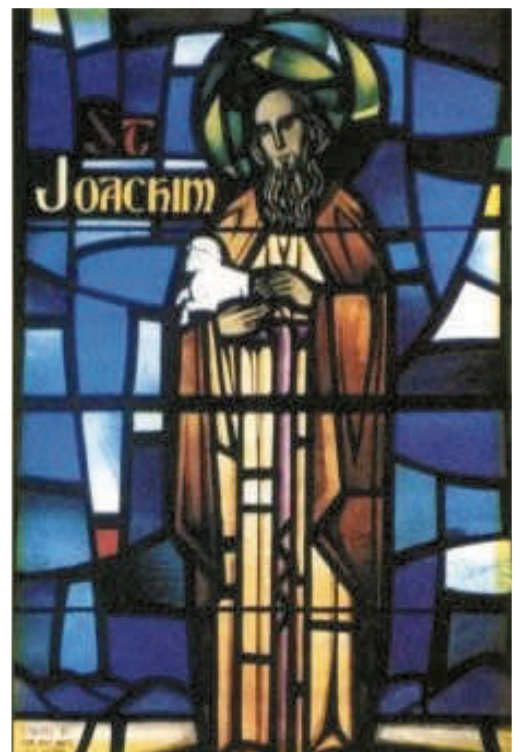

# VOTE “NO” ON PROPOSITION 1

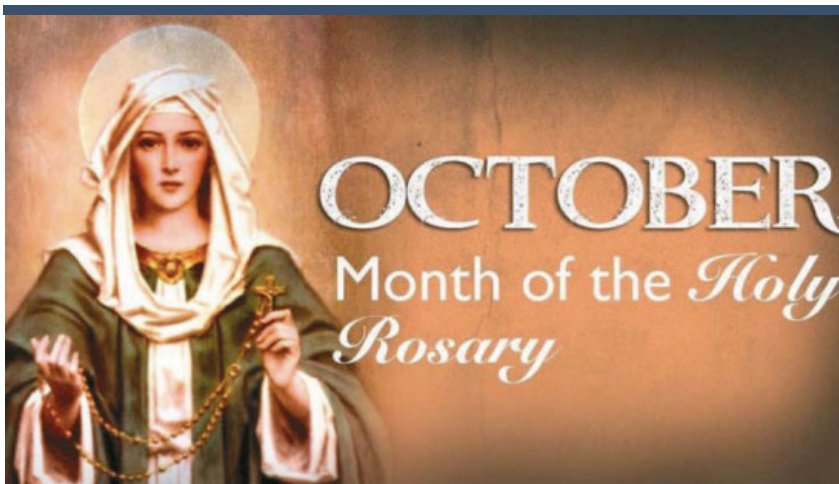

## VATICAN CORNER

On October 2, 2022, Pope Francis did not offer his usual commentary on the day's Gospel reading, instead he begged Russian President Vladimir Putin to "Stop this spiral of violence and death" in the war with Ukraine "for the sake of his people." It was the first time Francis made such a direct appeal to Putin. The Pope's plea was triggered by Putin's announcement on Sept. 30 that Russia is annexing the four parts of Ukraine that Russia is currently occupying. The Pope told the people in St. Peter's Square that the recent actions taken by Russia are contrary to the principles of international law and they increase "the risk of nuclear escalation to the point of fears of uncontrollable and catastrophic consequences worldwide." The Pope also said he was

"saddened by the immense suffering of the Ukrainian people as a result of the aggression" and he appealed to Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy "to be open" to any "serious peace proposals." The Pope also asked world leaders "to do everything in their power to put an end to the ongoing war, without allowing themselves to be drawn into dangerous escalations, and to promote and support initiatives for dialogue." An anonymous European Union official has said that Putin "is totally in a corner, he's crazy... and for him there is no way out. The only way out is total victory or total defeat. The European Union's goal, the official said, is to give Ukraine the military support it needs to continue to push Russia out of Ukrainian territory, while pressuring Russia politically to agree to a cease-fire and withdrawal. Alexander Gabuev, a senior fellow with the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace says the hope has been that Ukrainian successes on the battlefield would force Putin to back down, but instead he is doubling down. We are two or three steps away from Russia failing to achieve its goals and resorting to...the unthinkable." Gabuev said smaller tactical nuclear weapons would be used by Russia after the mobilization of the hundreds of thousands more Russian men, the escalating attacks on civilian targets and the attacks and sabotage on infrastructure all fail to turn the tide of the war in favor of Russia. He believes the U.S. would enter the battlefield directly and respond to such a nuclear attack. Speaking to thousands of people in St. Peter's square, Francis said "in the name of God and in the name of the sense of humanity that dwells in every heart, I renew my call for an immediate ceasefire." He prayed for a negotiated settlement of the conflict, one that is "not imposed by force, but agreed, just and stable." A just solution, he said, "must be based on respect for the sacred value of human life, as well as the sovereignty and territorial integrity of each country, and the rights of minorities and legitimate concerns." 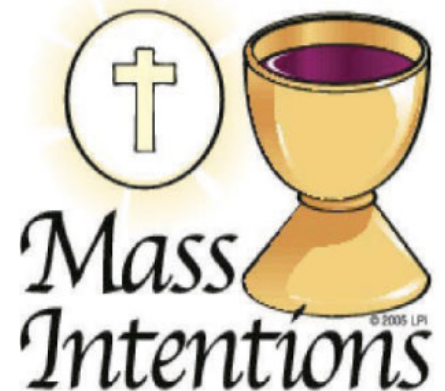

## What is the history of the rosary? Where did this prayer come from?

Answer:

Although a longstanding tradition attributed the rosary to Saint Dominic and the Dominican Order, the practice of using beads to count prayers predates the Dominicans by a few hundred years. In fact, it seems that what we now think of as the rosary (which means “garland of roses”) was first developed by illiterate peasants and religious brothers and sisters as a way of offering 150 “Our Fathers” to replace the praying of the 150 psalms in the Divine Office.

The practice of reciting 150 Hail Marys (which was later subdivided into 15 decades of 10 Hail Marys) arose during the late Middle Ages. Devotion to the rosary began to flourish in the nineteenth century, especially as new devotions to Mary began to spread throughout Europe and the New World. An annual liturgical celebration of Our Lady of the Rosary was introduced into the Church calendar in 1573 and it has been observed on the date of October 7 since 1913.

In the apostolic letter *On the Most Holy Rosary*, Pope Saint John Paul II not only added five new mysteries to the traditional fifteen, but he also reminded Catholics that the rosary is, at its core, an opportunity to go deeper into the life of Jesus: “The rosary, though clearly Marian in character, is at heart a Christocentric prayer ... It has all the depth of the Gospel message in its entirety, of which it can be said to be a compendium. It is an echo of Mary’s prayer, her perennial Magnificat ... With the rosary, the Christian people sit at the school of Mary and are led to contemplate the beauty of the face of Christ and to experience the depths of his love” (no. 1).

## What is the story behind the rosary?

Answer:

The rosary is a sacred and popular Catholic devotion, but its origins are mysterious. Prayer beads to facilitate meditation began in the early ages of the Church. In the early medieval period, bead strings were used to count Hail Marys or Our Fathers. A tradition has developed that the rosary in its current form was given to St. Dominic by the Blessed Mother. However, the earliest biographies of the saint do not include this story. In the Middle Ages, the prayers were grouped into 50 Hail Marys with verses from Psalms and vignettes from the lives of Jesus and Mary. By the 16th century, the Joyful, Sorrowful, and Glorious Mysteries were established.

The rosary rose to prominence in the late 1500s. The Turkish Empire was spreading across eastern Europe, and pirates were raiding Christian ships. The Christian nations of Europe rallied for a great battle at sea. Pope St. Pius V urged all Christians to pray the rosary for victory. While vastly outnumbered, the Christian fleet was victorious at the Battle of Lepanto. The pope established October 7th as the feast of the Holy Rosary. Later, all of October would come to be known as the Month of the Rosary.

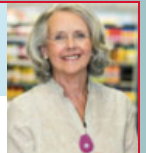
