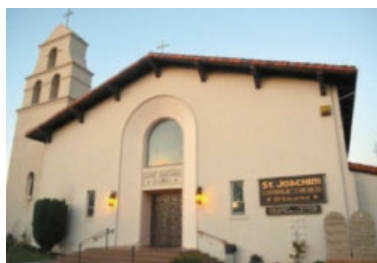

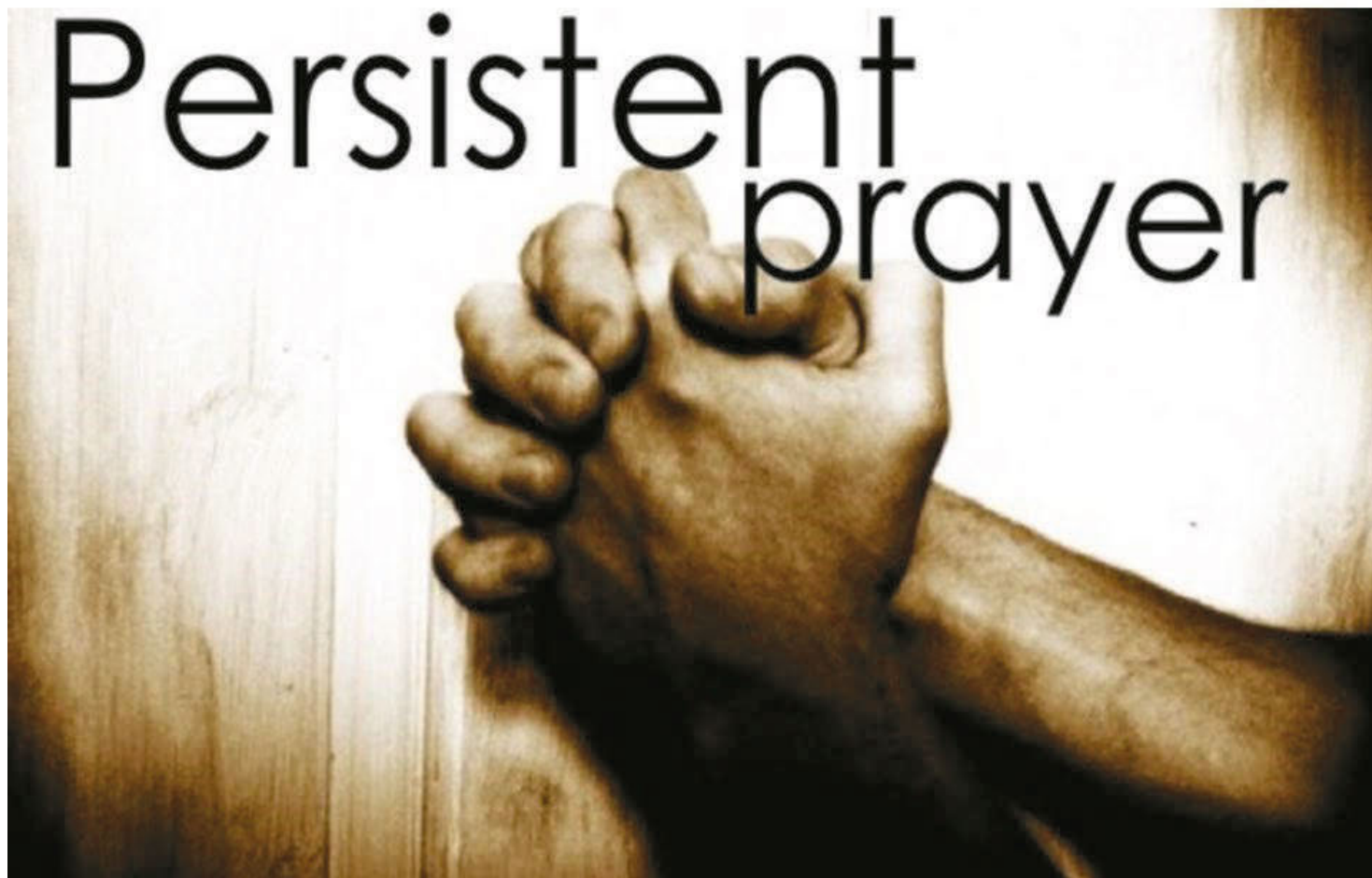

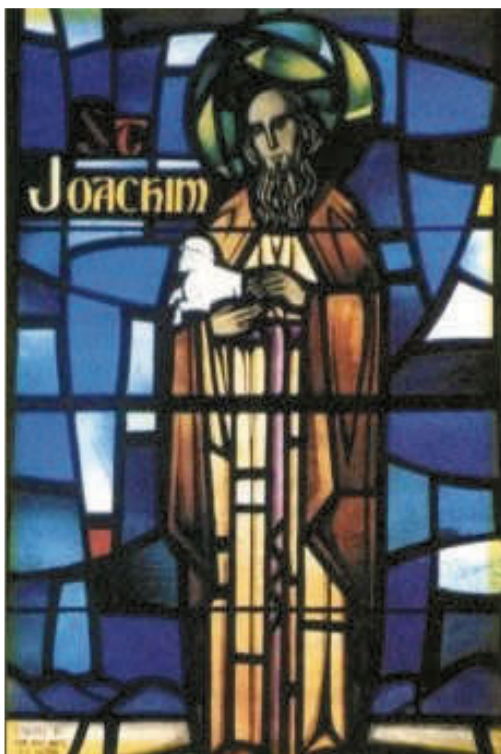

VOTE “NO” ON PROPOSITION 1

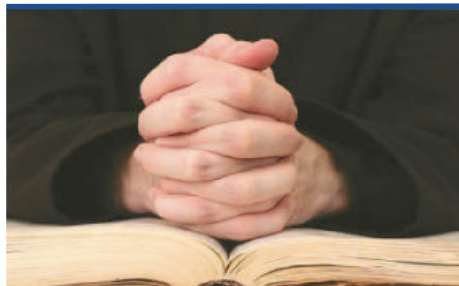

VATICAN CORNER

Most of the powerful popes during the Renaissance period were also collectors of classical Greek and Roman sculptures, and each new pope in the 16th century was anxious to add to the Vatican's collection, even if the subject matter was pagan rather than Christian. The main characteristic of classical sculpture is that it consists of free standing human forms. The ancient marble statues that were collected at the Vatican had enormous influence on the evolution of art in the Renaissance Period. Many artists like Michelangelo and Raphael came to Rome to study those sculptures. The majority of those statues are kept today in the Vatican's Octagonal Courtyard a beautiful sculpture –garden founded by Pope Julius II in the early 1500s. The Laocoön is one of those statues and it is an incredibly dramatic



depiction of Greek mythology showing a Trojan priest (Laocoön) and his two sons battling against divinely sent sea-snakes during the Greek-Trojan war. The muscular priest is twisting in agony as a sea-snake tears at his naked flesh and has wrapped itself around him. The two young boys are also ensnared in snake coils and none of the three can free themselves. The scene being depicted is from the story of the Trojan War where Helen, 'the most beautiful woman in the world', was carried off from her native Sparta to the city of Troy by the love-struck Paris. The Greeks attack Troy to rescue Helen but could not penetrate its protective walls. They build a massive wooden horse as a peace offering but hide their soldiers inside. The wooden horse was brought into the city through the protective walls and all the Trojans were fooled into thinking it was a peace-offering, except for one Trojan priest Laocoön who tries to warn his comrades with the famous phrase: 'I fear Greeks, even those bearing gifts.' The gods on mount Olympus were supporting the Greeks in the war and therefor they had Poseidon send sea-snakes to kill the priest and his sons in order to stop them from warning about the wooden horse. The Laocoön statue was re-discovered buried in a muddy Roman vineyard in 1506, and a bidding war between wealthy Roman collectors broke out. However Pope Julius II decided he wanted it. The extremely heavy marble statue was then dragged through the city to the Vatican. The classical writer Pliny described the statue as one of the ancient world's greatest statues because of its portrayal of psychological intensity. He attributed three sculptors as the creators: Agesander, Polydorus, and Athenodorus. The Renaissance sculptors including Donatello, Michelangelo, and Bernini studied the Laocoön and how human emotions could be portrayed in a cold unfeeling stone. They went on to create their own great marble works showing love and hate, hope and despair. The statue Laocoön is a tremendous achievement, was very influential, and a must-see at the Vatican Museum.
