## VATICAN CORNER

The word “sentience” means having the capacity to

experience feelings and sensations, and the ability to be self-aware. Sentience appears in humans at a certain stage of growth as the brain develops. It is also something that can be lost from a brain injury. Sentient animals include fish and other vertebrates, as well as some mollusks and crustaceans. Since the 1950, research scientists have been working on creating artificial intelligence (AI) trying to make it possible for machines to learn from experience, adjust to new inputs, and perform human-like tasks such as problem-solving and thus simulating human intelligence. Machines can now draw on billions and billions of words written by human beings to produce responses to questions given them. In June of

2022, an engineer at Google announced that their artificial intelligence system called Language Model for Dialogue Applications (LaMDA) may have developed sentience. However Google itself disagreed saying their system merely “feel” like real human respondents and is not sentient artificial intelligence. You may be surprised to learn how often the Catholic Church and the Pope have spoken on the subject of artificial intelligence in recent years. In December 2016, the Pontifical Academy of Science organized a conference on “Power and Limitations of Artificial Intelligence.” In March of 2018 the Academy held a workshop on “Artificial Intelligence and Democracy”. In May 2019, the Academy held a 2-day conference on “Robotics, Artificial Intelligence and Humanity: Science, Ethics and Policy”. In the spring of 2020, the Pontifical Academy for Life as well as technology giants Microsoft and IBM signed a declaration calling for the ethical and responsible use of AI. The declaration included six ethical principles that should guide the development of AI. They are: Transparency, Inclusion, Accountability, Impartiality, Reliability, and Security – Privacy. In November 2020, Pope Francis invited Catholics around the world as part of his monthly prayer intention, to pray that robotics and artificial intelligence remain always at the service of human beings – rather than the other way around. .”In 2021 at the UN conference on conventional weapons, the Vatican urged for the international community to step up efforts for a legally binding document to address the legal and ethical issues raised by Lethal Autonomous Weapons Systems (LAWS). These are weapons like “swarms of ‘kamikaze’ mini drones” and other advanced weaponry using artificial intelligence. The Vatican said that “The use of swarms in urban areas could lead to high risks for civilians if functioning without any direct human supervision, and such systems could make mistakes in identifying the intended target.” They said lethal autonomous weapon systems, “equipped with self-learning or self programmable capabilities... could ‘deviate’ into actions targeting non-combatants in order to maximize efficiency.” The 2020 Vatican sponsored declaration quoted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights in stating the equal dignity and rights of all humans, which AI must protect and guarantee, while calling equally for the “benefit of humanity and the environment. But what about the flip side? What about the potential dignity and worth of the AI itself, if it comes to identify itself as a sentient being? The Catholic Church may have to think about that question sometime in the future. 

# VOTE “NO” ON PROPOSITION 1
