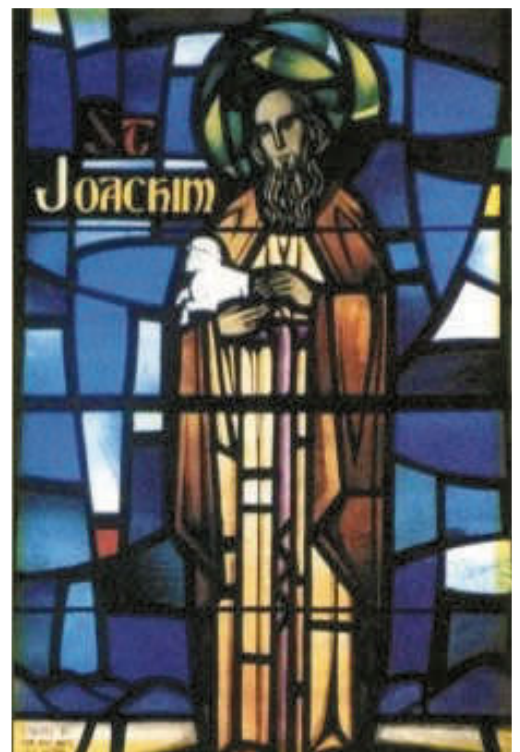

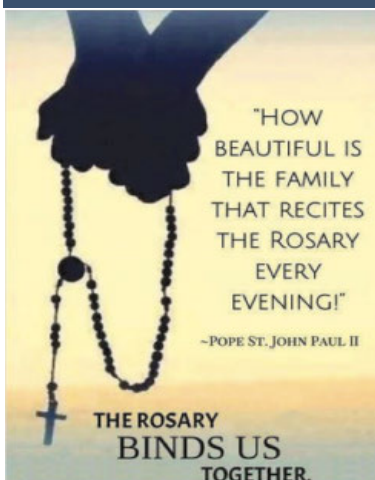

VATICAN CORNER

Pope Francis is the first pope to visit the island country of Bahrain, located on the Persian Gulf. At the invitation of King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, Francis made his 39th journey abroad since becoming Pope, and came to Bahrain Nov. 3-6, 2022. The country is comprised of 50 natural island and 33 artificial ones, centered on Bahrain Island and is the third-smallest nation in Asia. The county has a 70% Muslim population which is split between Sunni and Shi'ite Muslims. It is one of the most accommodating countries for non-Muslims in the region, and has 161,000 Catholics, of which many are foreign workers from the Philippines, India, Pakistan, and other South Asian countries.

Bahrain has two Catholic churches including a modern cathedral and there are 20 Catholic priests. Many Catholics visit Bahrain from neighboring Saudi Arabia, which bars public worship by non-Muslims. Some Catholic families in Saudi Arabia can only attend private Masses in their apartments. Pope Francis instructed the Catholic bishops, priests and nuns in Bahrain to remain united as they ministered to the faithful. He told local Catholic leaders to avoid factions, quarrels and gossip. He said "worldly divisions, but also ethnic, cultural and ritual differences, cannot injure or compromise the unity of the Spirit." The Pope's visit was intended to continue his policy of improving ties with the Islamic world. He spoke with the King Hamad and Sheikh Admad al-Tayyeb, Grand Imam of Egypt's Al-Azhar mosque and university who was also in Bahrain. He talked about the tensions between Bahrain's two Muslim groups, stressed human rights, spoke against the death penalty and called for "ensuring respect and concern for all those who feel most at the margins of society, such as immigrant and prisoners." There was a small protest along the Pope's motorcade route which was brought to an end by the police. Because of Francis' knee ailment, he was forced to use a wheelchair during the trip. At an East-West dialogue meeting the Pope talked of the role of religions in promoting peace and disarmament. About 30,000 people crowded into a soccer stadium to attend the first public papal Mass in Bahrain. Two thousand – nine hundred registered attendees of the Mass had traveled from Saudi Arabia. There were many worshippers from Lebanon who applauded when a prayer was said for their war-torn country. Bishop Paul Hinder the Apostolic Vicariate of Northern Arabia thanked Pope Francis for showing "pastoral care for a tiny Church in a tiny county." The bishop said: "Like your patron Saint Francis of Assisi, you are not afraid to build bridges with the Muslim world and to show your fraternal closeness to all people of goodwill regardless of their cultural background and religious belief." "We Christians in the Middle East – those of ancient Oriental tradition and those who as migrants temporarily live in this part of the world – try to implement the invitation of Saint Francis to his brothers to 'live spiritually among the Muslims ... not to engage in arguments and [simply] to acknowledge that [we] are Christians.'" Pope Francis thanked all those who traveled to the Mass and said "May the Blessed Virgin, Our Lady of Arabia, accompany you on your journey and preserve you constantly in love towards all."
