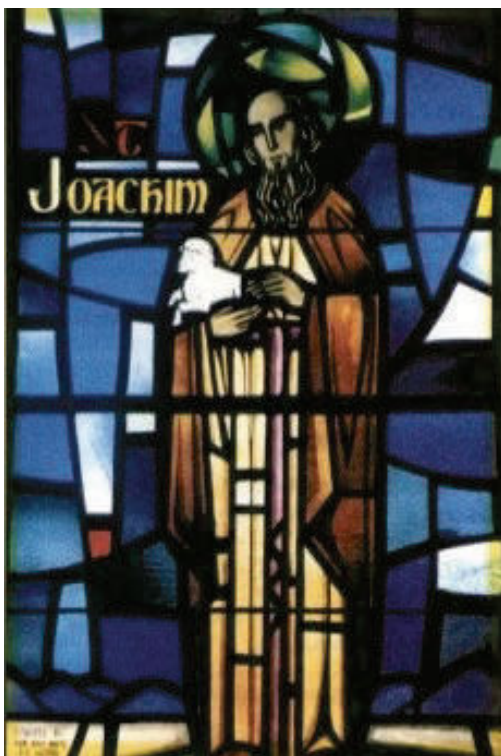

## The History of the Advent Wreath

The Catholic church adopted this tradition during the Middle Ages, as a way to prepare the hearts and minds for Christmas. The word advent itself comes from the Latin word "adventus" meaning "arrival." We prepare for the arrival of Christ. The wreath itself represents eternity and everlasting life, a circle that never ends (John 3:16).

Some have traced the origin of Advent as far back as the 4th or 5th century, but most would agree that the advent we've come to know now, symbols and all, started from the Middle Ages onward to the 1800s.



## La historia de la corona de adviento

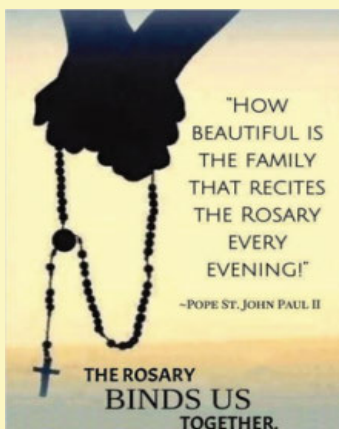


## VATICAN CORNER

Pope Francis answered more of the reporter's questions while returning from his trip to Bahrain on a Gulf Air Boeing 787, on Nov. 6, 2022. A reporter asked the Pope if canonical penalties should be made public. His question was referring to the recent discovery that in 2021 a French bishop was found guilty of committing sexual abuse in the 1990s as a priest, but his conviction was kept secret by the Church. Pope Francis said "the problem of abuse has always been there, not only in the Church but everywhere. You know that 42-46% of sexual abuse takes place in the family or in the community. This is very serious, but the habit has always been that of covering up. ... An ugly habit that began to change in the Church when a scandal surfaced in Boston at the time of Cardinal Law, who, because of the scandal, resigned. ... Since then the Church has become aware of this and has begun to work, whereas in society and other institutions it is normally covered up. ... Some say we are a small minority, but [I say] even if it were a single case, it would still be tragic. ... Before the scandal in Boston, people were substituted [priest were moved], now everything is transparent and we are moving forward on this, that is why we should not be surprised that cases like this come to light. ... I want to publicly thank the heroism of Cardinal O'Malley, a good Capuchin friar, who sensed the need to institutionalize this with the Commission for the Protection of Minors that he is heading. ... I believe that the Church cannot be 'shameless.' It has to be ashamed of the bad things, as well as [saying] thank you to God for the good things it does." A reporter from Germany asked "is there anything to learn from this small flock we saw in Bahrain for the great Germany? Francis said Germany has a great and beautiful Evangelical Church; I do not want another one, which will not be as good as that one; but I want a Catholic [one], in fraternity with the Evangelical. ... Now we get into ethical discussions, into contingent discussions, but the root of religion is the slap in the face that the Gospel gives you, the encounter with the living Jesus Christ: and from there the consequences [follow], all of them; from there you get the apostolic courage to go to the peripheries, even to the moral peripheries of people to help; but [it starts] from the encounter with Jesus Christ. If there is no encounter with Jesus Christ, there will be an ethicism disguised as Christianity. When Pope Francis arrived back in Rome, he visited Rome's Marian Basilica of St. Mary Major and stayed a little while giving thanks to Our Lady for her maternal protection. He prayed at the feet of the ancient Byzantine icon of Maria Salus Populi Romani (Salvation of the Roman Peoples). It is a 5 feet high by 3 ¾ feet wide painting of Madonna and Child Jesus. Many of the faithful believe the image was painted by Saint Luke who used as his canvas the tabletop of a table Christ himself had built when working in his foster father- Saint Joseph's carpenter shop. In 590 AD, Pope Gregory the Great welcomed the image from Crete. In 1838, Pope Gregory XVI crowned the icon and Pope Pius XII did the same in 1954. The image has been overpainted many times through the centuries and in 2018, the Vatican Museums cleaned and restored the ancient icon. It is a Vatican custom that the pope visits the icon before and after his Apostolic trips to spend some time with the Blessed Mother in prayer.

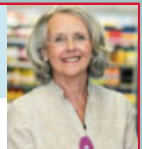
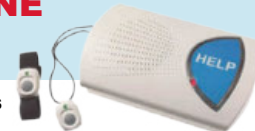
