



VATICAN CORNER Jozef Ulma and Wiktoria, his 7 months pregnant

wife and their six young children lived at the outskirts of Markowa, a small rural village in southeast Poland in 1944. Jozef was a farmer with skills in photography which he used to document his family and life. The Ulmas were deeply religious and were active members of their parish. With the occupation of Poland by the Germans and the Nazi regime, Jews became a primary target. Most of the 30 Jewish families in the village were taken out of their homes, shot and buried in a former animal burial ground. Only those that hid in the homes of local farmers managed to survive. It was common for Poles to be indifferent and hostile to Jews, and searches for hiding Jews were conducted both by the



Germans and by Polish peasants. But some Poles chose to help their former Jewish neighbors, even though hiding Jews was punishable by death. It is thought that God's commandment of love thy neighbor, was the reason why the Ulmas decided to help. Eight members of the Jewish family "Szall" came to the village looking for shelter and they found safe haven in the Ulma's family house. According to a neighbor, the Jewish Szall family did not hide, but instead helped run the farm. It is not certain how the Germans soon discovered the presence of the Szall family, but it is thought that a policeman knew of the Szall family's whereabouts, because he had helped them previously in return for money. He was holding their belongings and when the Szall's wanted them back, he turned them into the Germans. On March 24,1944, the German police first killed all eight of the Jewish Szall family and then as a warning to others, also killed the Ulmas family: father, mother, the six young children and the one unborn. As a result there was an enormous panic among the other Polish peasants who were hiding Jews. Some peasants killed the Jews they had been hiding, but others continued to shelter them. As a result of this tragedy, the Ulma family has become a symbol of Polish sacrifice and martyrdom during the German occupation. In 1995 Józef and Wiktoria Ulma were posthumously awarded the Righteous Among the Nations Medal by Israel's Yad Vashem, and were among the 7,000 other Poles so honored, more than any other national group. In 2003, the Ulmas were included with 122 Polish martyrs whose beatification (sainthood) process was begun. Documents were sent to the Vatican. In 2010, the Ulmas were posthumously given an award by the Polish president. In 2017, the Congregation for the Causes of Saints deciding to take the case of the Ulmas separately from the others and in 2018, Pope Francis hailed the Ulmas as "an example of faithfulness to God and his commandments, of love for neighbor and of respect for human dignity." In 2013, construction began on a museum in Markowa dedicated to Poles who saved Jews during WWII. The museum was named after the Ulmas and opened in 2016. In 2018, Poland's parliament established a National Day of Remembrance for Poles Saving Jews Under the German Occupation and it is held on March 24, the anniversary of the Ulmas' death. Pope Francis on December 17, 2022 recognized the martyrdom of the Ulmas family thereby moving them along the path to officially attaining sainthood. Francis also advanced 15 other cases. The Ulmas' six children and the one unborn child were included as martyrs because of their parent's faith, and it is the first time an entire family has been considered for sainthood.
