



VATICAN CORNER

Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI died

on December 31, 2022 at the Mater Ecclesiae Monastery in Vatican City at the age of 95. The Director of the Press Office of the Holy See, Matteo Bruni made the announcement and said Pope Francis went to see Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI soon after he received the news on Saturday morning. Benedict's personal secretary Archbishop Georg Gänswein reported that a nurse was the only person with Benedict at his passing, and the last words Benedict uttered shortly before his death were "Lord, I love you." Benedict had been pope emeritus since his



resignation in 2013 which was due to his ill health and advanced age. His resignation shocked the Catholic Church when it happened, since no pope had resigned in 600 years. Three days prior to Benedict's passing, Pope Francis had announced deterioration in Benedict's health and asked for the faithful to pray for him. Benedict's death ended the period of nine years when both the current and former pope lived within the Vatican. Benedict's body lay in state on January 2nd through 4th in St. Peter's Basilica where nearly 200,000 mourners paid their respects. About 50,000 people gathered in St. Peter's Square on January 5, 2023 for Benedict's funeral Mass which was presided over by Pope Francis. As per Benedict's wishes, the funeral was a simple one and it was a very solemn occasion. There were more than 4,000 priests, 400 bishops, and at least 120 cardinals attending. There was also tight security with 1,000 Italian security personnel deployed to ensure safety at the event. Because Benedict was no longer a head of state when he died, only two countries Italy and his native Germany, sent official delegations to the funeral. But other world leaders and royals attended in their private capacities. Mourners dressed in black and fog covered the top of the Basilica. The ceremony began with a prayer from Pope Francis for Benedict, and readings were in Spanish, English and Latin. Hymns were sung by the Sistine Chapel Choir including Psalms 23 and Hallelujah. Pope Francis honored Benedict in his homily, but did not dwell on his legacy. Prayers were also in German, French, Arabic, Portuguese and Italian. Francis placed his hand on the coffin as it was being carried into St. Peter's Basilica and the crowd cheered and applauded. In the Basilica the plain cypress coffin containing Benedict's body was encased in zinc before being sealed in a second wooden casket. At his request, Benedict was buried in the crypt under the basilica alongside his predecessors and where John XXIII and John Paul II were interred before their remains were transferred to more prominent places in the basilica above. Like his predecessor Pope John Paul II, Pope Emeritus Benedict left behind a spiritual testament apologizing to "anyone I have wronged in any way." He thanked his father, for his "lucid faith" that taught his children to believe; his brother, also a priest, for his judgment and guidance, and his sister, who took care of him for decades. 

May your Son welcome him into eternal glory.


May your servant whom you appointed high
