Sometimes we mistake stillness with vulnerability. But Christ shows us that to withdraw, to contemplate, can actually be a tremendous show of strength. Even the fiercest dogs wait for the command of their master before they act.

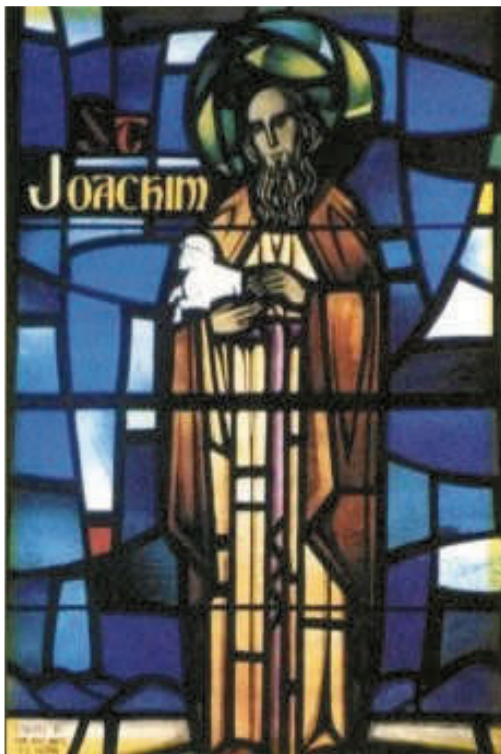

5, 2023. A one page written account of his papacy was rolled up and put in a cylindrical tube and placed inside his coffin. The document written in Latin cited Benedict's theological and papal legacy, including his outreach to Anglicans and Jews and his efforts to combat clerical abuse with his continual calling the church to conversion, prayer, penance and purification. It was under his papacy that the abuse scandals came to light around the world. Also buried with Benedict were coins of his pontificate and his pallium: the long narrow white band adornment made from the wool of lambs. Following the tradition of his predecessors, his body was buried in three coffins that all fit inside one another, with the second metal coffin being welded shut.



Pope Emeritus Benedict was born Joseph Alois Ratzinger in a Bavarian village on April 16, 1927. His father was a policeman and his mother a hotel cook. He was the youngest of three children and he was six years old when the Nazis took power in Germany in 1933. His parents were devoted Catholics who opposed the Nazis regime, and Germany at that time became fiercely hostile to the Catholic Church.. He remembered seeing his parish priest beaten by Nazis before celebrating Holy Mass. Ratzinger entered the seminary in 1939 and in 1941 he was forced to join the Hitler Youth. In 1943 he was drafted into the German military, serving in an antiaircraft unit in Bavaria and then sent to Hungary to set tank traps in 1945. He deserted in April 1945 and was captured by American forces that held him prisoner for a short time. After the war he continued his education in the seminary and was ordained a priest in 1951. He earned his teaching license in 1957 and taught dogma and theology at the school of philosophy and theology in Freising until 1959; University of Bonn from 1959-69; universities in Münster from 1963-66; University of Tübingen (1966-69); and then became vice president of the University of Regensburg. During his academic career he wrote a number of important theological works, and attracted the attention of the archbishop of Cologne, Joseph Frings, who asked Ratzinger to serve as his expert assistant at the Second Vatican Council (1962-65). Ratzinger opposed those at the Council who hoped to limit reform. He contributed to a criticism document which eventually lead to reorganization and creation of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith by Pope Paul VI. He was named archbishop of Munich and Freising in 1977, the same year he became a cardinal. In 1981, he was made prefect of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith by his friend Pope John Paul II and for more than two decades, Ratzinger was the Pope's closest adviser, and was responsible for preserving Catholic doctrine by enforcing canon law. Ratzinger earned a reputation as a hard liner, and lead sweeping crackdown on dissent, disciplining theologians in Latin America such as Leonardo Boff in Brazil and Charles Curran in the United States. Despite his reputation of being a theological conservative, critics recognized his ability to discuss controversial matters with an objective and impartial spirit. He was also recognized for his humility and gentleness as well as for his many talents, speaking several languages and being a pianist. *To be continued ...Sources: nbcnews.com, npr.org, britannica.com, vatican.va*
