Emeritus Benedict XVI had an extraordinary ability to convey the deep mysteries of the faith by bringing them down to a level that anyone could understand, and being able to do that because of his great mastery of the subject. He was a very productive writer, with 60 books, important encyclicals, over a thousand academic articles, many speeches, commentaries and even prayers to his name. He is considered one of the greatest and most faithful theologians in the history of the Church. As a professor of theology, he was so gifted that his doctoral students formed a group to honor him and celebrate their experience. Many of the faithful believe that Benedict could become another Doctor of the Church. It is a title given by the Church to those recognized as having made a significant contribution to theology or doctrine through their research, study or writing. Throughout Church history there have been just 37 saints named Doctors of the Church, four women, and 33, men, of which two were popes. Traditionally, the title has been granted on the basis of three requirements: being a canonized saint, leaving behind a significant and lasting contribution to the life of the Church, and having a formal declaration made, usually by a pope. Benedict himself understood those requirements for he named two Doctors of the Church while pope. In 2012: he named the 12th century abbess and mystic St. Hildegard of Bingen and named the 16th-century priest St. John of Ávila. Clearly Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI has met the one requirement, with his body of work. Only time will tell if he will be canonized and be given the Doctor of the Church title. Following his death, global leaders paid respect and honored Benedict with their words. Justin Welby, the Archbishop of Canterbury and head of the Church of England said "Pope Benedict was one of the greatest theologians of his age – committed to the faith of the Church and stalwart in its defense." Cardinal Timothy Dolan, Archbishop of New York, said he will remember him with "love and gratitude". European Parliament President Roberta Metsola said "Europe mourns him. May he rest in peace." Patriarch Kirill the leader of the Russian Orthodox Church said "his Holiness's many years of life marked a whole epoch in the history of the Roman Catholic Church, which he led in a difficult historical period, associated with many external and internal challenges." "Relations between the Russian Orthodox Church and the Roman Catholic Church had ""developed significantly" during Benedict's tenure, in an effort to "overcome the sometimes-painful legacy of the past." The Dalai Lama said "At a time when we are seeing tension in several parts of the world, we can take a lesson from the life of Pope Benedict and do what we can to contribute to religious harmony and global peace." US President Joe Biden said "May his focus on the ministry of charity continue to be an inspiration to us all." Italy's new Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni said "Benedict XVI was a giant of faith and reason. He put his life at the service of the universal Church and spoke, and will continue to speak, to the hearts and minds of men with the spiritual, cultural and intellectual depth of his Magisterium." Russian President Vladimir Putin called Benedict "a staunch defender of traditional Christian values." *To be continued ...*

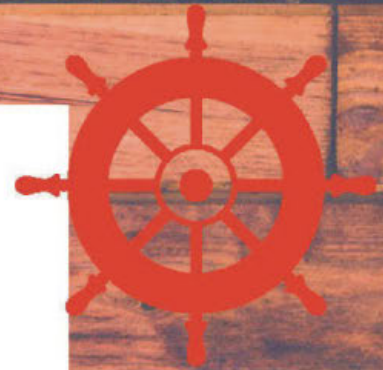
