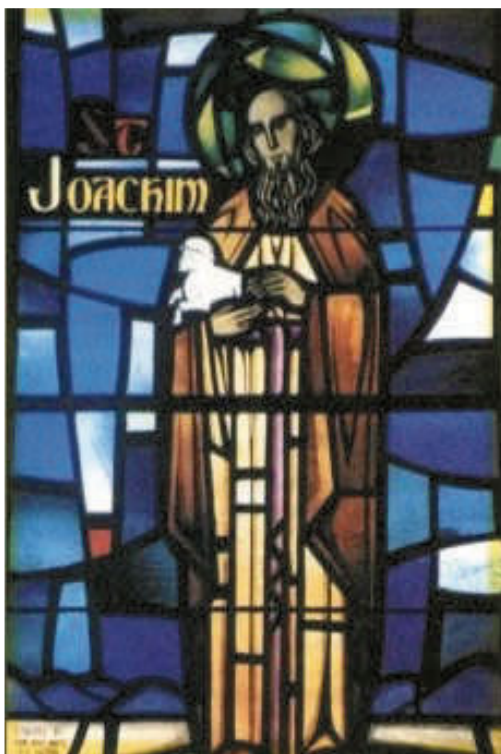

VATICAN CORNER

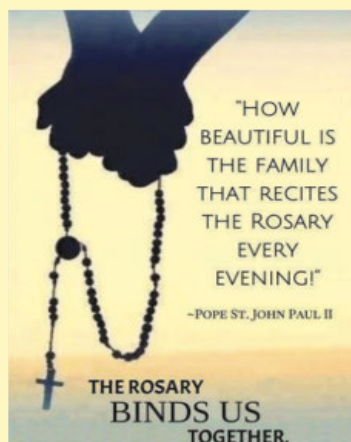
Postponed from last year for health reason,

Pope Francis was finally able to make a six day trip to two African countries. On January 31, 2023 he visited the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) in central Africa, formerly known as the Republic of Zaire. He was greeted by thousands of cheering people waving white flags. Almost half of its 105 million people are Catholics. Violence in eastern DRC has created a severe humanitarian crisis with more than 5.5 million people having been displaced from their homes. The Pope met with President Felix Tshisekedi in front of an audience of authorities, diplomats, and representatives of civil society. He told them that “this country and this continent deserve to be respected and listened to; they deserve to find space and receive attention.”



“Hands off Africa! Stop choking Africa: Africa is not a mine to be stripped or a terrain to be plundered.” “I have greatly desired to be here and now at last I have come to bring you the closeness, the affection, and the consolation of the entire Catholic Church.” Francis said “We cannot grow accustomed to the bloodshed that has marked this country for decades, causing millions of deaths that remain mostly unknown elsewhere.” As you, the Congolese people, fight to preserve your dignity and your territorial integrity against deplorable attempts to fragment the country, I come to you, in the name of Jesus, as a pilgrim of reconciliation and of peace.” “I am here to embrace you and to remind you that you yourselves are of inestimable worth, that the Church and the Pope have confidence in you, and that they believe in your future, the future that is in your hands, your hands.” “The heavenly Father wants us to accept one another as brothers and sisters of a single family and to work for a future together with others, and not against others.” A Mass celebrated by Pope Francis was held at the N’Dolo Airport and around 1 million people attended. The Mass was concelebrated by many cardinals and bishops from Africa. Some people who traveled from far away stayed at the airport all night until the morning Mass the next day. Francis later met with victims of violence from the eastern part of the country. On this trip, the second country Francis visited was the South Sudan in East Africa. He was joined on this trip by the leader of the Anglican Church and by the leader of the Church of Scotland. Back in 2019, Justin Welby the leader of the Anglican Church had proposed a retreat to Pope Francis, and it was held at the Vatican, where opposing leaders from South Sudan had been brought together for 24 hours of prayer and preaching in the attempt to heal their bitter division. President Salva Kiir and Riek Machar, his former deputy, who became the rebel leader, had signed a commitment to an armistice and to form a new unified government. Back then, Pope Francis said “I am asking you with my heart, let us go forward. There will be many problems but they will not overcome us. Resolve your problems.” The two leaders were stunned when the then 82 year old Francis, who suffers from chronic leg pain, was helped by his aides to kneel and kiss their shoes. *To be continued ...*

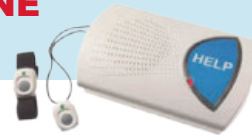
