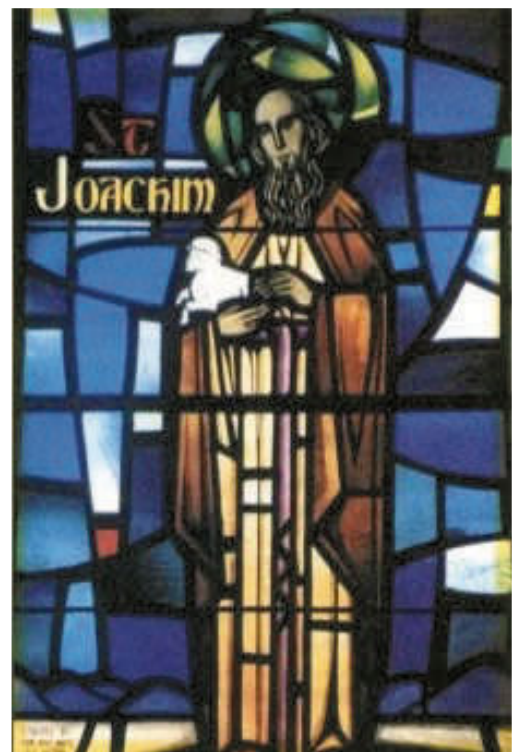

VATICAN CORNER

The Vatican office known as the Fabric of Saint Peter is responsible for the conservation and maintenance of St. Peter's Basilica. That office has existed under various names since 1523. In addition to conservation and maintenance, it has the duty of carefully watching over the Basilica's sacred character, organizing visitors to the Basilica, and managing all the staff who work there. Beginning in 2019, the office has been supervising a massive four-year long project to clean and examine the stones of the majestic dome. The main purpose of the work is to delay the degradation of the structure over time, and any interventions used must be distinctive and reversible, as modern restoration work requires. A survey was performed using a laser scanner to better understand the complex architectural structure designed by Michelangelo and Giacomo Della Porta. Also there was a study made of stone fragments, stucco-work, the



different types of chemical, physical and mechanical deterioration found, and a study of the alteration work made in the past. The lightning protection system for the Basilica was also revised. In 2020 Pope Francis commissioned an investigation of the office of the Fabric of Saint Peter after the Auditor General found some dubious contracts relating to the renovation of St. Peter's dome. Irregularities appeared on invoices from service providing companies. What was found was double billing, and billing for work not in the contracts. The promoter of justice at the Vatican City State Court seized documents and computer equipment from the Fabric's headquarters searching for fraud. Pope Francis finally decided to remove Cardinal Comastri from the management of the Fabric. In March 2021 the commission overseeing the reform of the office of the Fabric, updated laws, reorganized the administration, and a new leader was selected - Mauro Gambetti, a 55 year old Franciscan friar elevated to Cardinal in 2020 was made the president of the Fabric of St. Peter. In January, 2023, the Fratelli Tutti Foundation - the new foundation promoting spirituality, art, formation, and dialogue around St. Peter's Basilica, in collaboration with the office of the Fabric of Saint Peter set up a course of technical and artistic training for young people in order to restart the centuries-old tradition of transmitting practical know-how from the master craftsmen of the Fabrics of St. Peter. Beginning 250 years ago, young apprentices were trained with the highly specialized skills necessary to service the Vatican Basilica. In the 18th century the training school was called the "Factory" and was free and open at night, mornings and on holidays for young artisans. The present day collaboration of the Fratelli Tutti Foundation and the Fabric of St. Peter resulted in a new "School of Arts and Trades", which is now training future stonemasons, carpenters, and marble craftsmen, starting with twelve young men and eight young women coming from Italy, Peru, Germany and Belarus. The students reside at the "Villa Aurellia" residence run by the Dehonian Fathers for the six-month course. The teaching activities consist in cycles of lectures, seminars, guided tours, and study visits to various locations throughout Italy. The course objectives include the professional and personal growth of the young artisans and the development of manual skills, along with formation in art history. The students receive a full immersion in the technical and spiritual details of St. Peter's Basilica. The school is free, and candidates are selected through a test and an individual interview. The students that are admitted are those with backgrounds in technical/ artistic education and who are highly motivated to train in ancient trades, which today seem unattractive to many of their peers. The training started up once more will transmit the necessary conservation skills needed by such a unique building as the Basilica. 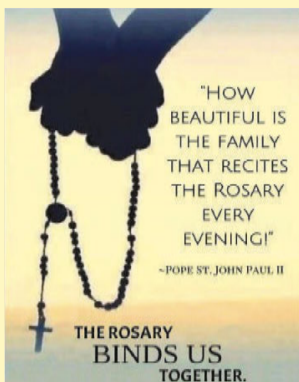

Daily Faith

Question:

What can I do to help our family practice our faith each day?

Answer:

Some families practice their religion together as just another event on their schedule: go to church, observe Lent, help at the parish picnic, go to a meeting, volunteer time, make your confession, use your envelope... But the focus needs to be on who we are—God’s people, in relationship with him, loved, forgiven, and redeemed, and called to live and proclaim the Gospel. Our awareness of God’s presence and our sense of mission are supported by the daily rituals, celebrations, and traditions that help us stay focused. Sharing our faith strengthens us and clarifies the beliefs and values of Christian living.

Daily family practices include time for prayer—before meals, before bed, before important meetings and activities. Attend Sunday Mass together and discuss the homily afterward. Create family celebrations for holy days and holidays. Make religion a regular part of your discussions. Include others, especially the elderly and the less fortunate, in your activities and charitable efforts. By applying the virtues of faith, hope, and love to each day, faith becomes part of who your family is. It influences how you act towards others, what you value, and how mindful of God you are. Faith is the leaven of life that helps all of us rise to our calling and dignity as God’s people.

Pregunta:

¿Qué puedo hacer para ayudar a nuestra familia a practicar nuestra fe todos los días?

Respuesta:

Algunas familias practican la religión juntos como un evento más en su agenda: ir a la iglesia, practicar la Cuaresma, ayudar en el picnic de la parroquia, ir a una reunión, ser voluntario, hacer su confesión, usar su sobre de donación....Pero el enfoque debe ser en lo que somos: el pueblo de Dios, en relación con él, amado, perdonado y redimido, y llamado a vivir y proclamar el Evangelio. Nuestra conciencia de la presencia de Dios y nuestro sentido de misión están respaldados por los rituales, las celebraciones y las tradiciones diarias que nos ayudan a mantenernos enfocados. Compartir nuestra fe nos fortalece y aclara las creencias y valores de la vida cristiana.

Las prácticas familiares diarias incluyen tiempo para la oración: antes de las comidas, antes de acostarse, antes de las reuniones y actividades importantes. Asistir juntos a misa dominical y discutir la homilía después. Participar tener celebraciones familiares para días festivos. Hagan de la religión una parte regular de sus discusiones. Incluyan a otros, especialmente a los abuelitos y los menos afortunados, en sus actividades y esfuerzos caritativos. Al aplicar las virtudes de la fe, la esperanza y el amor a cada día, la fe se convierte en parte de lo que es su familia. Influye en cómo actúen hacia los demás, lo que valoran y qué tan consciente eres de Dios. La fe es la levadura de vida que nos ayuda a todos a elevarnos a nuestro llamado y dignidad como pueblo de Dios.
