





The Easter Triduum

Easter Triduum is a term used by the Roman Catholic Church to denote the three days from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. The Triduum begins with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper and ends after evening prayers at sunset on Easter Day.


The term was used at the Second Vatican Council, when the revised liturgical calendar set the final part of Holy Week apart from Lent proper. Previously, these three days had already gained distinction from the rest of Holy Week with an observance of silence, which were also known as "the still days"

their ticket entry time for the Vatican Museum, or those who have finished their tour and are looking for something else to do at the Vatican, will soon have a Biblical miniature golf course to wander through and play. The golf course was the idea of the Papal Ministry of Education and Bishop Bogey Sebastian. Sponsorship of the construction is by the Italian Federation of the Nightingales of Columbus. The course is



located on the west side of the Museum in the old gardens around the Villa of Pius IV. Each of the 18 holes of golf recreate a different story from the Old Testament. The first hole is the Garden of Eden with a real apple tree blocking a clear path to the hole. There is a hole about Jonah and the Whale where the ball must roll into the Whale's blowhole where it is then launched out of Whale's mouth after a short delay. There is the Noah's Ark hole where you must follow the golfing instructions precisely or your ball will be lost into the water with a big penalty. You must weave your ball around the tablets of the Ten Commandments, bounce your ball over the burning bush, and pass your ball through the legs of David and Goliath, just to mention a few of the changeling holes. There is an outdoor computer monitor at the front of each hole to explain the hole's connection with a Bible story, and the text can be displayed in 167 different languages. Bishop Sebastian said that his hope is that players will learn or recall those Bible stories recreated on the course and that players will be encouraged to read more of the Bible, and learn more about the Catholic religion. If the first miniature golf course is a success, then a second 18-hole course will be constructed based on stories from the New Testament.

You and your fiancé have been able to get permission for a Vatican wedding. You have the date and time set and you are now making a guest list. You get the idea to ask Pope Francis to come to the wedding, but of course, that would be impossible, right? The Pope is a very busy guy, and he has many demands on his time. Well, a new Vatican ministry has been set up to help relieve some of that time pressure and make it easier for him to attend more events that he would like to attend using technology. The new Papal Ministry is called Papal Telepresence, and it will hopefully enable the Pope to attend events that he would normally miss because of scheduling conflicts, large travel distances, or other difficulties. Telepresence robots will be



used to replicate his presence at events using real-time audio/video and 100% remote control by the Pope. He will be able to see, hear, talk, and move just as if he was physically there. Among many other things, Francis can give speeches, shaking hands, wink, write, arm wrestle, dance, whisper, and talk with his hands like an Italian. The Ministry's initial purchase was for 3 of the latest model Luigi#5 robots from Boston Dioramics, USA. The plan is to buy 3 more robots soon. It might be possible someday that you could find Pope Francis in Kiev talking with President Zelensky through a robot, and also at a conference of bishops in Argentina with a robot, and also be a guest at your Vatican wedding with a robot, while he is home at his residence getting ready for bed.
