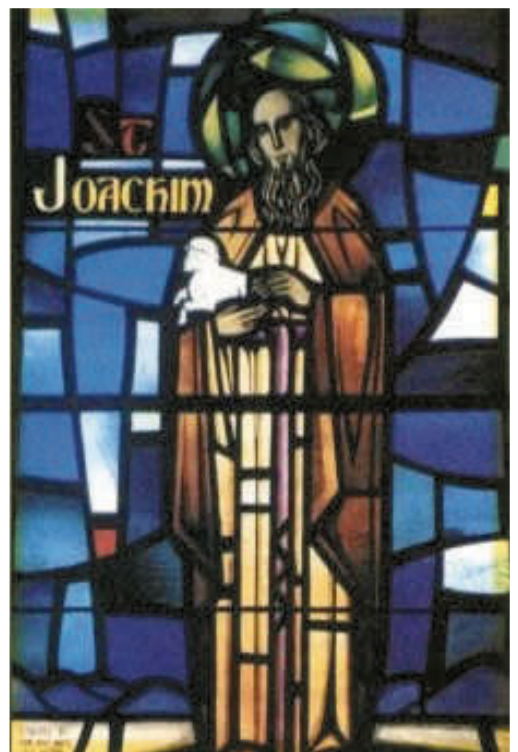

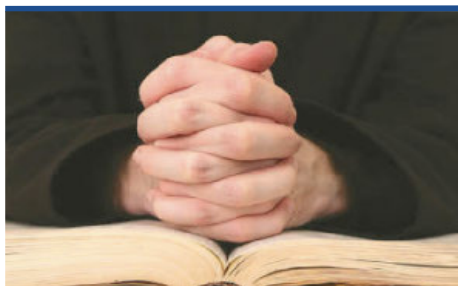

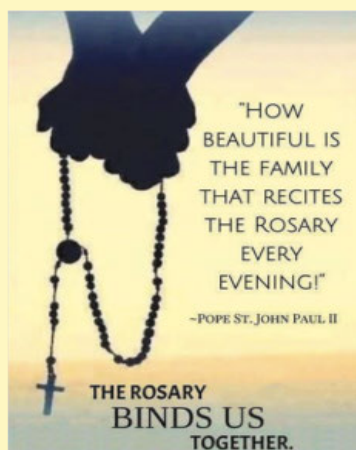

## VATICAN CORNER

Throughout the month of May 2023, the Vatican is offering a special Marian tour to let pilgrims and tourists discover the many images of the Virgin Mary scattered within the Vatican Gardens. Every Wednesday from May 3, thru May 31 and every Saturday visitors will be able to explore the artistic images of the Blessed Mother in the Pope's Gardens. The Gardens over the centuries are where the Popes would take moments of rest, contemplation, and pray, and have images of the Virgin Mary to honor. Today the Gardens are also open to the public for visits. There are numerous Madonna's from all around the world placed along the trails, with the oldest being Our Lady of Lourdes, a copy of the original French statue, and the newest being from Latin America. Our Lady of Fatima and our Lady of Guadalupe are among the statues, and those two Madonna's are the most dear to Pope Francis himself. Guided tours will be conducted in Italian and English and are fully accessible by the disabled. Tickets are found at [education.musei@scv.va](mailto:education.musei@scv.va).

In the Catholic Church the month of May is Mary's month. It's the month we honor Blessed Mary as the Mother of Jesus and our Heavenly Mother. Historians are not exactly sure why the month of May was selected to honor Mary, but many believe that May being the month when spring is in full bloom has much to do with it. The month of May in the northern hemisphere is the height of spring-gardens with blooming flowers and new leaves on trees. Nature's new beginning and new birth reminds us of the life Mary gave to Jesus. When nature is showing new life in May it is the ideal time to honor the woman who gave life to our Savior, whose life, death, and resurrection would not have happened without Mary giving birth to Jesus. The custom of dedicating the month of May to Mary dates back to the 13th century, but it wasn't until the 18th century when this practice became popular. The Jesuit Order in Rome followed the practice and it spread because of the far reach of the order's schools. The devotion took hold by the 1700's and began to spread worldwide. It is a Catholic tradition to honor Mary during the month of May by crowning her statue with flowers. Pope Paul VI explained best the reason for doing this by writing in 1965 that May is an occasion for a "moving tribute of faith and love which Catholics in every part of the world pay to the Queen of Heaven." The crown symbol is attributed to Mary because she is the Mother of the Son of God, who is our Heavenly King. Also the May Crowning custom is a reminder to the faithful to strive to imitate our Blessed Mother's virtue in our own lives. The crowning doesn't just have to be a "church" thing, we can do the same in our homes, participating more fully in the life of the Church. A statue of Mary in a special prayer spot in your home designated for God can receive a crown, because Mary is Mother, your mother, my mother, everyone's mother, and because she cares for all of us day-in-and-day-out without fail, interceding for us in even the tiniest matters to obtain for us God's favor and graces. For that she deserves an entire month in her honor.

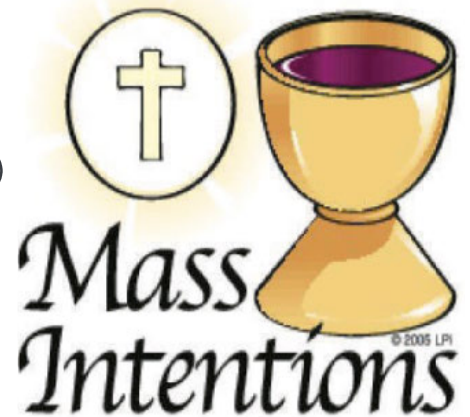
