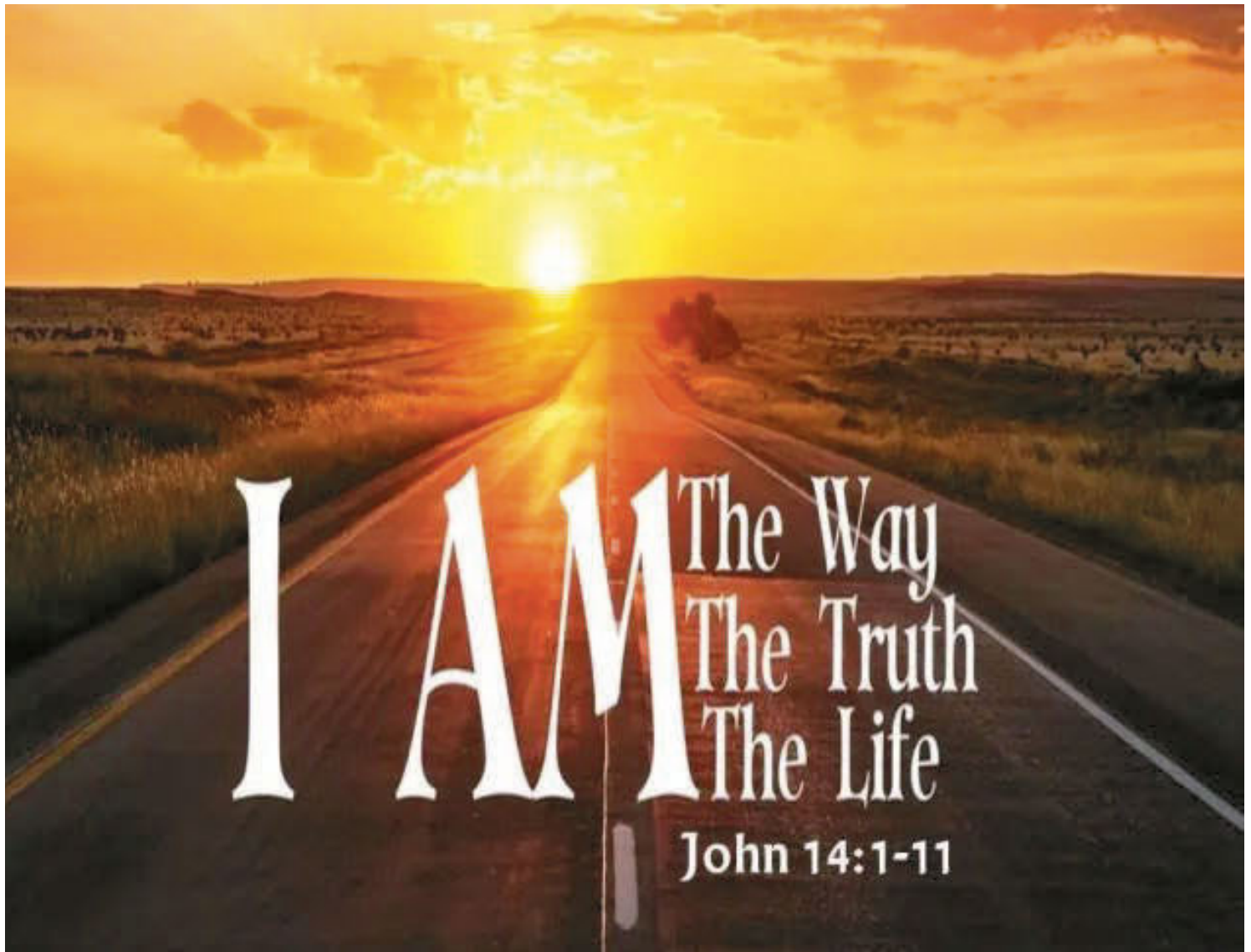

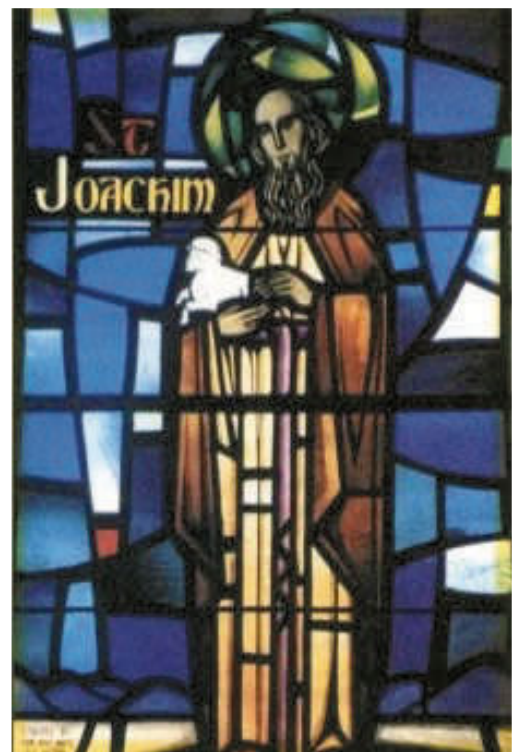

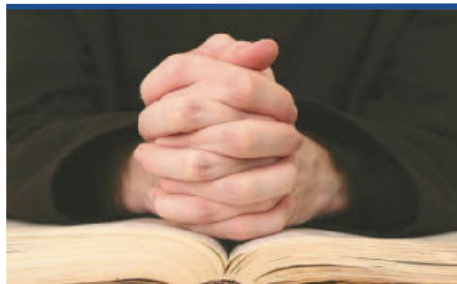

VATICAN CORNER

A Marian apparition is a reported supernatural appearance of Mary

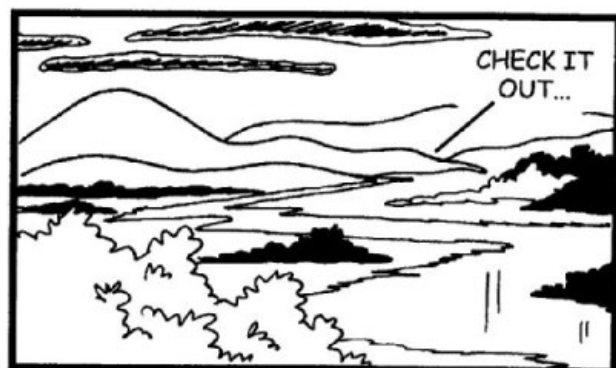
the mother of Jesus. For an appearance to be classified as a Marian apparition in the Catholic Church the person or persons who claim to see Mary must see her visually in their own environment. If they only hear Mary, it is known as an interior locution. A dream or vision or a claimed perception of Mary is not an apparition. Nor are miracles associated with Marian artwork, such as weeping statues an apparition. Marian apparitions are considered expression of Mary's ongoing motherly care for the church and the purpose of each apparition is understood to draw attention to some view of the Christian message needed at a particular time and place. Apparitions are often accompanied by other supernatural events such as medical healing, but such events are thought to be for the purpose of drawing attention to her message. The Blessed Mother has been reported on every continent on the earth. She has been seen by men, women, and children from all different walks of life and in many different environments such as large cities, remote areas, caves, churches, fields, homes, and monasteries. The Roman Catholic Church has been very carefully and cautious to approve, disapprove or condemn reported apparitions. It classifies them as "worthy of belief", "not contrary to the Faith," and "not worthy of belief." An approved apparition cannot have any content that is contrary to the teachings of the Church. The local bishop makes the initial decision about "faith expression" (prayer and devotion). The Vatican makes a decision on the supernatural character of an apparition. The Vatican has officially confirmed the apparitions at Guadalupe, Saint-Etienne-le-Laus, Paris (Rue du Bac, Miraculous Medal), La Salette, Lourdes, Fatima, Portugal, Pontmain, Beauraing, and Banneux. In rare cases a physical artifact is reported in apparitions. The image of Our Lady of Guadalupe is one example where her image was miraculously imprinted on the cloak of Saint Juan Diego. Possibly the best-know apparition sites are Lourdes and Fatima. Over sixty spontaneous healing out of thousands reported at the Lourdes Spring have been classified as "inexplicable" by the physicians of the Lourdes Bureau. The Three Secrets of Fatima have received a large amount of attention in the press. In the twentieth century, of the 386 cases of Marian apparitions, the Church decided that only eight cases had a supernatural character. In the majority of cases the Church has made "no decision" about the supernatural character.



There are many titles through which we love and honor Mary. Some titles grew from geographic and cultural reason such as through the veneration of specific icons (Black Madonna). Others were related to Marian apparitions (Our Lady of Guadalupe). Other names came from seeking her intercession for many human needs in varied situations (Good Counsel). Other titles for her are from her role in the life of Jesus (Our Lady of Sorrows) and still others from dogmas and doctrines (Immaculate Conception). A priest one time in his homily said the greatest title of all was bestowed on her by her beloved Son. It was just one word and it was everything we ever need to know about her. That title is "Mom."

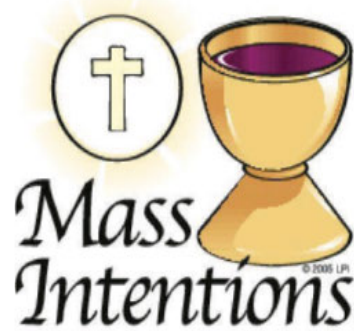
