VATICAN CORNER

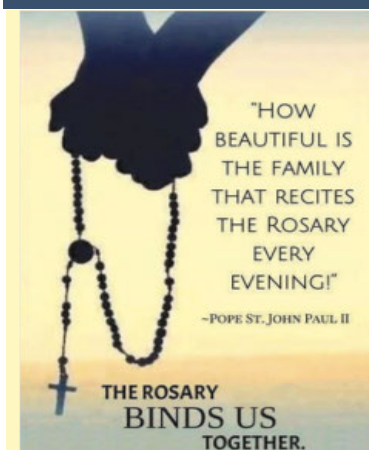
In her book

The Costs of Conversation: Obstacles of Peace Talks in Wartime, author Oriana Skylar Mastro discusses past wars where it was known by both warring sides that a decisive victory was impossible. The author analyzes why peace negotiations took so long to begin and how they may have been started quicker. During the initial stages of almost any war, neither party is



willing to negotiate, viewing it as a tool to get the other side to surrender. Warring parties fear that proposing talks signals weakness, and if an enemy senses weakness it will step-up the conflict or change tactics. Generally, it is when combatants have demonstrated power and resiliency and when a party is sure their opponent is not able to greatly increase the fighting is when they start negotiations. To reduce the chance that peace talks will signal weakness, secret back-channel negotiations are sometimes used to keep them out of the public's eye. Other times private diplomacy between heads of state has been used. The secrecy allows parties to reach agreement before the stage when their public would support such negotiations and compromise. One of the book's key points is that third-party mediators have an opportunity to reduce the costs of peace talks for the combatants even while fighting continues. A major power like the United States acting as a policeman can and has offered incentives to bring parties to the negotiation table. However situations in which the United State is also a participant become much more difficult for the U.S. to negotiate. The author suggests that alongside the United State, regional powers and international institutions such as the United Nations need to step-up and help bring warring parties to the table from day one. On May 4, 2023, Cardinal Pietro Parolin – the Vatican's Secretary of State, reiterated Pope Francis' tireless appeal to put an end to the conflict in Ukraine. Parolin said it is a top priority to try to "Find points of agreement and put an end to this massacre that is strongly affecting Ukraine, but also has significant implications for Russia." The Cardinal recalled the Pope's words 4 days earlier when Francis said "I am willing to do whatever needs to be done. Also, there is a mission going on now, but it is not public yet. Let's see how ...When it is public I will talk about it." After the Pope's statement officials of both Moscow and Kyiv governments responded saying they were not aware of this Vatican initiative, nor had they had any specific communication. Cardinal Parolin said he himself would not give further details. He also expressed "surprise" at the reaction of Russia and Ukraine since, he said, "to my knowledge, they were and are aware" on both sides. "As far as I know, they know...I don't know if there are the conditions today for a ceasefire. Let's hope ... I believe that this initiative – if there will be one – by the Vatican should also go in that direction," and he explained the hope is that a cessation of fighting might take place and then the start of a peace process. After a year of war with the total number of wounded and killed at approximately 354,000 Ukrainians and Russians together, and with millions of Ukrainians driven from their homes, let us pray that the Vatican peace negotiations will be successful to stop the conflict soon.

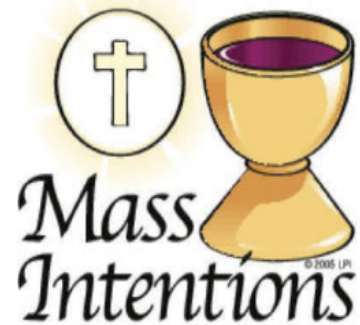

1. If this is your child's first year, a copy of his/her Birth, Baptism will be required at the time of registration **and First Communion Certificates** (for Confirmation registration) will also be required. Please make sure you bring copies and NOT originals.
2. If your child has not been baptized they **MUST** be baptized before the classes start in September .
3. If this is your child's second year, **tuition for their first year must have been paid in full** and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.
