



Registration Requirements:

- 1. If this is your child's first year, a <u>copy</u> of his/her Birth, Baptism will be required at the time of registration and First Communion Certificates (for Confirmation registration) will also be required. Please make sure you bring copies and NOT originals.
- 2. If your child has not been baptized they MUST be baptized before the classes start in September .
- 3. If this is your child's second year, <u>tuition for their first year must have been paid in full</u> and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.
- 4. Classes can fill up and applications are accepted on a first come basis for students that have completed all the requirements.

Tuition Fees:

1 Child in the family \$100.00 ~~ 2 Children in the family \$140.00 ~~ 3 Children or more in the family \$150.00 MUST be paid in full at the time of registration.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be NO automatic registration.




VATICAN CORNER

On Thursday evening May18, 2023, a 40 –year-old

Italian man drove a car at high speed through one of the main entrances of Vatican City and reached the St. Damasus Courtyard of the Apostolic Palace. He was arrested there by the Vatican Gendarmerie (police). The incident occurred at the Santa Anna gate shortly after 8:00 pm., where the man was initially prevented from entering by the Swiss Guards because he lacked the proper authorization to enter. He briefly left the entrance and then turned his car around and returned at high speed forcing his way through the Swiss Guard check point and through a second Gendarmerie check point. In an attempt to stop the car, a Gendarmerie inspector guarding the gate fired a shot in the direction of the front tires of the vehicle and hit the front left fender, but the vehicle continued on its way. By radio, the Gendarmerie sounded the alarm for an incursion and they closed the gate which could have given the man access to the rear of St. Peter's Basilica, to



the Vatican Gardens and to the Santa Marta Square, where the Pope's residence is located. When the car reached the St. Damasus Courtyard the man got out on his own and was stopped and placed under arrest. He was immediately taken to the doctors of the Directorate of Health and Hygiene of the Vatican, and they found him to be in a "serious state of psychophysical alteration". The man was held overnight in a prison cell in the new premises of the Gendarmerie barracks. The next afternoon the man was questioned in the presence of his lawyer and a Vatican magistrate sentenced the unidentified man to mandatory determination of his condition and medical treatment at the psychiatric ward of Santo Spirito in Sassia Hospital. Italy's news agency ANSA later reported that the man's name was Simone Baldovino and he had a history of drug use. Also they reported that Baldovino had made two earlier attempts that day to enter the Vatican, saying he wanted to speak to the Pope, but the Swiss Guards would not let him enter. The incident was a rare incursion into the Vatican of which much is off limits to the general public, especially at night. While visitors can access St. Peter's Basilica and the Vatican museums during business hours, permission is required to enter the other buildings. It was not the first time a seemingly psychologically disturbed person caused a problem in the Vatican. In 2009, a woman jumped the barricade at St. Peter's Basilica during Christmas Eve Mass and tried to attack Pope Benedict XVI. He was not hurt. Another incident happened in June 2022 when Italian military police shot out the tires of a car near the Vatican that was speeding toward St. Peter's Square while visitors were gathering there for the Pope's Sunday prayer. The Swiss Guard closed the Vatican entry points as a precaution, but it was determined that it was not terrorism which created the threat. Mental illness is an illness like any other, and we are called by Jesus to recognize those who are suffering in our midst and to accompany them on their journey. 

The Flame Communicated

Fire! Fire! They're all gonna die! They're all gonna burn up!"

I had absolutely no hope of restoring order as I read the story of Pentecost with my young children last year. As soon as they glimpsed the tongues of fire hovering over the foreheads of the apostles, they were lost to giggles and shrieks. I sighed, sipped my coffee, and wondered resentfully why the Holy Spirit couldn't have chosen to be a dove on that particular day. Just a nice, peaceful dove.

I'll say this, though: the fire left an impression. It usually does, doesn't it? Fire consumes. It renews. It illuminates. It leaves you breathless with fear and awe. The memory and scent and impact of a flame lingers long after it is extinguished.

When I am trying to explain theology to my kids, I have an awful habit of overcomplicating things. I'd had a whole speech prepared for them about what the Holy Spirit is, but it went out the window as soon as they saw the flames. And you know what? It's probably for the best. They wouldn't have remembered that speech. The flames, though? The flames they remembered. The flame communicated.

As a result of Pentecost, the apostles suddenly had the ability to give the truth to foreigners. Aliens. People who were heretofore beyond their reach, isolated by language. The flame communicated.

God's sense of timing is impeccable, and His delivery is carefully crafted. And on Pentecost, the Holy Spirit did not descend as a dove or pour forth as water.

On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit burned.

"¡Fuego! ¡Fuego! ¡Todos van a morir! ¡Todos se van a quemar!"

No tenía absolutamente ninguna esperanza de restaurar el orden cuando leí la historia de Pentecostés con mis hijos pequeños el año pasado. Tan pronto como vieron las lenguas de fuego flotando sobre las frentes de los apóstoles, se perdieron entre risas y gritos. Suspiré, tomé un sorbo de mi café y me pregunté con resentimiento por qué el Espíritu Santo no pudo haber elegido ser una paloma en ese día en particular. Solo una paloma agradable y pacífica.

Sin embargo, diré esto: el fuego dejó una impresión. Suele pasar, ¿no? El fuego consume. Renueva. Ilumina. Te deja sin aliento con temor y asombro. El recuerdo, el olor y el impacto de una llama persisten mucho después de que se extingue.

Cuando trato de explicar teología a mis hijos, tengo la terrible costumbre de complicar demasiado las cosas. Les había preparado todo un discurso sobre lo que es el Espíritu Santo, pero se fue por la ventana en cuanto vieron las llamas. ¿Y sabes qué? Probablemente sea lo mejor. No habrían recordado ese discurso. ¿Las llamas, sin embargo? Las llamas recordaron. La llama se comunicó.

Como resultado de Pentecostés, los apóstoles repentinamente tuvieron la habilidad de dar la verdad a forasteros. Extranjeros. Personas que hasta ahora estaban fuera de su alcance, aisladas por el idioma. La llama se comunicó.

El sentido del tiempo de Dios es impecable, y Su entrega está cuidadosamente elaborada. Y en Pentecostés, el Espíritu Santo no descendió como paloma ni se derramó como aqua.

En Pentecostés, el Espíritu Santo ardió.
