VATICAN CORNER

So who is this Cardinal Matteo Zuppi, Archbishop of Bologna, called by some the “bicycling cardinal”, and why do many consider him a leading contender to be elected pope in the next conclave? He was born in Rome on October 11, 1955, the fifth of six children. His father was a journalist, and his mother was the niece of a Cardinal. He was ordained a priest in 1981 and was the parochial vicar and then pastor of Basilica of Santa Maria in Trastevere, a neighborhood in Rome. He worked with the Community of Sant’Egidio. A Catholic lay association devoted to promoting unity among the world’s Christian Churches and to conflict resolution. He supported that group’s activities of service to the disadvantaged, marginalized children, the elderly, immigrants, homeless, terminally ill, drug addicts, prisoners and victims of conflict. That organization is Pope Francis’ favorites of the new movements dedicated to ecumenism, social justice and it has assisted in previous international peace processes. In 1992, Zuppi working with that organization played a key role in negotiating the Mozambique peace accords, bringing an end to the 17-year civil war in Mozambique, which killed roughly a million people and left four million others displaced. For his role in the negotiations, Zuppi was made an honorary citizen of Mozambique. In Turkey in 1993 he attempted to secure the release of two Italian tourists held by Kurdish rebels.



Cardinal Zuppi is not considered a “traditionalist” or “conservative”, his tendency is to act as a builder of bridges, and he shares much of Pope Francis’s agenda. Zuppi was ordained as Bishop in 2012, appointed Archbishop in 2015 and Pope Francis made him a cardinal in 2019. In May of 2022 Pope Francis appointed Zuppi President of the Italian bishop’s conference. Francis had been unhappy with the work of the Italian bishops for the past 5 years, and Zuppi may lead them in the direction he desires. The Cardinal said he would be guided by three criteria, “obedience to the primacy of the pope, synodality, and collegiality.” On May 20, 2023, Vatican spokesman Matteo Bruni confirmed that Pope Francis has chosen Cardinal Zuppi to conduct “a mission”, in agreement with the Secretary of State, that will contribute to easing the tensions in the conflict in Ukraine, in the hope...that this can start paths of peace.” Zuppi will seek meetings with both Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy and Russian President Vladimir Putin as part of the mission. Churches and monasteries in Italy have been invited to pray for Zuppi and for the mission. Negotiations could be very difficult base on President Zelenskyy’s statements at the recent meeting with Pope Francis at the Vatican. Zelenskyy said there “can be no equality between the victim and the aggressor,” and insisted that Ukraine’s own peace plan, which calls for restoration of Ukraine’s territorial integrity, the withdrawl of Russian troops, and the full cessation of hostilities, is “the only effective algorithm for achieving a just peace.” For years Zuppi has been listed among possible future popes, but he has made light of that speculation. And there is no reason at all to believe the end of Pope Francis’s reign is near. He has repeatedly said he is not about to resign. Anyway, the online “gamblingsites.org” has Zuppi’s odd at 14 to 1 to become the next pope, and it has those same odds for Cardinal Pietro Parolin, the Vatican’s Secretary of State. ources: press.vatican.va, catholicnewsagency.org, cruxnow.com
