

VATICAN CORNER


Reported in 2020, the population of the Vatican city-state was 801,

and unlike other countries, citizenship is not based on birth. Instead citizenship is granted only to those who live in the Vatican because of their work or office. Citizenship is lost with loss of job or office. Swiss guardsmen must retire at age 40 and move out, losing their citizenship. Also included as citizens are cardinals living outside the Vatican in Rome, and diplomatic officials, who spend their time in other countries. The citizenry is a diverse group of mainly men from Italy, Switzerland, Argentinian, and other countries with many different languages spoken. Only about 30 women in the world are Vatican citizens. Living in the small community of the Vatican is said to be like living in a little village; however one difference is the security. Everyone is observed, every corner monitored, and at the



gates, the gendarmerie (police) are watching when you come and go. Generally guests of citizens have to leave before midnight and only citizen's parents and siblings can visit and spend the night, cousins and friends cannot. There are just a few families living in the Vatican. Swiss guardsmen have married and started families. The head electrician and chief gardener have families. When children grow up and get married they lose their right to live in the Vatican. Polish-Vatican journalist and television presenter Magdalena Wolinska-Riedi who has lived and worked in the Vatican since 2003, describes life in the Vatican as "the greatest privilege." She became a citizen when she married a member of the Vatican Swiss Guard. Their wedding ceremony was officiated by Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger, who became Pope Benedict XVI, and their two daughters were baptized by him. She likes to share her life with people in order to bring them closer to the Catholic Church. She explains that life in the Vatican is special and it is the safest place in the world to live. She sees the care and respect that everyone has for one another in the city. Magdalena says It is a very normal place, where she purchases her groceries, teaches her children to ride their bikes, and walks to work. She says she barely thinks about the Vatican code of dress anymore, where bare shoulders, low necklines, or short skirts are not allowed around the city. Generally speaking, women living in Vatican City say they feel happy and secure, but at times a bit lonely in this "man's world." Some benefits are: no taxes, they have access to duty-free shopping, including luxury brands like Prada, Valentino or Armani. However, there are no beauty specialists or hairdresser in the Vatican, but there is a gym and fitness coach, and a gas station with much cheaper gas than in Rome. Health services are provided by access to the top Roman clinics. As time goes on, there are increasing numbers of women coming into the Vatican from Rome to perform work, and currently 1,165 are women, or one in four employees. But by the Vatican's very nature, the number of women citizens doesn't look likely to change much. The few women who do live at the Vatican say they feel neither humiliated nor ignored, and they understand the centuries-old traditions limiting their numbers.
