





VATICAN CORNER June 22, 2023 was the 40th anniversary of the disappearance of Emanula Orlandi the 15

-year-old schoolgirl and daughter of a Vatican lay employee of the papal household. She went missing after a music lesson in central Rome. Her father reported her missing to the police and the search for her began the next morning. Her photo was published in the Italian newspapers and Pope John Paul II issued an appeal to those responsible for her disappearance. There have been many theories about what happened to her, such as it being linked to a plot to kill Pope John Paul II; or being a kidnapping by the Roman underworld and connected to a Vatican Bank financial scandal; or she was the victim of a group of priestly pedophiles; or she was taken and is still alive living in central Europe or the Middle East. Over the years questions were asked why the Vatican never opened an official investigation into the disappearance. The official answer was that the disappearance was on



Italian territory, and it fell under Italian jurisdiction. However some information suggests that the Vatican may have also made an investigation of its own. In 2001, a skull was found in a bag in a confessional in San Gregorio VII church near the Vatican. It turned out not to be Orlandi's, but it publicized again the mystery of her disappearance. On Good Friday, 2007 Reverend Raniero Cantalamessa in St. Peter's Basilica advised the congregation to make amends for sins before dying. This got people thinking that he was talking to someone in the Vatican who might have information about the Orlandi disappearance. Vatican spokesperson Rev. Federico Lombardi issued a detailed statement regarding Vatican cooperation with the Italian investigators over the years and that all materials from the Vatican had been handed over to them. In October 2018, the Orlandi family received an anonymous letter which suggested where Emanuela's body may have been buried. The Vatican opened the site and did not find her remains, but did find many ancient bones that were unknown to be there. In October 2022, Netflix released a four-part documentary entitled Vatican Girl which explored different theories surrounding her disappearance. On January 9, 2023, the Vatican opened its first official investigation and Pope Francis appointed Alessandro Diddi to lead the probe. Italian investigators have also reopened their own investigations. Diddi's office reported that they "collected all the evidence available in the various institutions of the Vatican and the Holy See, while also seeking evidence through conversations with persons in charge of certain offices at the time of the events." They proceeded "to examine the material, confirming certain lines of investigation worthy of further investigation" and all the relevant documentation has been transmitted "to the Public Prosecutor's Office in Rome, so that the latter may examine it and proceed in the direction it deems most appropriate." On Sunday June 25, 2023, Pope Francis addressed the crowd in St. Peter's Square, including Orlandi's brother Pietro standing with a group of supporters holding up photographs and banners that called for "truth" and "justice". He offered prayers and solidarity to the Orlandi's family. Francis said he wanted "to express once again my closeness to her family, especially her mother, assuring my prayers." Pietro Orlandi said he welcomed the Pope's remark, calling them "a positive signal" and "a good step forward." Earlier in 2023, Pietro Orlandi played an audio tape on Italian television from an alleged gangster who said girls were brought into the Vatican to be molested and that Pope John Paul II knew about it. Pope Francis called those allegations offensive and unfounded insinuations".




