



VATICAN CORNER


Pope Francis answered journalist's questions on his

return flight from World Youth Day in Portugal on Sunday August 6, 2023. He was asked why he did not pray publicly for an end to the war in Ukraine when he visited the shrine at Fátima. He said he prayed for peace but did not want to "advertise" his private prayer. "She [Our Lady] made this request during the First World War. And this time I appealed to Our Lady and I prayed. I did not advertise." In St. Peter's Basilica last year, Pope Francis consecrated Russia and Ukraine to the Blessed Virgin Mary with a prayer asking for peace in the world and asking all the bishops of the world to do the same. A portion of the skipped prayer was later published by the Vatican, and it was one of several prepared



speeches for the trip which he did not give. One journalist noticing these changes and asked the Pope about his health and specially his eyesight. He said his health was fine and one speech he cut off because there was light in front of him. In other instances, he shortened or changed his homilies based on the response of his audience. Simultaneous translations into Portuguese, Englsh, Spanish, French and Italian were provided at World Youth Day by way of radios and headphones. Francis said when I speak, I don't do academic homilies, but I try to make it as clear as possible." "You noticed that I asked a few questions and immediately the feedback showed me where it was going, whether it was wrong or not." "Young people don't have a long attention span. Think about it: If you make a clear speech with an idea, an image, an affection, they can follow you for eight minutes." Pope Francis said attendance was impressive and the youth event being the largest and best prepared was the Saturday evening vigil. "The young people are a surprise, they act youthful, life is like that. But they are seeking to move forward, and are the future. The idea is to accompany them." The problem is knowing how to accompany them." They shouldn't detach themselves from their roots. That's why I insist so much on dialogue between old and young, between grandparents with grandchildren. The grandparents are the roots. Young people are religious, they seek faith, not something artificial ... They seek an encounter with Jesus." Pope Francis stressed that mental health and suicide are serious issues facing young people today, and that he does not believe that it is discussed enough by the media. Francis revealed that a young man had confided in him (not in the confessional) that he had considered committing suicide last year. He said "so many people are anxious and depressed. "In some countries that are very, very demanding at the university, young people who do not succeed in getting a degree or finding a job commit suicide because they feel great shame." The Pope was asked why women and homosexual people cannot access every sacrament. He said not being able to participate in every sacraments "does not mean the Church is closed." He emphasized that the Church welcomes everyone, including homosexual people. "The Lord is clear: the sick the well, the old and the young, the ugly and the beautiful, the good and the bad. Even the immoral [person]. He described the Church as a mother who guides her children in the maturing of their faith through prayer, interior dialogue, and dialogue with the pastors. "In [ministry], one of the important things is patience: accompanying people step by step on their way to maturity. Each one of us has this experience: that the Mother Church has accompanied us and accompanies us in our own path of maturation." (maturity).

- 2. If your child has not been baptized they MUST be baptized before the classes start in September .
- 3. If this is your child's second year, <u>tuition for their first year must have been paid in full</u> and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.
