





VATICAN CORNER

Pope Francis traveled to




Mongolia at the end of August, 2023. It is a vast landlocked country, roughly the size of Alaska, bordered by Russia to the north and China to the south. Mongolia is the world's most sparsely populated sovereign state, and much of it is covered by rolling grassy plains called steppes which have no trees. Approximately 30% of its 3.3 million people are nomadic or semi-nomadic whose day-to-day life revolves around the herding and breeding of horses. Mongolia was part of China until 1921 when it became closely tied to the Soviet Union. Mongolia's Soviet-allied communist government banned religious

observation for decades. After the anti-communist revolutions of 1989, Mongolia had its own peaceful democratic revolution. Religious freedom was enshrined in the Mongolian constitution, and Christian and evangelical churches took root. Buddhism is the majority religion (52%), No-religion (41%), Islam (3%) and Christian (1%). Mongolia has a tiny Catholic population of about 1,500 in the entire country. There are 77 missionaries, 2 ordained priests, and no nuns. Last year Pope Francis named Archbishop Giorgio Marengo, an Italian, the first cardinal and administrator of the young Catholic Church in Mongolia. The hope is to eventually have more trained lay people so that foreign missionaries will be less necessary. During his visit, Pope Francis met with the authorities, diplomats, priests, missionaries, members of other religions and he said Mass for the tiny Catholic community in an indoor ice hockey rink. Francis opened a church-run homeless clinic and shelter, and he urged the everyday Mongolians to volunteer to help the poor. He said that the Catholic Church was not about winning converts. "No! Christians do whatever they can to alleviate the suffering of the needy, because in the person of the poor they acknowledge Jesus, the Son of God, and in him the dignity of each person." Pope Francis also traveled to Mongolia to bless a statue which was miraculously found in a landfill in the northern region of the country by a Buddhist woman. It was a beautiful statue wrapped in a blanket. The woman who found it insists that she found it before the missionaries arrived 18 years ago." When the story of the statue reached Cardinal Giorgio, he enthroned it in the Cathedral of Saints Peter and Paul at the capital, and he consecrated Mongolia to the Virgin Mary. Cardinal Giorgio said "This discovery might signify something profound; perhaps a sign from our Blessed Lady Mary that she had been present here before us, preparing for our arrival. She appeared in the humblest and poorest of places, which could signify her desire for us to care for the poorest among us. Pope Francis selected the name for the statue to be "Heavenly Mother" as the most fitting title, recognizing the significance of heaven in Mongolian culture. The Catholic community has become devoted to Mary, and the statue is credited with helping to grow the Catholic community.

So why did Pope Francis fly for 10 hours and travel 5,000 miles to meet fewer Catholic than there are in most parish churches? Well he was invited by the Mongolian government, and he was just following his policy of going to the peripheries of the world, where Catholics are a minority in order to draw attention to the people and problems. He traveled there to give a word of hope to the young church. He may also have been visiting a future go-between country that could help him to improve the situation of Catholics in China, since Mongolia and China have good relations.


