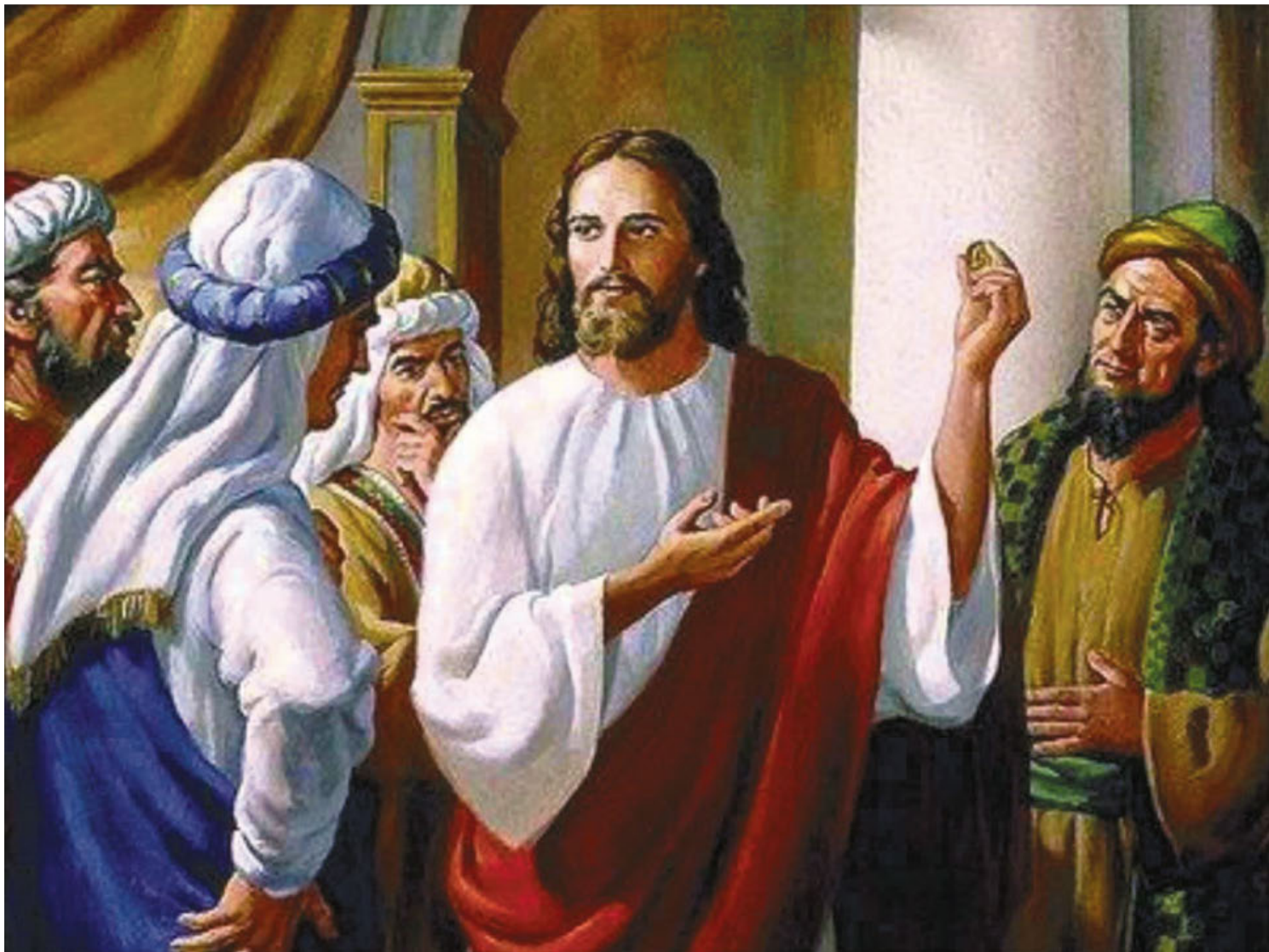

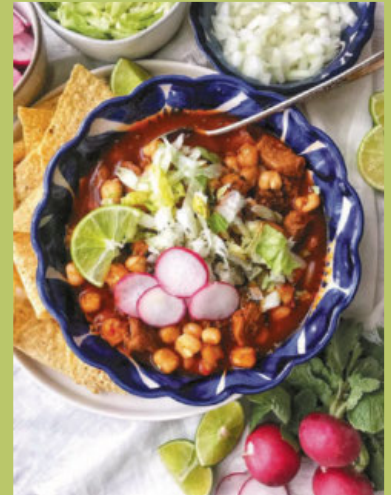

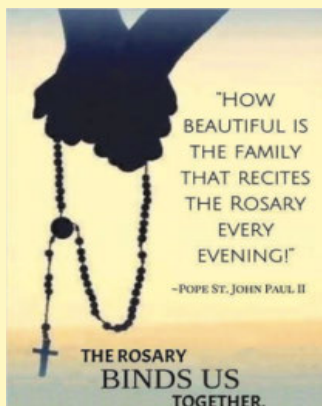
VATICAN CORNER

On Oct. 7, 2023, as

Israelis were finishing the seven-day long Jewish festival of Sukkot, they were attacked by Hamas terrorists from the adjoining Gaza region. Thousands of missiles were fired from Gaza, the border fences were breached by hundreds of armed fighters, beaches were stormed by dozens of militants coming from boats, and attacks came from paragliders. More than 1,400 people were killed in the attack,



including women, children and the elderly. Another 3,400 were injured, and at least 200 were taken back to Gaza as hostages. It was the deadliest attack Israel had ever seen and they declared war on Hamas in retaliation. Israel launched bombs from jet fighters at high-rise residential buildings in the area of Gaza that served as the hub for Hamas. By Oct. 16th at least 2,750 Palestinians had been killed and more than 9,700 injured by the Israelis. Three hundred thousand Israeli reservists were mobilized. Electricity, fuel, food and water were blocked by the Israelis from the 2.3 million Palestinians living in the Gaza. Hamas threatened to execute the hostages they had taken. As of this writing, the Israelis were preparing for a ground invasion to annihilate Hamas and retrieve the hostages. There was a chaotic rush of thousands of Palestinians and foreigners toward the southern Gaza in the hope of escaping through Egypt before the Israeli ground forces moved in. But Egyptian officials did not let the Palestinians cross into their country and Hamas militants tried to delay the evacuation in order to use the Palestinians civilians as human shields. Pope Francis condemned Hamas' terrorist attacks on Israel and pleaded with the militants to free their hostages unharmed. He also expressed concern about Israel's tightening siege on Gaza and its impact on innocent civilians. He said "one who is attacked has the right of self-defense, but I am concerned about the total siege under which Palestinians are living in Gaza, where there also have been many innocent victims." "Terrorism and extremism will not help reach a solution to the conflict between Israelis and Palestinians, but only increase hatred, violence and vengeance and only make each other suffer." Israel's foreign minister Eli Cohen criticized the Vatican response to the Hamas attack. He called for the Vatican to issue a clearer condemnation of Hamas' "terrorist acts". Cohen said "Israel is fighting a war that was imposed upon it and will continue to fight Hamas until it no longer poses a threat to the citizens of Israel. This is being done for the benefit of the entire world." Cardinal Pietro Parolin, the Vatican's secretary of state called Hamas's attacks "in human" and said the Vatican expresses "complete and firm condemnation." Pope Francis also stressed the need of respecting international humanitarian law in Gaza "where it is urgent and necessary to ensure humanitarian corridors and to come to the aid of the entire population." He invited Christians to join the Church in the Holy Land in dedicating Oct. 17th to prayer and fasting for peace. He said although it is easy to feel powerless in the face of war, "prayer is the meek and holy force to oppose the diabolical force of hatred, terrorism and war." 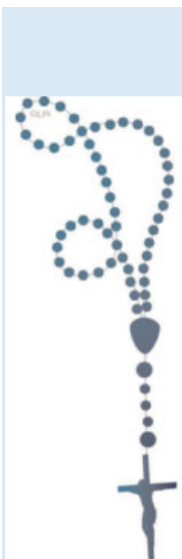
