## VATICAN CORNER

The nearly month-long 2023


Synod on Synodality concluded on Saturday evening October 28, 2023. More than 1,150 amendments were proposed to the draft summary report in the last days. The drafters attempted to incorporate those amendments. Each of the final 81 paragraphs of the 42- page summary report was voted on by the 344 voting members in attendance. The Synod had 365 participants, including 300 hundred bishops, along with lay men and about 50 mostly lay women. The Pope gave women and lay people a vote on Church affairs for the first time. A two-thirds majority was needed for each paragraph to be included.



After the final vote, Pope Francis thanked the Synod members and organizers, and the final summary was published. The participants will meet again for a final session in a year. The report calls for greater 'co-responsibility' in the Church. There were some notable proposals for new ministries for the laity, increase lay involvement in decision making, create ways to evaluate bishop's performance of their ministry, change the way the Church recognizes "controversial" issues, and expand the synodal method of coming together for listening, dialogue, consensus-building and decision-making. The final report also noted fears that have emerged around the Synod. "Some fear that they will be forced to change; others fear that nothing will change and there will be little courage to move in the rhythm of the living Tradition. Some perplexity and opposition also hide the fear of losing power and the privileges that come with it," the report said. The Synod participants also identified the need to determine why only 1% of Catholics worldwide participated in the synodal process which had begun by Pope Francis in 2021. The report also noted that some members raised concerns that the equal participation of non-bishops in an episcopal body could lead to the "specific task of the bishops" not being "adequately understood." The sections of the report that received some of the most opposition concerned proposals related to the possible inclusion of women as deacons (diaconates). Sixty-seven members voted against the proposal that "theological and pastoral research" by the two commissions Pope Francis established "to study women's access to the diaconate should be continued." Sixty-one members voted against a proposal that said a "deeper reflection" on the diaconate's status as "a proper and permanent degree of the hierarchy" would "also illuminate the issue of women's access to the diaconate." Both proposals received enough votes to pass. The summary report did not include the term "LGBTQ+ people" although it had been included in the working documents for the Synod. The report did however emphasize the participant's closeness and support to all those who experience a condition of loneliness" as a result of "fidelity to the Church's tradition and magisterium in marriage and sexual ethics" and called upon Christian communities to listen and accompany those in these situations.

Wyatt Olivias, the 19-year old student at the University of Wyoming, a missionary at the Catholic youth program Totus Tuus and a catechist at his local diocese, was the youngest member attending the Synod. He drafted a letter requesting he be excused from classes for a few days upon his return home in order to rest up. He thought who better to sign the letter than the head guy. The Pope Francis agreed with him and signed the excuse letter with a smile.
