### VATICAN CORNER

During the time of Jesus and his first disciples,

fishing was part of the local economy of the villages along the Sea of Galilee. It is a freshwater lake located in northern Israel and is one of the lowest-lying bodies of water in the world. It is also known as Lake Tiberius or Kinneret, and is 13 miles long, seven miles wide and rich in fish, even today. In the time of Jesus, most fishing was done by nets and either cast from the shallow waters, or from a boat, or dragged behind a boat. While Jesus himself was not a fisherman, he used fishing boats for transport and preaching, and most of the time the



boats belonged to fisherman like Peter and Andrew, James and John or their father Zebedee. More than 50 times in the Gospels boats are mentioned. The Barque (boat) of St. Peter depicted in religious artwork, is an ancient Christian symbol. It represents the Church, the soul's refuge in times of trial, tossed on the sea of disbelief, worldliness, and persecution. It is the safe harbor blessed by God. Just as Peter and the disciples were




hesitant and doubtful about the stormy sea and Jesus said "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." "Come!" and Peter walked on the water and came toward Jesus. The Barque symbolizes the Church founded on St. Peter and is a means of conveyance between this world and the next. In 1986 the remains of a boat was discovered on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. A sudden subsidence of the waters exposed the well preserved remains that had been covered in mud. The boat measured 8.8 meters long by 2.5 meters wide with an 8 meter mast and was used for fishing. The boat would hold four rowers and a dozen people. It is thought to be of the same type mentioned in the evangelical stories and therefore gives us a precise idea of the boat from which Christ calmed the storm. Radiocarbon dating placed the discovered remains within the time of Christ's life,

between 120 BC and AD 40. The remains of the boat were put in a museum in Ginosar, in Galilee. A replica was constructed with the same dimensions as the discovered remains by the Aprea family, marine carpenters from the Sorrento peninsula. This copy was a fully functional boat and completed in collaboration with the International Diplomatic Institute. The replica was given to Pope Francis in March of 2023, and he wanted it available for all to see. It was placed as a permanent exhibit at the entrance to the Vatican Museum on October 10, 2023 along with various models of boats from all over the world. Barbara Jatta, the director of the Vatican Museums said "It's the boat of boats." "It speaks to our origins, it is a symbol of the Church, of what we are today. Peter's boat represents the difficulties we encounter in our daily lives, but also Jesus's invitation to trust God."
