VATICAN CORNER The Nativity scene, also

known as the manger, or

presepio, or crèche is a tradition handed down from Italian generation to Italian generation. It is a replica of the scene of the birth of Jesus, and is one of the main Christmas decorations in Italy. It is found in almost every church and in many homes. It is usually prepared on December 8, the feast of the Immaculate Conception, and is on display for a month. During St. Francis' time in 1223, the Nativity scene consisted of Mary, Joseph and baby Jesus, and with two live animals – an ox and an ass. Over time the cast of characters has grown to include shepherds and three wise-men, angels, cattle and other farm animals. However, of the four gospels of the New



Testament, only Matthew and Luke describe Jesus' birth. Mathew mentions wise-men and Luke writes of shepherds but nowhere are shepherds and wise-men described together, and no animals are mentioned at all. The number of wise-men visiting baby Jesus is not stated in the Bible and only what is said is that they brought 3 gifts: gold, frankincense, and myrrh. The wise- men were probably a class of priests from Persia who studied astrology and noticed the star in the sky, and were not kings as they are depicted today. Songs and poems, paintings and stories over the centuries have understandable added artistic interpretations to the nativity scene and broadened the telling of the story from what was in the Bible. Some replica Nativity scenes are now very elaborate, showing an entire village from everyday life with characters and components mostly made from hand, from wood, ceramics, papier-mache, terracotta and fabrics. Some scenes are so detailed that they include waterfalls, fountains, buildings, mountains, trees, vendors and livestock. These elaborate scenes have introduced new characters which have become essential to the traditional scene. Benino the shepherd is one character that represents the "sleeping people whom the angel announces the coming of Christ." He is often sleeping with 12 sheep which represent the 12 apostles or the 12 months of the year. Another character is the fisherman, who symbolizes a "fisherman of souls". Uncle Vincenzo and Uncle Pasquale represent Fat Tuesday and the Death, the two moments that open and close the remembrance of the death of Jesus before Easter. The Young Gypsy Woman is another character who is able to predict the future. She is a sign of the misfortune and pain yet to come for Jesus. The Harlot is a symbol of the carnal, as opposed to the purity of the Virgin Mary. She is placed near the tavern, opposite the manger. Pope Francis in his 2019 letter said that with the manger, "great imagination and creativity is always shown in employing the most diverse materials to create small masterpieces of beauty." "As children, we learn from our parents and grandparents to carry on this joyful tradition, which encapsulates a wealth of popular piety. It is my hope that this custom will never be lost and that, wherever it has fallen into disuse, it can be rediscovered and revived. "Pope Francis in his December, 2023 speech said "every nativity scene, including the creches in our homes, should awaken in us sentiments of nostalgia for silence and prayer, in our often hectic life" Silence allows us to "listen to what Jesus tells us from that unique 'chair' which is the manger." Prayer on the other hand, enables us "to express the grateful wonder, the tenderness, perhaps the tears that the Nativity scene arouses in us." Mary is our model: "She says nothing, but contemplates and adores."


