

VATICAN CORNER | The so-called Vatican 'trial of the century' ended December 16, 2023, after 2 1/2 years in Vatican's City's criminal court. It was

about a multi-million euro investment in a luxury property in London that went bad, along with other financial misconduct resulting in great losses of charitable donations. It was a very complicated financial trial with 3 judges, 10 defendants including a Cardinal, 30 defense lawyers, police raids, a secret recording of the Pope, and a 500 page indictment detailing the alleged crimes. The trial tested the Vatican judicial system and exposed some Vatican dirty laundry. Seventy-five year old Cardinal Giovanni Angelo Becciu, once one of the most powerful figures in the Vatican as the "substitute" Secretary of State, was found guilty of several counts of embezzlement and was sentenced to 5.5 years in prison. He has repeatedly denied the charges and his lawyer said Becciu would appeal the verdict. Most of the other defendants were found guilty on some counts but were acquitted of others. Most defendants face jail time and some restitution. Only Monsignor Mauro Carlino, Cardinal Becciu's former secretary, was acquitted on all counts. The Vatican spent around \$400 million on the London investment




property, a former car showroom was to be made into apartments, but ended up with losses of \$150 million, eventually being unloaded by the Vatican. Prosecutors in the trial present the case that the Church was swindled out of millions by paying too much while middlemen made huge profits, and while those in charge of the deal were negligent. Extortion, money laundering, fraud, embezzlement, abuse of office were some of the crimes for which defendant were found guilty. Things unintentionally discovered during the trial were Vatican vendettas, corruption, incompetence, ransom payments, and the cost of the harm to the Vatican's reputation. Before the trial Pope Francis had to change the law to allow bishops and cardinals to be prosecuted in a Vatican courtroom, since they were previously immune. Also he issued decrees during the pre-trial period to give prosecutors greater freedom of investigation, including the use of wiretaps, to be able to detain suspects without a judge's warrant, and the suspension of confidentiality rules for documents. Monsignor Alberto Perlasca who ran the office that managed the Vatican's sovereign wealth fund, was initially a prime suspect in the trial. However - public relations specialist Francesca Chaouqui with a grudge against -Cardinal Becciu from the "Vatileaks" scandal in 2015 2016 got Monsignor Perlasca to cooperate with the trial prosecutors and turn on Cardinal Becciu. The Cardinal was found to be in charge when the initial investment of the Church's funds was approved for the London property. It was also discovered that the Cardinal secretly funneled 125,000 Vatican euros to a charity in his native Sardinia run by his brother. The charity was said to be for the purpose of a bakery to employ at-risk youths. But the money had not been spent. Cardinal Becciu also paid Cecilia Marogna – a Sardinian woman, the so called 'cardinal's lady' - who was also one of the trial's defendants, \$575,000 euros for her intelligence services, to pay a British security firm to negotiate the release of a Colombian nun taken hostage. It was proven that Marogna spent \$54,000 of that money on clothing and fashion accessories for herself. The trial revealed the problem of having priests with no professional financial training, in charge of large Church funds. One result of the trail is that Pope Francis in his battle to reform the Vatican finances, has transferred funds controlled by the Secretary of State to be managed day-to day by an experienced accountant. Due to Pope Francis' efforts to enhance Vatican financial accountability, the London property investment was flagged as suspicious and led to this trial. The Pope is aware that there is still plenty of financial report needed, and he says the "lure of corruption is so dangerous that we must be extremely vigilant" and he often warns "The devil enters through the pockets!"
