Christ Is Anything but Ordinary

We're about to dive headlong into week two of Ordinary Time, and we need to admit, after the hustle and bustle of the holidays, things are indeed looking more ... ordinary, at least in our spiritual lives.

The transcendent highs of the Christmas season are flatlining a bit and the vivid imagery of the Nativity scene has faded. The solemn anticipation of the Advent season is by now a distant memory.

Are you bored yet?

Here's a secret: I think that Ordinary Time can actually be quite extraordinary, if we're really living out our baptismal call.

In today's Gospel, Jesus point-blank asks Andrew, who is following him after hearing John the Baptist's testimony: "What are you looking for?" He's asking us the same question.

What are you looking for? Why are you following me? Is it for the Christmas cookies and the Advent carols? Is it for the King's Cake on the Epiphany? Is it for the feeling we get on Christmas when we just know God has done a wondrous thing?

None of those things are bad, but they are not what Andrew was looking for, and they were not what Christ promised him when he said, "Come, and you will see." Andrew was looking for the Messiah — the One who makes even Ordinary Time extraordinary. The One who can sanctify the longest and dullest of to-do lists, on the longest and dullest of days. The One whose peace can reign in our homes on January 25, not just December 25.

Remember what you are looking for. Come, and you will see.





VATICAN CORNER | The Diocese of Livorno in Tuscany, Italy issued a decree that their Father Ramon

Guidetti "publicly committed a schismatic act" during Mass and has therefore resulted in his automatic excommunication per canon 1364.1 of the Code of Canon Law. That law is about offenses against the faith and the unity of the Church. Catholics have been instructed not to attend any Masses offered by Father Guidetti or they too will receive the penalty of excommunication. The schismatic act committed was a violation of 751 of the Canon Law Code, which defines schism as "the refusal of submission to the Supreme Pontiff



or of communion with the members of the Church subject to him." Father Guidetti in his 20-minute long homily at Mass on December 31, 2023, honored Pope Benedict XVI on the anniversary of his death. However, Guidetti also called the deceased former pope "the true pope" who "never fled the barque (boat) of Peter". He called Pope Francis an "antipope usurper" (an illegitimate pope). He went into detail about the qualities of "real priests" and cardinals versus those who follow Pope Francis and "his mercenaries." He called Pope Francis a "masonic Jesuit tied to a group of globalists and denied that Francis has been the Pope for the last decade. He praised another priest as a "pioneer" in being faithful to Christ. That priest was Father Alessandro Minutella of Palermo, who was excommunicated in 2018 for spreading "heresy and schism" and who continues to go on speaking tours and hosts a web radio program in which he regularly declares Pope Francis an antipope. The 48-year-old Father Guidetti had been a diocesan priest since 2017 in the parish of St. Ranieri in the town of Guasticce about 150 miles north of Rome. Bishop Simone Giusti had met with Father Guidetti before Christmas to discuss a video shown on social media, where Father Guidetti called Pope Francis a "usurper" and a "freemason". After Father Guidetti's verbal attack of Pope Francis on December 31, Bishop Giusti had enough and removed Father Guidetti from his office at the parish, and Guidetti can no longer perform priestly functions. A similar situation occurred on Aug. 7, 2020, when Father Jeremy Leatherby was automatically excommunicated by Bishop Jaime Soto of Sacramento, Calif. Father Leatherby would offer Mass and teachings in public to the faithful, instructing them against the legitimacy of Pope Francis, and instead substituting Pope Benedict XVI name for that of the pope, even though Benedict had retired. Back under the 1917 Code of Canon Law, excommunication meant a person was kicked out of the Church. However a new code in 1983 changed the meaning of excommunication, which is now known as a censure, and mainly medicinal, meant to wake a person to his wrongdoing so he can repent and return to normal functioning within the Church. It means a person is still in the Church but is prohibited from receiving the sacraments or if they are clergy, prohibited from administering sacraments and prohibited from acts of governance. The excommunicated person is still required to fulfill his Sunday obligation at church but is prohibited from taking an active part in church celebrations. The Church prays for excommunicated people to repent and longs to welcome them back into normal Catholic life. 
