




VATICAN CORNER | Machine Learning, or Artificial Intelligence (AI) is a field in computer science that develops and studies

how machines can learn from experience, adjust to new inputs and perform human -like tasks. Many of the AI examples talked about these days come from game playing computers, search engines, robots and self- driving cars. These examples rely heavily on deep learning and natural language processing. A.I in the 21st century is influencing a social and economic shift towards automation, data-driven decision-making and its integration into economics, affecting job markets, healthcare, government, industry and education. Questions have been raised about Al's ethical implications and the risks it poses to jobs that can be done by robots, privacy, copyright protection and even human life itself. Regulatory policies are thought to be needed to ensure the safety and benefits of the AI technology. In Dec. 2023, the European Union provisionally approved the world's first comprehensive Artificial Intelligence (AI) rules. On Dec. 14, 2023, Pope Francis, in



his World Day of Peace message, called for binding global regulation of AI with an international treaty, to ensure AI is developed and used ethically. He said the risk of technology lacking human values of compassion, mercy, morality, and forgiveness are too great. Over the past year, AI has captured the world's attention with great advances like Open AI's ChatGPT showing its ability to produce human-like text, photos and songs. Pope Francis spoke of the promise AI offers and praised it as a manifestation of the creativity of human intelligence. But he emphasized the grave concerns that have been raised by ethicists and human rights advocates about the technology that promises to transform life in ways the can disrupt everything from democratic elections to art.

Pope Francis' greatest alarm has to do with remote weapons systems which he said have already led to a "distancing from the immense tragedy of war and a lessened perception of the devastation caused by those weapons systems." He called for "adequate, meaningful and consistent" human oversight of Lethal Autonomous Weapons Systems (or LAWS), arguing that the world has no need for new technologies that merely "end up promoting the folly of war." The Pope's message did not give details of how a binding treaty could result, other than to say it must be negotiated at a global level, to both promote best practices and prevent harmful ones. Technology companies alone cannot be trusted to regulate themselves. Pope Francis was the victim of some AI foolery in early 2023 when AI was used to generate an image of him in a luxury white puffer jacket which went viral. It showed how fast a realistic fake image can be made and spread on-line. The comments made by the people who saw it made it clear that they thought the image was real. A new documentary by Hans Block and Moritz Riesewieck entitled "Eternal You," looks at the growing industry of the digital afterlife, where artificial intelligence is used to create avatars of deceased loved ones. The living can then have simulated communications with the dead. Artificial intelligence uses text, social media profiles, images and videos to create functioning avatars intended to extend the lives of the dearly departed into the future digital world. The documentary includes the views of ethicists and sociologists and critics. There is one story that a woman created a digital version of her late father so her children can know their grandpa. There is also a heartbreaking story of a South Korean woman preparing to meet a virtual reality version of the young daughter she lost. All is capable of scary stuff, but it may also be able to help us deal better with our grief from the loss of loved ones. Pope Francis said whether or not humanity develops a greater awareness of the "epochal change" that we are experiencing, will determine if Artificial Intelligence becomes "a new form of slavery" in which a "select few can condition the thoughts of others," or a means of freedom by which "all people can participate in the development of thought." Recuperarse del robo/robo


Todavía tenemos mucho que hacer después del robo de hace un par de semanas. Nos alientan mucho aquellos que
