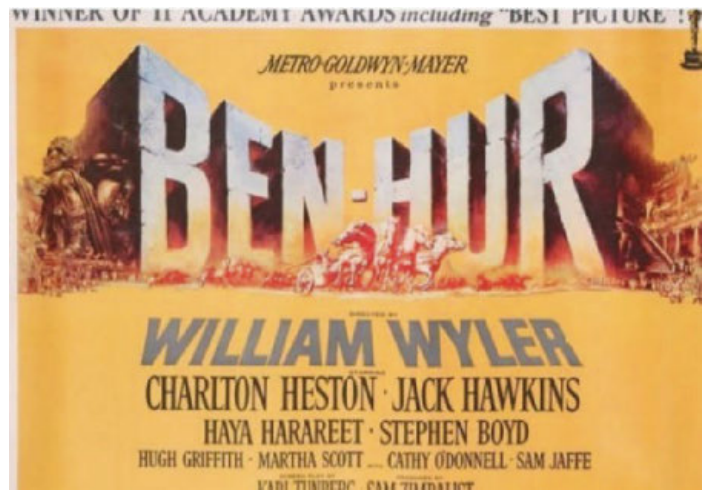

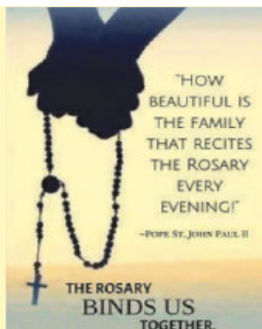

VATICAN CORNER

In 1995, on the 100th anniversary of cinematography, the Vatican compiled a list of outstanding movies chosen by a committee of 12 international movie scholars appointed by the Pontifical Commission for Social Communications. The 45 movies chosen came from all over the world. The list was called "Some Important Films" and it was divided into three categories – "religion", "values" and "art". On the list for "values" and "art" were 11 American films including Gandhi, Schindler's List, Citizen Kane, 2001: A Space Odyssey, Fantasia and the Wizard of Oz. Only one American film made the "religion" category, and that was the movie Ben-Hur: A Tale of the Christ (1959), the grandest of Hollywood's classic biblical epics. It was directed by William Wyler, starred Charlton Heston, Jack Hawkins, Stephen Boyd and Haya Harareet. It is a tale framed within the period between the birth and death of Christ. The main character is Judah Ben-Hur, a Jewish prince from Jerusalem, who is enslaved by the Romans and becomes a charioteer and a Christian. It is the story of a man who loses everything, a story of revenge, a story of a man's personal encounter with Jesus and his ultimately conversion. There are two scenes with Ben-Hur receiving water and later giving water to Jesus which is so tremendously moving to watch. There is also a love story, a story of betrayal, and a story of forgiveness. The viewer is immersed into the ancient world, being shown glimpses of Gospel stories, Jewish patriotism, pageantry, slavery, leprosy, the power and culture of what was ancient Rome and the redemptive death of Christ. The movie has an interesting naval battle and a colossal chariot race which are both very thrilling. The sheer scope of the movie and its special effects can rival some of the biggest blockbuster of today. The movie is based on a popular 550 page original book. A silent movie version had been made previous to this movie version. Jesus' face is never shown in the movie, and that was done by the Director to show respect for God. In the filming Director William Wyler had 300 sets built, there were more than a million props, 100,000 costumes, 10,000 extras, 1.25 million feet of film used, 5 of the 6 existing 65mm cameras in the world were used to film different angles of the action. The unheard of sum of 15 million dollars was spent making the movie which would be about 159 million today. The chariot race circus constructed for the movie is still the largest set ever constructed for any movie and the scenes filmed there took 5 months to shoot. The movie won 11 Oscars, more than any other movie until Titanic tied it with 11 in 1997, and The Lord of the Rings – Return of the King tied it in 2003. The beautiful Oscar winning score was composed by Miklos Rozsa who captured in his music both the grandeur of Rome and the softness of Christ. These days it seems like many younger people have never experienced Ben Hur (1959) or have never even heard of this movie!!! That is a shame because it is such a well made film, allowing the viewer to be eyewitnesses to the astounding life and times of Jesus Christ, and it has such an uplifting message that it can bring you closer to Christ. Movie viewers will be inspired by the powerful depiction of how hatred can destroy life and how love, grace and forgiveness can restore it. If you get the chance to see this 3 hour 42 minute movie (excluding intermission), do it !!!.

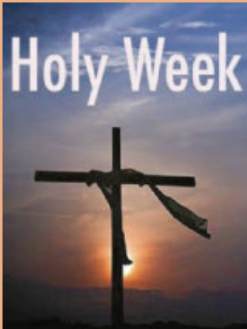

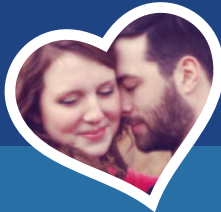
