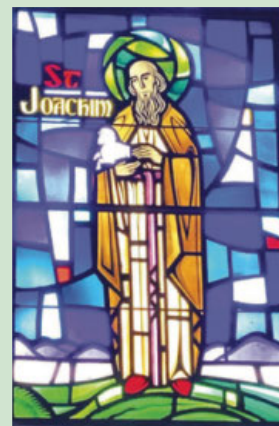

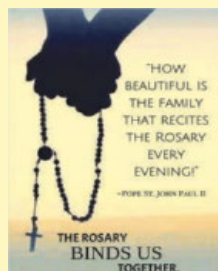

## VATICAN CORNER

A jubilee is a season or occasion of rejoicing or festivity, or jubilation. Pope Boniface VIII in 1300 started the first-ever Roman Catholic Church jubilee called a “Holy Year”, and it was initially celebrated every 100 years. Then it was changed to follow biblical tradition to every 50 years, and in 1490 Pope Paul II changed it again to every 25 years, to allow every person to experience a jubilee in their lifetime. The celebration is designed to be a time of conversion and reconciliation, with emphasis on God’s mercy and forgiveness of sins. It is marked by the opening of the Holy Door in St. Peter’s Basilica and each of the Holy Doors of the four other papal basilicas in Rome. Those doors are destination points for pilgrims who pass through them seeking special graces such as plenary indulgences, which cleanses the soul of ones who has been baptized, and it can also be applied to souls in purgatory. The last Ordinary Jubilee was the one in 2000, celebrated by Pope John Paul II. The upcoming 2025 Jubilee will be the 27th time an ordinary jubilee was celebrated. A new custom calling “extraordinary” jubilees outside the 25-year cycle came about in the 16th century, but there have been only a few, with the last one being the one called by Pope Francis in 2015-2016 known as the Jubilee of Mercy. Roughly 25 million pilgrims came to Rome for the Great Jubilee in 2000. Approximately 21 million came for the extraordinary jubilee in 2015, and the Vatican and Rome are expecting 32 million for the 2025 Jubilee. It is traditional for the city of Rome to use a jubilee to roll out much-needed improvements and modifications to the city infrastructure. In 2023 Italian officials announced plans to spend \$1.95 billion on nearly 100 different projects to update and enhance Rome ahead of the expected tens of millions of extra visitors to the city. Rome’s mayor Roberto Gualtieri said an additional \$542 million would be spent from Italy’s post-pandemic recovery fund on some 335 city projects already being carried out. For example, prior to the Great Jubilee of 2000, Rome built a large parking garage reducing the problem of finding street parking in the Vatican area and it installed a new bus line allowing quicker access from Rome’s main train station, to the Vatican. The most expansive work which Rome was planned and has been undertaking involves road maintenance for updating and remodeling several heavily trafficked streets with sidewalk reconstruction included. One of the most important projects near the Vatican is the construction of an underpass allowing pedestrians to avoid a busy street by crossing from the area in front of Castel Sant’Angelo to Piazza Pia next to the Via della Conciliazione, the main street leading to St. Peter’s Basilica. Some of the other improvements being worked on are: two new parking garages, a bike path, increased security and surveillance, updated train platforms, some new trains, redoing routes from the airport, revamping the city’s metro and bus system, electronic pole and smart shelters for bus waiting, a reception center, lighting improvements, and green areas. A system of “pilgrim paths” are being worked on for suburban churches and places expected to host pilgrims, including the Santa Maria della Pietà youth hostel, and a center for people with disabilities. The public works projects underway have overwhelmed Rome, with flood-lit construction sites operating around the clock and with entire boulevards rerouted and traffic snarled in the city’s already clogged streets. On May 9, 2024 Pope Francis presided over a ceremony in St. Peter’s Basilica for the official edict announcing the 2025 Jubilee called “Pilgrims of Hope” which is to begin on December 24, 2024. Hopefully, and with God’s help, many of the construction projects will be wrapped up before they are needed for the Catholic Holy Year. 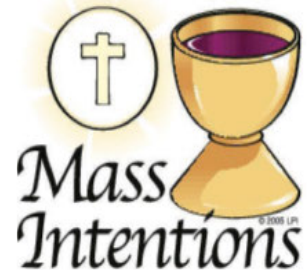
