



VATICAN CORNER An updated set of rules for reviewing alleged apparitions, visions, and revelations

were issued by the Vatican on May 17, 2024. The rules have been in development since 2019, and are replacing those established in 1978 under Pope Paul VI. Historically, the Vatican has used great caution when approving supposed supernatural occurrences. Examples where the Church has affirmed supernatural events are Our Lady of Guadalupe and Our Lady of Lourdes, both which have led to great spiritual growth among the faithful. However other claims of supernatural appearances have led to confusion and harm. The new rules are intended to prevent scams, hoaxes and heresies and it requires bishops to perform the investigations and evaluations, using a interdiocesan commission. But also the new rules require a determination by the Vatican that the alleged supernatural appearances are truly real, and bishops will no longer be allowed to make that determination on their own. In these times of rapid communication through social media, there has been an explosion of supernatural claims, from weeping statues of the Virgin Mary to Jesus appearing on food. Cardinal Victor Manual Fernández the head of the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith presided over the press conference introducing the



new set of rules. In the document he wrote that "there are serious critical issues that are detrimental to the faithful; in these situations (hoaxes), the Church must respond with utmost pastoral solicitude (care)." "In particular, I am thinking of the use of such phenomenon to gain profit, power, fame, social recognition, or other personal interest, even possibly extending to the commission of gravely immoral acts or the use of these phenomena as a means of or pretext for exerting control over people or carrying out abuses." Also he wrote that such hoaxes could possibly spread "doctrinal errors, an oversimplification of the Gospel message," and sect mentality. Fernández observed that under the old rules, "decisions took an excessively long time, sometimes spanning several decades," delaying "the necessary ecclesiastical discernment." In assessing the spiritual authenticity of such claims, the new rules stress the need to have quick and clear rulings that involve collaboration between local bishops and the Vatican's doctrinal office in order to avoid confusion. Alleged supernatural events today have a global influence and have consequences other than just in the diocese where they are located, that is why the Vatican must be involved. Cardinal Fernández was asked about the controversial case of Medjugorje, the site of alleged Marian apparitions in Bosnia-Herzegovina that draws thousands of pilgrims each year, but of which many people are skeptical, including Pope Francis. A special study of the case was started in 2018, but no decision has been reached. He said the new rules will make it easier to reach a conclusion. The new rules outline six possible Vatican conclusions that may be eventually granted to an alleged supernatural event. The most positive conclusion being: without certainty about the event itself, there may be an appreciation of the potential spiritual and pastoral value, where the diocesan bishop is encouraged to promote its spread, including through possible pilgrimages to a sacred site. The most negative conclusion being: An authorization to declare that the phenomenon is found to be not supernatural. The new rules quoted the late Pope Benedict XVI who said that even when such events (supernatural) receive church approval, they are meant to be "a help which is proffered (extended), but its use is not obligatory (required).


