God in Daily Life

Question:

How do I bring God into the work of my daily life?

Answer:

Whatever your daily work, you have an opportunity to encounter God and to follow His commandments in love. In the New Testament, we see that most of the Apostles didn't have a previous religious position. They were fishermen, tax collectors, and political activists. St. Paul was a tentmaker. Among the saints, we have doctors, lawyers, farmers, and stay-at-home moms. No matter your daily tasks, God can be present there!

One way concerns behavior. Start with an examination of conscience. Look at areas where you tend to struggle to imitate Christ at work. Do you gossip? Does brimming frustration become impatience at home? Pick one sin you struggle with, then choose a virtue to strengthen that area. If you tend to speak poorly of your co-workers, resolve to stop and to say one kind thing a day instead.

Another way relates to perspective, particularly your perspective of others. Jesus' incarnation reminds us of the value of every human being. Jesus is God, and each of us is created in God's image. When you encounter another person, you have an opportunity to see God in a new place and a new way — in that person in front of you. Genuinely listen to them and be present to their concerns. Loving your neighbor is loving God! Our relationship with God and the love He inspires in our hearts shouldn't remain only at church on Sunday. We can — and should — let our faith animate our lives!

Dios en la Vida Diaria

Pregunta:

¿Cómo introduzco a Dios en el trabajo de mi vida diaria?

Respuesta:

Cualquiera que sea tu trabajo diario, tienes la oportunidad de encontrarte con Dios y seguir Sus mandamientos con amor. En el Nuevo Testamento vemos que la mayoría de los Apóstoles no tenían una posición religiosa previa. Eran pescadores, recaudadores de impuestos y activistas políticos. San Pablo era un fabricante de tiendas. Entre los santos tenemos médicos, abogados, agricultores y amas de casa. No importa tus tareas diarias, ¡Dios puede estar presente allí!

Una forma se refiere al comportamiento. Comienza con un examen de conciencia. Mira las áreas en las que tiendes a tener dificultades para imitar a Cristo en el trabajo. ¿Haces chismes? ¿La frustración desbordante se convierte en impaciencia en casa? Elige un pecado con el que luchas y luego elige una virtud para fortalecer esa área. Si tiendes a hablar mal de tus compañeros de trabajo, decide detenerte y decir algo amable al día.

Otra forma se relaciona con la perspectiva, particularmente la perspectiva que tienes de los demás. La encarnación de Jesús nos recuerda el valor de cada ser humano. Jesús es Dios y cada uno de nosotros es creado a imagen de Dios. Cuando te encuentras con otra persona, tienes la oportunidad de ver a Dios en un lugar nuevo y de una manera nueva: en esa persona frente a ti. Escúchalos genuinamente y esta presente en sus inquietudes. ¡Amar al prójimo es amar a Dios! Nuestra relación con Dios y el amor que Él inspira en nuestros corazones no debe quedarse solo en la iglesia el domingo. ¡Podemos — y debemos — dejar que nuestra fe anime nuestras vidas!






VATICAN CORNER

As Israel and Hamas are considering proposals for an exchange of hostages and a ceasefire, on June 1, 2024, Pope Francis spoke to members of the Italian Christian Workers' Association at the Vatican. "Being peacemakers in the style of Jesus Christ, while necessary and valuable, can also be risky." "Interceding for peace is something that goes far beyond mere political compromise because it requires putting oneself on the line and taking a risk." Pope Francis repeated the words of Cardinal Carlo Maria Martini from 1991 at a prayer vigil for peace. The cardinal emphasized the ability to 'intercede', that is, to situate oneself between the



contending parties, putting a hand on the shoulder of both and accepting the risk that this entails. The person who builds peace is the one "who knows how to take a clear position, but at the same time strive to build bridges, to listen, and to understand the different parties involved, promoting dialogue and reconciliation." Pope Francis said that living as a Christian means "growing in familiarity with the Lord and in the spirit of the Gospel" and our actions "have the style of Christ and make him present in the world." Father Francesco Patton, the custodian of the Holy Land gave an interview in May, 2024 talking about being in the middle between warring parties. He was asked how Christians in the Holy Land experience what is happening? He said they are very conflicted. "On the one hand they feel they belong to a people, on the other hand they also feel, as Christians, that they are called to go beyond an ethnic vision. "They are caught in the middle and are being pulled on both sides." "Christians try to be women and men of peace, and in general the Christians in the Holy Land are – I dare say – the culturally most peaceful component, and therefore the one that in some way could make a contribution, in the future, to that path of reconciliation... however, they feel frustrated because, often beyond the official statements and those for political marketing purposes, by Jewish world they are considered simply Arabs and by the Arab world they are not considered sufficiently Arab. Right now, the desire to emigrate has returned. Of those living in Gaza, I believe very few will remain...even in the West Bank many are thinking of leaving... even in Galilee, because of local organized crime." Asked about reconciliation he said "Forgiveness is not an amnesty, it is not a pretending that nothing has happened. Forgiveness is taking upon oneself all the negative consequences, of suffering, of evil, that evil produces. When we think of forgiveness, we think of Christ on the cross, from the cross forgiving. To be able to forgive, I must accept the kind of suffering that allows me not to react. To the slap, as Jesus did in the hour of the Passion, I do not respond with the slap." "For Christians, reconciliation is universal, it concerns everyone, the Jewish world and the Muslim world have reconciliation, but it is mostly applied within their own communities... so the presence of Christians becomes fundamental, because it takes one beyond both the ethnic horizon and the horizon of one's own religious community. And Christians must also be willing to pay a price of suffering for this. This cannot be demanded of everyone, so I understand those who can no longer cope and leave the country, as happened in Iraq, Syria, Lebanon, because they fear for their lives or those of their families. Those who stay, know they have to pay a price: the price of being faithful to Christ and also of giving their lives, in the sense that in the end that is what happens... I know that those who choose to use violence in some way have already lost. Because Christ who died and rose... has truly conquered evil and death."



Registration Requirements:

- 1.1. If this is your child's first year, a **copy of his/her Birth, Baptism** will be required at the time of registration and **First Communion Certificates** (for Confirmation registration) will also be required. Please make sure you bring copies and NOT originals.
2. If your child has not been baptized they MUST be baptized before the classes start in September .
3. If this is your child's second year, **tuition for their first year must have been paid in full** and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.
4. Classes can fill up and applications are accepted on a first come basis for students that have completed all the requirements.
