## God in Daily Life

### Question:

How do I bring God into the work of my daily life?

### Answer:

Whatever your daily work, you have an opportunity to encounter God and to follow His commandments in love. In the New Testament, we see that most of the Apostles didn't have a previous religious position. They were fishermen, tax collectors, and political activists. St. Paul was a tentmaker. Among the saints, we have doctors, lawyers, farmers, and stay-at-home moms. No matter your daily tasks, God can be present there!

One way concerns behavior. Start with an examination of conscience. Look at areas where you tend to struggle to imitate Christ at work. Do you gossip? Does brimming frustration become impatience at home? Pick one sin you struggle with, then choose a virtue to strengthen that area. If you tend to speak poorly of your co-workers, resolve to stop and to say one kind thing a day instead.

Another way relates to perspective, particularly your perspective of others. Jesus' incarnation reminds us of the value of every human being. Jesus is God, and each of us is created in God's image. When you encounter another person, you have an opportunity to see God in a new place and a new way — in that person in front of you. Genuinely listen to them and be present to their concerns. Loving your neighbor is loving God! Our relationship with God and the love He inspires in our hearts shouldn't remain only at church on Sunday. We can — and should — let our faith animate our lives!

### Pregunta:

¿Cómo introduzco a Dios en el trabajo de mi vida diaria?

### Respuesta:

Cualquiera que sea tu trabajo diario, tienes la oportunidad de encontrarte con Dios y seguir Sus mandamientos con amor. En el Nuevo Testamento vemos que la mayoría de los Apóstoles no tenían una posición religiosa previa. Eran pescadores, recaudadores de impuestos y activistas políticos. San Pablo era un fabricante de tiendas. Entre los santos tenemos médicos, abogados, agricultores y amas de casa. No importa tus tareas diarias, ¡Dios puede estar presente allí!

Una forma se refiere al comportamiento. Comienza con un examen de conciencia. Mira las áreas en las que tiendes a tener dificultades para imitar a Cristo en el trabajo. ¿Haces chismes? ¿La frustración desbordante se convierte en impaciencia en casa? Elige un pecado con el que luchas y luego elige una virtud para fortalecer esa área. Si tiendes a hablar mal de tus compañeros de trabajo, decide detenerte y decir algo amable al día.

Otra forma se relaciona con la perspectiva, particularmente la perspectiva que tienes de los demás. La encarnación de Jesús nos recuerda el valor de cada ser humano. Jesús es Dios y cada uno de nosotros es creado a imagen de Dios. Cuando te encuentras con otra persona, tienes la oportunidad de ver a Dios en un lugar nuevo y de una manera nueva: en esa persona frente a ti. Escúchalos genuinamente y esta presente en sus inquietudes. ¡Amar al prójimo es amar a Dios! Nuestra relación con Dios y el amor que Él inspira en nuestros corazones no debe quedarse solo en la iglesia el domingo. ¡Podemos — y debemos — dejar que nuestra fe anime nuestras vidas!





## VATICAN CORNER

The Vatican's Dicastery for Culture and Education has organized an event to be held on June 14, 2024, with Pope Francis having a meeting with more than 100 prominent comedians from 15 countries, for the purpose of "establishing a link" between comedians and the Catholic Church. Approximately two-thirds of the entertainers will be from Italy; however some household names from the United States will also be there. Stephen Colbert, Jimmy Fallon, Jim Gaffigan, Whoopi Goldberg, Chris Rock, and Conan O'Brien are among those U.S. comedians taking part.

The meeting aims to "celebrate the beauty of human diversity ... and promote a message of peace, love and solidarity" and it "promises to be a moment of meaningful intercultural dialogue and sharing of joy and hope." From a past interview, Pope Francis has said that he prays daily using the words of St. Thomas More, asking the Lord to grant him a sense of humor, because a sense of humor lifts you up, makes you see the temporariness of life and take things with a spirit of a redeemed soul. It is a human attitude, but it is the closest to God's grace." He has said that the art of comedy has had a significant impact on the world of contemporary culture, and it has contributed to a more empathetic and sympathetic world. He believes that humorists, including actors, artists, cartoonists and writers have "the ability to dream up new versions of the world," and often do so "with irony, which is a wonderful virtue." A notable attendee to be at the meeting will be Roman street artist Mauro Pallotta, who has painted images of Pope Francis on many walls in Rome as superman, "Super Pope". Teacher and Philosopher Kieran Setiya writing about comedy said: "Dictators aren't defeated by laughter, but comedy consoles, educates, and creates a sense of solidarity that can destabilize the prevailing order. History has shown that in Egypt, Poland, Serbia, and Thailand there have all been successful humorous nonviolent protest actions against potentially violent regimes and so reduced people's fears and weakened those in power. According to author G. Swaminath "We are defenseless without humor. If we fail to see the irony in our circumstances, the situation may appear dispiriting. Laughter is a way of 'thumbing one's nose' at the inescapable and incomprehensible vagaries of existence and declaring, 'I choose to rise above this. I choose to meet life head on.' Laughter is freedom." Legend has it that shortly after Adam was created, he complained: 'O, Lord! You have given the lion fierce teeth and claws, and the elephant formidable tusks; you have given the deer swiftness of legs, and the turtle a protective shell; you have given the birds of flight wings, but you have left me altogether defenseless.' And the Lord said unto Adam: 'I shall give you an invisible weapon that will serve you and your children better than any weapons of fight or flight, a power that will save you even from yourself. I shall give you the sense of humor.' In an interview, Whoopi Goldberg said she offered Pope Francis a cameo role in her new comedy movie "Sister Act 3", in which she reprises her character as a singer who takes refuge in a convent and organizes a choir. 



# Faith Formation Registration: Catechism, Confirmation , RCIA & Adult Confirmation 2024-2025

### Registration Requirements:

- 1.1. If this is your child's first year, a **copy of his/her Birth, Baptism** will be required at the time of registration and **First Communion Certificates** (for Confirmation registration) will also be required. Please make sure you bring copies and NOT originals.
2. If your child has not been baptized they MUST be baptized before the classes start in September .
3. If this is your child's second year, **tuition for their first year must have been paid in full** and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.
4. Classes can fill up and applications are accepted on a first come basis for students that have completed all the requirements.
