







VATICAN CORNER Just a nine minute drive from Vatican City is the Capitoline Hill,

the smallest of the seven hills on which Rome was founded, but the most important. It was the center of religious and political power of the Ancient Roman Empire, and contained most of the important temples in the city including the temples of Jupiter Capitoline, Juno Moneta, and Minerva. Ceramics have been found at the hill dating back roughly 500 years before the founding of Rome, which is the year 753 BC according to legend. The Hill's very steep sides made it a natural fortress protecting its inhabitants from external attacks. During the middle ages (5th through 15th centuries) the Palazzo Senatorio was built atop some of the ruins there and it became the place where senators




met. Today that building still contains the government offices for Rome. During the Renaissance, Michelangelo designed one of his architectural masterpieces – the Piazza del Campidoglio to revitalized the site. On June 10, 2024, Pope Francis made a visit to that historic hill and gazed over the ancient ruins of the Roman Forum while standing shoulder to shoulder with Rome's mayor Roberto Gualtieri. Francis addressed the mayor and city administration, and reflected on how the "Rome of Caesars" transformed into the "Rome of Popes." Pope Francis praised ancient Rome as "a radiating center of civilization," with its legal developments and organizational skills, built lasting institutions and an ancient culture with "many good values, which on the other hand needed to elevate itself, to confront a greater message of fraternity, love, hope, and liberation." "The Good News, or rather the Christian faith, over time would permeate and transform the life of people and of the institutions themselves." "It would offer people a far more radical and unprecedented hope." "The shining witness of the martyrs and the dynamism of charity of the first communities of believers tapped into the need to hear new words, the words of eternal life." "Olympus was no longer enough; one had to go to Golgotha and to the empty tomb of the Risen One to find the answers to the yearning for truth, justice and love." He commented on the Roman's ingrain acceptance of slavery and how "even refined civilizations can sometimes "no longer perceived as contrary the dignity of the human being." He compared that to today's unfortunate marginalizing or discarding of certain categories of people. The Pope was there to offer a prayer for the city of Rome as it prepares for the 2025 Jubilee. The Vatican and the city are expecting an estimated 35 million people to come to the Jubilee Year of Hope, the first ordinary jubilee since the Great Jubilee of 2000. Francis noted that while the influx of pilgrims, tourists, and migrants to the city may appear to be "a burden" for local citizens, the reality is that Rome is "unique in the world" and with that has "a responsibility ... to the human family." "Rome is a city of universal spirit. This spirit wants to be at the service of charity, at the service of welcome and hospitality." From a balcony the Pope and mayor waved to a crowd gathered below. The legend of the Capitoline geese is part of Rome's history. Tradition says that around 390 BC the city on the hill had a temple

dedicated to the goddess Juno which housed a group of sacred geese. The Gauls from the north besieged Rome and tried to find a way to penetrate Capitoline Hill which was full of Romans who had taken refuge there. One night the Gauls were able to creep into the city by following the path of a messenger. The only animals in the city that had not been eaten because of the siege were the sacred geese. The geese began to squawk and warned the Romans who were then able to repel the enemy. Rome was very nearly completely captured by a foreign foe, but were saved by some frightened geese.



Faith Formation Registration: Catechism, Confirmation, RCIA & Adult Confirmation 2024-2025

June 26 and June 28—6-8 PM

Registration will be in the HALL

Registration Requirements:

- 1.1. If this is your child's first year, a <u>copy</u> of his/her Birth, Baptism will be required at the time of registration and First Communion Certificates (for Confirmation registration) will also be required. Please make sure you bring copies and NOT originals.
- 2. If your child has not been baptized they MUST be baptized before the classes start in September.
- 3. If this is your child's second year, <u>tuition for their first year must have been paid in full</u> and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.
- 4. Classes can fill up and applications are accepted on a first come basis for students that have completed all the requirements.

Tuition Fees:

1 Child in the family \$100.00 ~~ 2 Children in the family \$140.00 ~~ 3 Children or more in the family \$150.00 MUST be paid in full at the time of registration.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be NO automatic registration.

ALL students MUST register.
