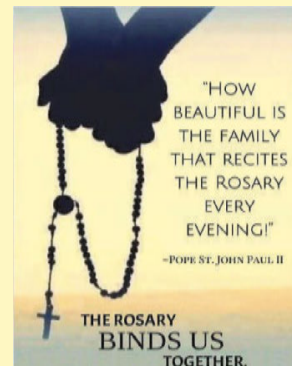

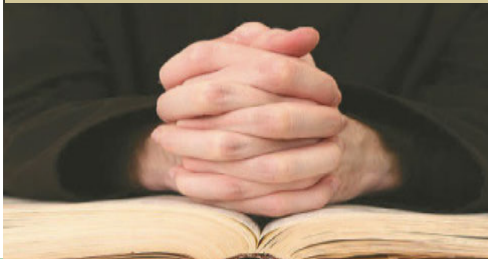

VATICAN CORNER

During World

War II Vatican City was a neutral country, nonetheless, on November 5, 1943, at about 8 PM, bombs were dropped on the Vatican. There were no casualties but what was hit were the laboratory of mosaics, Vatican Radio, the administration building, the palace where the diplomats lived and the house of the archpriest of St. Peter's Basilica. Who dropped those bombs was a mystery until 2010 when new research found the answer. From the start there was speculation that it was the Nazis who were occupying Rome, or the Allies, who had already bombed Rome, or the fascists who were allied with the Nazis in northern Italy. The Americans and the British were both initially surprised by the thought that it could have been their plane. But eventually the American thought that one of their planes had gotten lost and bombed the wrong target. The British also thought it was one of their planes until that idea was disproved. A new book by author Augusto Ferrara entitled "Bombs on the Vatican" seems to have finally answered the question. At the time of the bombing, the Allies were fighting their way up the Italian peninsula while the Italian Fascists controlled northern and central Italy. The Fascists thought that Vatican Radio "gave important information to the Allied Forces through its frequencies" using coded messages. Author Ferrara was able to uncover the story of a Fascist soldier named sergeant Parmeggiani who was ordered to fly his smaller Savoia Marchetti plane over the Vatican and throw five bombs at the Vatican Radio station, thus solving the mystery. There was later a second bombing of the Vatican on March 1, 1944, by six dropped bombs, killing one Vatican worker, and injuring a Dutch Augustinian and seriously damaging a palace, a college, and the Oratory of Saint Peter. That second incident was found to be caused by a British plane missing its target.



The first group of Allied soldiers to enter the Vatican during WWII and meet with Pope Pius XII after the liberation of Rome from the Nazis on June 4, 1944, was the 38th (Irish) Brigade belonged to the British armed forces. Ireland was neutral during WWII and that Brigade was composed of a mixture of Irish volunteers and British of Irish descent. The Brigade was already at the new frontline north of Rome when Pope Pius XII said he wanted to say thank you to the Irish regiment. Irish priests in the Vatican arranged for the meeting with the pope. Since the Brigade was in an active combat zone, only a small group of soldiers could pull back from the front lines to come to the Vatican. It was first decided that only Catholic soldiers would be present at the meeting, but after outcry by the Protestant members, a mixed group of 150 soldiers was sent. Pope Pius XII addressed the soldiers on June 12, 1944 and said "Dearly beloved sons, we bid you welcome. You belong to the nation which has ever belonged to God's church since St. Patrick. We are well aware of the good which the Irish have done in spreading the faith from shores of their green isle ... into many nations. We greet you and bless you with our heart's affection and your dear ones at home. God be with you always ..." On June 12, 2024, the 80th anniversary of the Irish Brigade's audience with the pope in the Vatican, a delegation representing the Irish Brigade attended the general papal audience in St. Peter's Square as part of the commemoration of the liberation of Rome. The delegation gave a performance with bagpipes and drums of their quick marching tune. Pope Francis was moved by the encounter with the soldiers and he posed for photos. Then unexpectedly he asked the musicians to play for him and Major General Weir the Brigade's commander said the papal meeting ranked "extremely highly" on his list of career experiences.
