The Steward's Work Is Never Done

Woe to the shepherds who mislead and scatter the flock! When you hear these strong words from the Old Testament, you're probably thinking, thank goodness I don't have any sheep — dodged that bullet. Nobody misled here! No flock scattered on my watch! However, we are all shepherds of a kind, called to tend our own sheep: our families, our parishes, our communities.

But it's exhausting. Don't we all sometimes just want to take a break from being a steward? The excuses are so familiar: we're tired, we've done enough, we've given all we can, what more does the parish (or my spouse, or my kids, or my boss, or my friends, or my community) want? We give ourselves permission to be selfish. So, what if the flock scatters just a little?

Jesus gets that. We can just imagine him weary with exhaustion, can't we? We see him on his boat, attempting to sneak away for a quick break — maybe just a chance to eat a bite of food in peace. He is God, but he was still human, after all. Even the most dedicated shepherds need to sleep. But people couldn't leave him alone. They were hungry for him. They needed what he could offer, and they needed it now.

As tough as it is, that's the example we are tasked with imitating. Everyday Stewardship demands accountability. It demands our showing up even when we are tired. It demands that we look at our lives, our time, our energies, our talents, our hearts, our bank accounts and think: where do I still have more to give?

Nos damos permiso para ser egoístas. Entonces, ¿qué pasa si el rebaño se dispersa solo un poco?

Jesús lo entiende. Podemos imaginarlo exhausto de agotamiento, ¿no es así? Lo vemos en su bote, tratando de escabullirse para un breve descanso, tal vez solo una oportunidad para comer un bocado en paz. Él es Dios, pero seguía siendo humano, después de todo. Incluso los pastores más dedicados necesitan dormir. Pero la gente no podía dejarlo en paz. Tenían hambre de él. Necesitaban lo que él podía ofrecer y lo necesitaban ahora.

Por duro que sea, ese es el ejemplo que tenemos que imitar. La corresponsabilidad diaria exige responsabilidad. Exige que nos presentemos incluso cuando estamos cansados. Exige que miremos nuestras vidas, nuestro tiempo, nuestras energías, nuestros talentos, nuestros corazones, nuestras cuentas bancarias y pensemos: ¿dónde tengo más para dar?



VATICAN CORNER

Father Marko Rupnik, 69, is a well known Jesuit artist and Catholic priest from Slovenia and he could possibly be the most influential priest-artist of the 20th century. His art work is displayed on the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary in Lourdes, France, in the Redemptoris Mater Chapel in the Vatican's Apostolic Palace, on the St. John Paul II Shrine in Washington D.C., and in or on 42 other chapels and churches in Rome, with 232 artworks worldwide. He designed the Vatican's logo for the 2022 World Meeting of Families. His art consists of unusual mosaics with bright colors, glitter and with his human figures having long-faces and big eyes. Rupnik has been

accused by about two dozen women, mostly former nuns, of sexually abusing them during the last 30 years. Rupnik has not publicly responded to the accusations. He is currently under investigation by the Vatican for the alleged sexual and psychological abuse of women religious. Pope Francis lifted the statute of limitations on the case last October, 2023 and asked the Vatican's Department of the Doctrine of the Faith to review the complaints, contact the institutions involved, and receive all the information available about the case to begin a new process. After that, two new alleged victims came forward making a public appearance. While his case is being examined, Rupnik continues in Rome exercising his priestly duties in a Slovenian diocese. In light of the "highly credible" accusations against him "from very different sources, Rupnik's Jesuit superior's ordered him to "change community" and "accept a new mission". But with his repeated refusal to do so, Rupnik's Jesuit superiors dismissed him from the Society of Jesus for not "observing the vow of obedience." Then the question arises, what is to be done with Father Rupnik's art if anything? Cardinal Seán O' Malley, the archbishop of Boston and the Pope's top adviser on clergy sexual abuse sent a letter to the Vatican department governing day-to-day affairs expressing hope that "pastoral prudence would prevent displaying artwork in a way that could imply either exoneration or a subtle defense" of those accused of abuse. "We must avoid sending a message that the Holy See is oblivious to the psychological distress that so many are suffering. Some places are considering removing Rupnik's art work. Paolo Ruffini, the head of the Vatican Department of Communication, defended using Rupnik's art, arguing that removing it wouldn't help his accusers. "I think that, as Christians, we have to understand that the closeness to the victims is important, but I don't know that this is the way of healing...there are people that are praying in sanctuaries of many churches all around the world" in front of Rupnik's mosaics. Bishop Jean-Marc Micas of Lourdes said his "personal opinion" is that "it would be better to remove these mosaics" both out of respect for the alleged victims of the former Jesuit and as a form of protection for all victims of abuse. Such a decision, however, is not yet mature, and the ongoing discussion continues to provoke controversy and heated debate. He said as a concrete step, "that these mosaics will no longer be highlighted, as they have been until now, by the light display during the Marian procession that brings pilgrims together every evening." This is a first step." On July 11, 2024 the Knights of Columbus announced that it will cover mosaics by the accused abuser Father Marko Rupnik in Washington D.C. and Connecticut. The Knights said the artwork could be permanently plastered over, after the conclusion of a Vatican penal process against the priest. "This decision is rooted in a foundational purpose of the Knights of Columbus, which is to protect families, especially women and children, and those who are vulnerable and voiceless." Author Lucia Osborne-Crowley writing about cinema artists who have been exposed as abuser said "can we simply decide that because the artist himself is a predator that we should no longer consume his art? Can we really throw the proverbial baby out with the bathwater? Is it that simple? Of course it is.
