


VATICAN CORNER Pope Francis sent a message to

Archbishop Laurent Ulrich of Paris saying that "In these troubled times, when world peace is seriously threatened", it is his "fervent desire" that everyone will respect a truce during the Olympic competition, following the tradition of the ancient world, with the hope of resolving conflicts and restoring harmony. "The Olympic Games are, by their very nature, about peace, not war" saying that the five intertwined rings represent the spirit of fraternity that should characterize the Olympic event and sporting competition in general." Francis encouraged Catholics in France to open the doors of their hearts, bearing



witness to the Christ who dwells within them and communicates his joy to them through "the gratuitousness and generosity of their welcoming everyone." Pope Francis said sports are "a universal language that transcends borders, languages, races, nationalities, and religions; it has the ability to unite people, to foster dialogue and mutual acceptance, it encourages people to surpass themselves, instills a spirit of sacrifice, promotes loyalty in interpersonal relations; it invites people to acknowledge their own limits and the value of others."

Sport – physical and competitive activities has probably existed through the entirety of human history. From the very beginning, the Church saw the value in sports, with St. Paul using sports metaphors such as "finishing the course", "discipline", "self-control", "winning", and perseverance" to explain Christian life to the Gentiles. In the medieval period, lay Catholics played games and sports on feast days and Sundays, and that play received theological support in the writing of influential theologian and philosopher Thomas Aguinas, who argued that there can be "a virtue about games" because virtue has to do with moderation. A virtuous person, by this account, should not be working all the time, but also needs time for play and recreation. The humanists of the Renaissance and the early Jesuits made use of Aquinas' understanding of virtue when they decided that students needed time for play and recreation during the course of the school day. This was the original of including play and sports in educational institutions in the Western world. In the 16th and 17th centuries many sport activities in the West disengaged from the religious and cultural contexts. The industrial revolution with its social, political, and economic changes gave sport the means to advance across the globe. Modern sport can be traced to two sources, games and competitions in English public schools in the first half of the nineteenth century which were carried to all parts of the British. The second source of sport was the exercises and gymnastics which came from an educational reform movement and developed later by Swedish educators. At the end of the 19th century Pierre de Coubertin merged the different sport traditions together and linked them to the Olympic Idea. The first modern Olympic Games took place in Athens in 1896 with Coubertin being successful in getting international participation. In 1904, Pope Pius X opened the doors of the Vatican to sport by hosting a youth gymnastics event. After the Jubilee of 2000, Saint John Paul II preached before 80,000 young athletes at the Olympic Stadium in Rome. He decided to create the Vatican Church and Sport office, bringing sport into the hierarchy of the Catholic Church. Since 2004 that office has been studying and promoting a Christian vision of sport that emphasizes its importance for the building of a more humane, peaceful and just society as well as for evangelization. In our time, sport is seem to be constantly progressing and changing but hopefully it can hold firm to its ancient principles of education and human promotion. 

Registration Requirements:

- 1.1. If this is your child's first year, a <u>copy</u> of his/her Birth, Baptism will be required at the time of registration and First Communion Certificates (for ADULT Confirmation registration) will also be required. Please make sure you bring copies and NOT originals.
- 2. If your child has not been baptized they MUST be baptized before the classes start in September .
