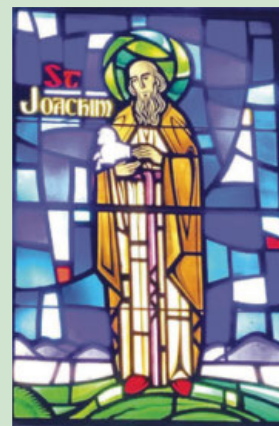

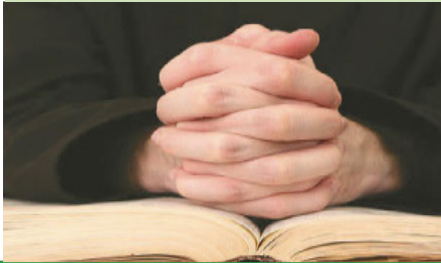

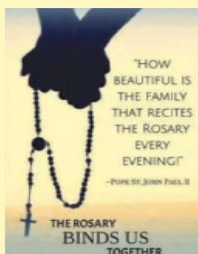
VATICAN CORNER

An acolyte minister is one who assists a member of the clergy in liturgical services by performing minor duties and is also known as an altar server. Their duties include carry the cross, the processional candles, lead the way for the priest, hold the book when the priest is not at the altar, carry the incense and censer, ring the bells during consecration, and performing other necessary assistance. There is a story where



during Mass an altar server intercepted mail a mail carrier tried to deliver to the priest. As St. John Paul II said, altar serving “Is an important task that enables you to be particularly close to the Lord and to grow in true and profound friendship with him... every time that you approach the altar, you have the good fortune to assist in God’s great loving gesture as he continues to want to give himself to each one of us, to be close to us, to help us, to give us strength to live in the right way.” Serving God as an altar server is a wonderful way for a child to grow in faith as well as in responsibility, friendship, and other virtues. On January 11, 2021, Pope Francis made an official announcement that opened altar serving to all “lay persons,” rather than just boys and men. Historically girls and women had been excluded from being altar servers, and after 1994 the decision was left to the individual bishops who could still restrict that ministry to males. But after Pope Francis’ announcement, any gender can be formally installed in that role. At the time, Kate McElween, executive director of the Women’s Ordination Conference, a Catholic feminist organization, said that the Vatican law change was “not a radical shift” but showed that Francis is willing to adapt church teaching to reflect the times and what laypeople believe. This openness, could lead to other moves toward gender equality.” The week of July 29 to August 3, 2024, 50,000 altar servers are expected to come to Rome as part of a pilgrimage organized by the International Association for altar boys and girls. The altar servers will visit Rome’s four papal Basilicas and meet with Pope Francis in a special audience in St. Peter’s Square. Approximately 35,000 servers will come from Germany, but others will be from Austria, Croatia, Hungary, Slovakia and Ukraine. Cardinal Jean-Claude Hollerich SJ. Archbishop of Luxembourg will accompany the servers throughout the week. Cardinal Hollerich said the theme of the pilgrimage is “With you” (Isa 41:10) this ‘you’ is Christ, who we are serving in the liturgy, however it also extends to the “group of friends” making the pilgrimage together. “We cannot serve Christ without serving our sisters and brothers.” He said that a particular important subject for altar servers to focus on – given that they are mostly teenagers, is bullying. He stressed that the internet has transformed bullying into “something awful.” He said altar servers “should never bully, but always be on the side of the weakest in their class or place of work.” Cardinal Hollerich said “listen to the Pope’s testimony, and be encouraged by him to live this service to the altar, this service to our sisters and brother’s throughout the world.”

- 1.1. If this is your child's first year, a **copy of his/her Birth, Baptism** will be required at the time of registration and **First Communion Certificates** (for ADULT Confirmation registration) will also be required. Please make sure you bring copies and NOT originals.
2. If your child has not been baptized they **MUST** be baptized before the classes start in September .
3. If this is your child's second year, **tuition for their first year must have been paid in full** and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.
4. Classes can fill up and applications are accepted on a first come basis for students that have completed all the requirements. YOUTH Confirmation Classes are FULL for this year.
