## VATICAN CORNER

A core belief of the Catholic faith is that demons are real, and as in the St. Michael prayer, they “prowl about the earth”. At such times when a person needs to be protected against the power of the devil or to be drawn away from him, the Church asks publicly and authoritatively in the name of Jesus Christ for this protection or liberation through the use of exorcism. It is a specific form of prayer that has been used by the Church for hundreds of years against the power of the devil. It is a precise ritual, taking about 20 or 30 minutes, and involving the reciting of certain prayers and scriptures, with the use of the crucifix and holy water. Exorcisms are extremely rare, and suspected demonic possession turns out to be only in about one in every 5000 cases, with the rest being mental or physical illness. Jesus performed a number of exorcisms in the Bible, and he involved the disciples in this work. Through the commissioning of the disciples, Jesus continued the exorcism work of the Church as part of the regular pastoral care of souls. Exorcism is considered part of the ministry of healing. It is to be celebrated only by a bishop or a priest who has obtained the special and expressed permission of the local religious head. The last



liturgical book to be revised following the Second Vatican Council of 1962-1965 was the book of Exorcisms and Certain Supplications. The English translation of that book was confirmed by the Vatican in 2016, and includes a warning not to confuse mental illness with demonic possession. It also removed several descriptions of Satan and states that the devil is a spirit without body, color and without odor. Italian journalist Fabio Marchese Ragona, a lifelong Catholic witnessed an exorcism with his “own eyes” and a priest asked him to write about what he saw and learned. Ragona’s book entitled “My Name is Satan: Stories of Exorcisms from the Vatican to Medjugorje” came out in 2020. In his book he wrote: “Many people think the devil is an invention of marketing” but he wanted to tell the stories of real possessions and exorcisms not only to underline the reality and existence of Satan, but to show that “even our neighbor” can have problems with the demonic. He tells the stories of ordinary people plus cases that went all the way to the Vatican. He writes “Even the popes have performed some exorcisms and some cardinals too.” In his book he tells the story and gives evidence that Venerable Pope Pius XII from his private chapel, attempted to exorcise Hitler using a “long distance” exorcism. This story was first reported in 2006, when Vatican documents were released. According to witnesses, Pius XII, driven by desperation to try and avert the protracted massacre against the Jews, attempted the extreme ritual of liberating the devil from Hitler remotely. However it did not work. Famed exorcist Fr. Gabriele Amorth, who was an exorcist in the Vatican for over 20 years, explains in the book that an exorcism requires physical presence with the possessed person and with their consent, so “it’s very rare that praying and attempting to carry out an exorcism from a distance works.” There is testimony in the book that St. Pope John Paul II performed at least three exorcisms. Pope Francis has never performed the Rite of Exorcism while pope, but he has prayed for the liberation of a possessed Mexican man. Francis has written that despite the fact that in Jesus’ time epilepsy could be confused with demonic possession, “this should not lead us to an oversimplification that would conclude that all the cases related in the Gospel had to do with psychological disorders and hence that the devil does not exist or is not at work.” On this subject, ninth century French poet Charles Baudelaire made his famous quote: “The finest trick of the devil is to persuade you that he does not exist.” *To be continued ...*

- 1.1. If this is your child's first year, a **copy of his/her Birth, Baptism** will be required at the time of registration and **First Communion Certificates** (for ADULT Confirmation registration) will also be required. Please make sure you bring copies and NOT originals.
2. If your child has not been baptized they MUST be baptized before the classes start in September .
3. If this is your child's second year, **tuition for their first year must have been paid in full** and copies of Birth, Baptism and First Communion (for Confirmation registration) Certificates must be already in the office before registration as a continuing student.
4. Classes can fill up and applications are accepted on a first come basis for students that have completed all the requirements. YOUTH Confirmation Classes are FULL for this year.
