VATICAN CORNER

... continued The following are some questions and answers from the Vatican's latest liturgical book

on exorcism: Are there different types of exorcisms? Minor exorcisms are a series of prayers which may be used by the faithful for those preparing for Baptism, and prayers used in the Rite of Baptism for Children and in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). The prayers are used to break the influence of evil and sin in a person's life. Major exorcism is a rite that can only be performed by a bishop, or a priest given special permission, and are directed at the expulsion of demons in the body of the possessed or to the liberation from the devil's ability to exercise dominion over that body. When and how is an afflicted member of the faithful referred to an exorcist? Every diocese should establish a protocol to respond to inquiries by the faithful who claim to be demonically afflicted. As part of the protocol, an assessment should occur to determine the true state of the person. Only after a thorough examination including medical, psychological, and psychiatric testing might the person be referred to the exorcist for a final determination. How are exorcists trained and prepared for this ministry? Traditionally the exorcist is trained through an apprenticeship model, working under the direction of an experienced exorcist. Additionally, in recent years, several training programs have been established. A solid theological and spiritual foundation is essential when preparing to minister as an exorcist, and the guidance of a skilled spiritual director is critical in the life of the exorcist. How does an exorcist determine that the one to be exorcized is truly possessed by demonic forces? The exorcist must utilize whatever resources are available to him when investigating a claim of demonic possession, along with input from medical and mental health professionals. An exorcist must establish a balance within his own mind between not believing too easily that the devil is responsible for what is manifesting, and attributing all possible manifestations solely to a natural, organic source. At a conference on exorcism in 2013, Cardinal Ernest Simoni explained that once medical reasons are ruled out, exorcisms become "tools" of a higher power, that of Jesus. Father Vincent P. Lampert, a Catholic priest for 33 years in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis is one of about 175 priests in the U.S. appointed as Catholic exorcists. An essay based on a conversation with him tells that in 2005 he followed the apprenticeship model and trained with a Franciscan priest who allowed him to sit in on 40 exorcisms over three months in Rome. Lampert said he is trained to be a skeptic, and he follows a very strict protocol. After a psychiatric evaluation and a medical examination, he asks these experts if there is something about this person's condition that cannot be explained? He sees real cases of demonic possession only one to three times a year on average. But for these rare cases he thinks the movies get it right. He says he has seen eyes roll in the back of the head, growling and snarling, foaming at the mouth, voices deepen, horrible odors, levitation, a body slither like a snake on the floor, even the tongue come out like a snake. He is now in his 18th year and he says none of this signs really phase him in the least. He says exorcism is not just about casting the devil out, that is the easy part. The harder part is to convince somebody that they need God in their life. It's really about helping people to know that the greatest thing in life that we can know are not the sins that we do, but it's God's love and mercy. God is always ready to forgive if we simply give God that opportunity.
