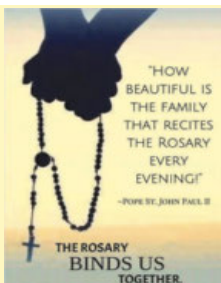
VATICAN CORNER

It is considered a great honor among Catholics in Switzerland to serve in the Pope's Swiss Guard. Young Swiss Catholic men compete for this prized job. Their minimum age is 19 and they must retire at age 30. As a prerequisite, they must go through basic training with the Swiss Armed Forces. At the Vatican they receive more training and become part of a paramilitary and police force willing to sacrifice their own lives while serving the Church and protecting the Pope.



These men come to the Vatican looking for an international adventure, experiencing the Italian language and culture, sharing comradery, honor, and service with their fellow guardsmen, becoming proficient in personal security while experiencing their faith more profoundly. Born and raised in a religious family in Fribourg, Switzerland, Didier Grandjean was motivated to become a Vatican Swiss Guard. He was trained in landscaping but at the age of 21 he completed the Swiss Army's recruitment school and went on to serve as a Swiss Guardsman at the Vatican from 2011 to 2019. During his service he "often had contact with pilgrims" and was impressed by their deep faith. He told Vatican News that the pilgrims turned out to be a catalyst for his very own "enlightenment". During his posts, he would take time to pray and reflect. In 2013, at the conclave to select a new Pope, he said he witnessed events both historically and spiritually that impressed and moved him deeply. "The contact with the two popes, Benedict XVI and Francis, was also very formative." Didier said he went through spiritual maturity and finally decided he should take the path of becoming a priest. On average, about one retiring Swiss Guard per year, who returns to Switzerland, chooses to study theology or even enter a monastery. Didier surprised his family with his decision, but the positive support he received from his loved ones spurred him towards his own religious destiny. Before he died, Didier's father told him "Go; this is your path". Didier joined the seminary in his home town of Fribourg to begin the process of becoming a priest. He said "The word 'vocation' comes from 'vocare' which means 'to call' in Latin. It is a call, something you feel inside. For me, this call developed gradually. It was not sudden illumination. I think it varies from person to person, but for me, it was a gradual process in which I realized that God was calling me to something else." Didier says in the seminary he has recognized the feeling of loneliness in being unable to marry. However, he said he has sought to find this familial feeling of love in his service to fellow believers. He expressed concern for the ever-growing "society of comfort", in which secularization is more present than ever and the importance of sacrifice and long-term commitment is fading, not only in priesthood but also in marriage. Therefore, he urges people to have courage to follow a path of faith and find joy in doing so, as "Christ will always be at your side." Didier says at the seminary he still wears "a kind of uniform, but not so colorful," he jokes.
