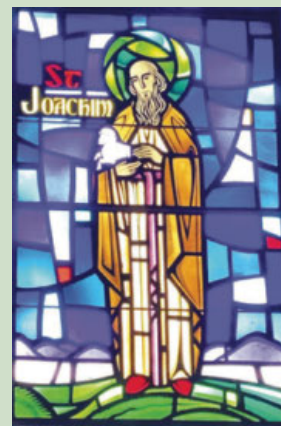

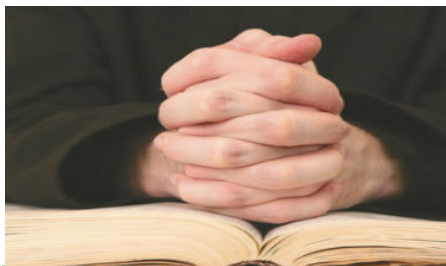

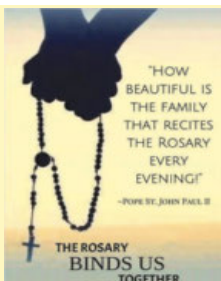

VATICAN CORNER

On Wednesday August 7, 2024, two women temporarily interrupted Pope Francis' general audience in the Paul VI Hall, with approximately 6,000 pilgrims attending. The two wore white shirts with the slogan "Stop blessing corridas (bullfights)" and they jumped from a seating area into the central walkway and shouted and waved a banner that said "la corrida e peccato" (Bullfighting is a sin). They ran down the aisle getting within meters of the Pope before security official intervened. They were activists connected to PETA (People for Ethical Treatment of Animals) and they were arrested and later released by Vatican authorities. The two women were calling for Pope Francis to take action against bullfighting



which PETA calls a "bloodbath" that celebrates animal cruelty. A news article reported that on the PETA website the two women belonged to the U.K. branch of the organization, and the article said the organization says it "is putting our faith in Pope Francis to condemn the despicable practice and cut the Catholic Church's shameful ties with the bullfighting industry". His Holiness Pope Francis wrote in his encyclical *Laudato Si'* that "every act of cruelty toward any creature is "contrary to human dignity." PETA believes bullfighting is "a stark contrast to Christ's teaching on compassion and mercy" and condemns the connection of the sport to celebrations held in honor of Catholic saints. Paragraph #2418 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church clearly states that humans should not "cause animals to suffer or die needlessly" yet Catholic priests often officiate at religious ceremonies in bullrings and minister to bullfighters in arena chapels. PETA's advertising campaign to end the sport is worldwide. Bullfighting is still legal in Ecuador, Mexico, Peru, Spain, Venezuela, France and Portugal. In April PETA protested in Spain ahead of the yearly meeting of Bullfighting Chaplains and Priests. They also protested another time when Pope Francis was attending vespers (evening prayer) at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls in Rome. The PETA article also referred to how Pope St. Pius V (in the 16th century) had condemned bull fights and those who participated in the sport because of its cruel nature, and it being contrary to "Christian piety and charity." But today that prohibition is not enforced. The Catholic Church has had a complicated relationship with bullfighting, with just a few popes condemning it. Bullfighting in Spain is intertwined with religion, with bullfighters seeking the protection of Mary and often become members of a religious brotherhood. Bullfighting takes place during festivities celebrating local patron saints. There are various forms of bullfighting with some even bloodless, involving dancing around or leaping over a cow or bull or attempting to grasp an object tied to the animal's horns. But all forms torment the animal, and most end in its death. PETA says every year, tens of thousands of bulls are slaughtered in bullfighting festivals. This year before the Easter celebration in Rome, on buses and 100 billboards around Rome, PETA posted an image of Jesus between a bull and a matador with the message: "Bullfighting is a sin. Ask your priest to condemn it". But while Catholic ethical doctrine insists upon the merciful treatment of animals, it does not place kindness towards them on the same plane of duty as benevolence towards our fellow-men.
