

VATICAN CORNER


DNA is a molecule found inside cells that carries the genetic instructions

needed for a living thing's development, function, and reproduction. It is life's blueprint, passing genetic information from generation to generation. By sequencing human DNA in the laboratory, scientist are now able to determine eye color, hair color, skin tone, height, predisposition to certain diseases, sex, facial features, and even some behavioral traits from DNA samples. In 2017, Pope Francis said that God gave humans DNA to make them his children and to create them in his image. He said "those who resemble God, whether a lot or a little, are his children and have received this identity." In 2021, Pope Francis



appointed Jennifer Doudna and Emmanuelle Charpentier the co-inventors of CRISPR genome editing technology, to the Pontifical Academy of Sciences. Their technology allows for the editing of human DNA and has pushed research into new treatments for diseases like cancer. Over the centuries, the Catholic Church has documented and approved for veneration (honoring) 107 Eucharistic miracles. Most of those miracles consist of the appearance of the flesh and blood of Crucified Christ. The Eucharistic miracle of Lanciano, Italy in the 8th century remains the most famous. A monk who doubted that the true presence of Christ in the bread and wine at Mass saw at the moment of consecration, the bread become flesh and the wine become blood. The event itself was a miracle, but 13 centuries later this double relic is still here to see and study. Doctor Franco Serafini, a cardiologist from Bologna, Italy, in 2014 became interested in Eucharistic miracles and dedicated his life to examining them. He knew that several miracles had been examined scientifically, but he was unable to find the original documentation. He decided to travel to Buenos Aires, Argentina, Tixtla, Mexico, Legnica and Sokolka, Poland and Lanciano, Italy and meet witnesses and medical doctors in recent studies of the miracles. Doctor Serafini's research became the book entitled "A Cardiologist examines Jesus." In all five Eucharistic miracles that he closely examined, Doctor Serafini found four common features. All had human blood of the same type: AB, the rarest in humans. All had heart or myocardial tissue, all had suffering myocardial tissue, and all had DNA. In Mexico and Poland there was scientifically unexplainable intertwined host and heart tissues on a microscopic level. The DNA molecules found in the Eucharistic miracles had sequences inexplicably missing, making the miraculous DNA impossible to trace or reproduce. Doctor Serafini has thought about the missing portions of the DNA sequences and has come to believe that it is better that they are missing. "The mysterious and unexplainable nature of this miraculous DNA preserves the sanctity and spiritual significance of the Eucharist, reinforcing the idea that faith should transcend scientific proof," and allows faith to flourish. Another theory about the missing DNA sections proposed by Father Robert Spitzer, PHD, head of the Magis Center (an educational organization connecting physics, philosophy, reason and faith) ,is that "Jesus didn't have a human father, and that maybe that interferes with an amplifiable DNA profile. There was no genuine male contribution and somehow God produced that contribution himself so that Jesus could be born. Apparently, how that happens is a mystery." In his book Doctor Serafini has added something else to think about: "If an Eucharistic event is true. That means that we have a biological trace that comes from the body of our Lord Jesus Christ" that is, "a biological trace in this world."
