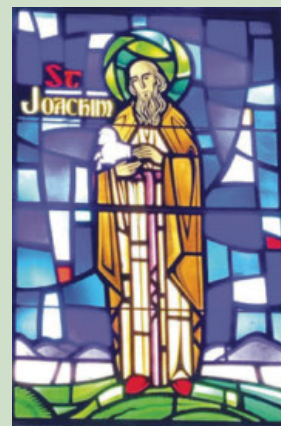

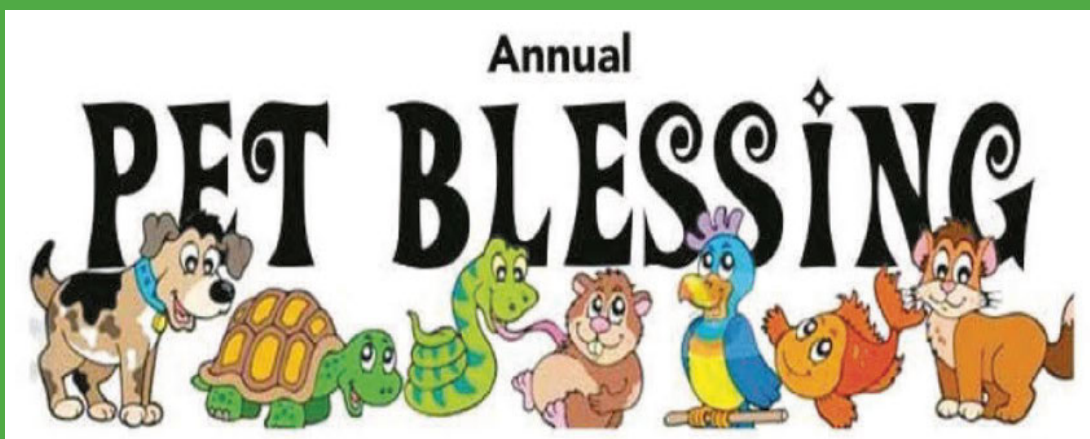

VATICAN CORNER

On September 19, 2024, 43 years after the Blessed Virgin Mary is said to have first appeared to six children known as “visionaries,” in the rural village of Medjugorje, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Pope Francis has granted approval for the faithful to show public acts of devotion at the popular pilgrimage site. Mary -“The Queen of Peace”, is the name that the “visionaries” said she called herself. However, the Pope did not declare authentic the alleged supernatural apparitions connected to the “Medjugorje phenomenon”. His “nihil obstate” judgement is one of the six possible conclusions of alleged supernatural events the Vatican now has per its new norms of discernment. It means pilgrims may continue to visit and pray at the site, but no definitive judgement is made about the supernatural phenomenon, and the faithful are not obliged to believe in it. Pope Francis stated, the spiritual phenomenon of Medjugorje has had “a long and complex history. It is a history in which bishops, theologians, commissions, and analysts have expressed a series of divergent opinion.” In 1981, the local bishop Monsignor Pavao Zanic was initially sympathetic to the young visionaries. He said the “visionaries” were six normal children and certainly not lying. However, for reasons still not entirely clear, he almost immediately changed his attitude and became the main critic and opponent of the Medjugorje apparitions. The county was a Marxist state at the time, and the six children were subject to intense questioning by doctors and psychologist. However, they showed no signs of disorders and continued to experience apparitions. Some of the original “visionaries” now as adults claim the visions have continued to occurred regularly since 1981, and even daily, and that Mary is still sending them messages. As children, the apparitions would come to the “visionaries” in a simple way. The children would recite the Rosary along with the crowd who gathered with them. They would kneel down simultaneously, look upward in the same direction, and have hopeful, tranquil expressions. Their lips moved but made no sound. Their glances converged at a point very close to them. The apparitions lasted from one to three minutes, then their voices would return and coming out of their ecstatic trance, they would report the things the Virgin Mary said. Experiments on the children while in ecstasy such as squeezing their arm or lifting the smallest child brought no change in their expression. Studies conducted by a medical team determined that the children were not dreaming, nor sleeping with open eyes, or in epileptic or cataleptic states. Fifteen years later, the “visionaries” were found still to be simple, healthy, and joyous people without neurotic symptoms and not affected by temptations and pressures from their world fame. Unfortunately Catholics disagreed on the “visionaries” authenticity. Some claimed the children were being manipulated by revivalist, or nuns, or by the Franciscan, or by the devil. Also some of Mary’s “message” as repeated by the “visionaries” seem to contradict Church teaching, or contain theological inaccuracy, or confused human experiences, or of interests that are not entirely legitimate. Also in some cases, Our Lady seems to show some irritation because some of her instructions were not being followed. Pope Francis acknowledges the many “positive fruits” that have resulted from the spiritual experience from Medjugorje, which have inspired people throughout the world. More than 50 million people have come to visit or pray at the site, and whether with true spiritual intent or out of curiosity, they have gone back home better for the visit. There have been many reports of unexpected conversions and returns to the faith and returns to the sacraments particularly, the Eucharist and Reconciliation. Miraculous healings as well as numerous vocations have been reported. An international Catholic youth festival is now held there annually. Religious radio and television programs have sprung up, and well as prayer groups and religious movements. Cardinal Victor Manuel Fernández, the head of the Vatican’s Dept. of the Doctrine of Faith said that people who go to Medjugorje should “be strongly advised that pilgrimages are not made to meet with alleged visionaries, but to have an encounter with Mary, the Queen of Peace, and ...to encounter Christ and listen to him through meditation on the Word, by participation in the Eucharist, and in Eucharistic Adoration.” Sources: *americanmagazine, vaticannews.va, apnew.com, ewtn.com*





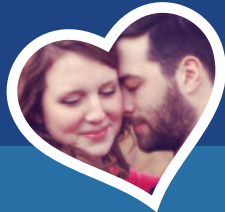
