## Giving as God does

Ask yourself this question — what would you pray for if you really believed God could and would do anything for you? In my experience, we all have something. We all have that miracle we're afraid to request, afraid we will be disappointed.

Do we doubt God's readiness to give because we ourselves have such an imperfect understanding of charity and love? Maybe if we had better faith in God we would be more ready to give of ourselves — and maybe if we were more ready to give of ourselves, we would understand more clearly the ways of God.

Because we're not really afraid that God can't do something. We know He can do anything. What we're afraid of is that He will do what He always does: give us what we need, not what we want.

Have you ever had a friend in need and you just wanted to give them something — a meal, a phone call, a text? Not because you knew it would help, but simply because you wanted to reach out. And have they ever said to you: It wasn't so much what you gave, but the fact that you did. You gave them what they needed even if it wasn't what they specifically asked for.

When we give in this manner, we are giving as God does. Sometimes we are afraid to ask because we don't want to be disappointed. But remember, the blind man on the road got what he asked for, but he would have gotten what he needed even if his answer had been the opposite. God's generosity is always reckless, and it's always perfect.

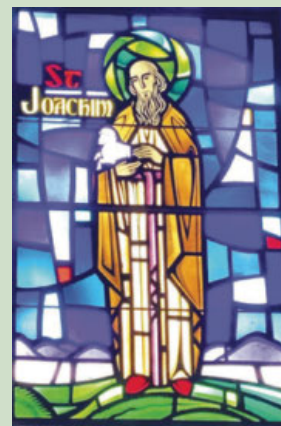

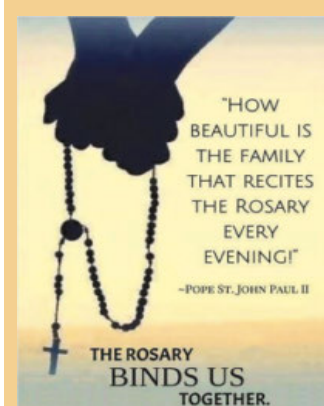
## VATICAN CORNER

José Manuel de Urquidi from Dallas, Texas, a former financial lawyer and restaurateur, who became a digital missionary in order to “answer the call of Christ,” was one of the Vatican’s participants at the October, 2024 Synod. He shared with the other members of the Synod his experiences as a digital evangelist and creator of Catholic content for the U.S. and Latin America. José and his wife Ana Cecilia decided to take their daughter to Rome to celebrate her birthday. Their two younger sons remained at home with their grandmother. Inés’ 10th birthday wish was to see the Vatican Hall where her father has been working at the Synod. On Thursday morning José Manuel was able to take his wife and birthday girl to the Synod Hall to let them see what was going on. At a coffee break,



when Inés entered the room, Pope Francis started off a chorus for the birthday girl. Mario Grech, the Secretary General of the Synod announced to the assembly “This week we have often highlighted the importance of family, and today we celebrate because one of our members, José Manuel de Urquidi, is here with his wife and daughter, whose 10th birthday is today. Come here and meet the Holy Father.” The three family members came up to Pope Francis and he said “What a beautiful family, I am so happy to see you.” He shook hands with them and said to Inés, “Thank you for lending your daddy to the Church.” Then Francis gave Inés a wooden box of alfajores (traditional Argentine cookies stuffed with dulce de leche (one of Francis’ favorite treats from his native Argentina) and joked “Eat them together, not all by yourself or else you’ll fill your belly.” Inés had letters and drawings from her classmate at All Saints Catholic School in the Dallas Diocese that she gave Pope Francis. Some of the messages from the school were particularly cute, with one child writing: “You work very hard and are a fantastic Pope.” Another asked the Pope: “Do you like being a Pope?” Francis smiled at the gifts and gave his blessing to the family. A large number of the other Synod participants came up to Inés also wishing her a happy birthday. The gathering is called the Synod of Bishops, but actually 26% of the 368 voting members are non-bishops and there are 96 delegates with several being parents of young children. Some of those parent participants have been juggling time-zone differences, missed birthdays and unexpected homework calls as they help plan a future for the Church. Parents at the Synod have acknowledged the difficulties of being away from home for a month – but they knew what they were getting into when they agreed to come. The inclusion of parents and other non-bishops as voting members has made some ask whether the Synod should even be called a Synod of Bishops and to question the weight of its forthcoming final document. Whatever the legal status of the current assembly, the parents who accepted Pope Francis’s invitation to come to the Synod are bringing their parental perspective to the proceedings.

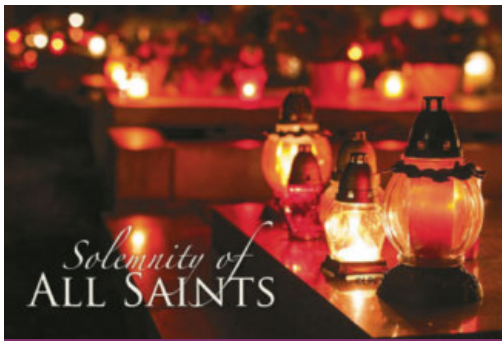

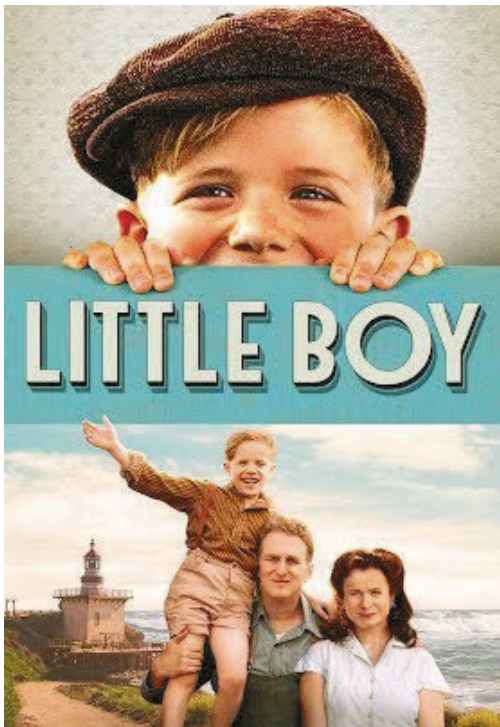

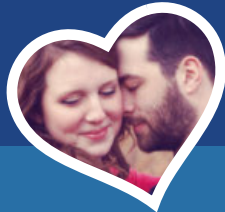
