




VATICAN CORNER

On October 27, 2024, the 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops ended with a closing Mass in St. Peter's Basilica. The work of the 400 international Bishops and delegates from this second session on the Synod on Synodality, produced a 51 page Final Document, which



was the culmination of Pope Francis' initiated three years of discussions about the future of the Catholic Church. The report came after the tens of thousands of listening sessions, the continental assemblies and two major meetings in Rome. Usually such a report would receive a papal exhortation, which is his own reflection and conclusion. However, Francis declared "What we have approved in the document is enough" and he was not writing an additional exhortation. He said the document already contains "highly concrete indications" to guide the Church's mission. He hoped the document would be a "gift to the people of God". The report outlined the Church's challenges and proposed ways for all the baptized to be involved in planning the path forward. However it has been said that the implementation and enforcement of the recommended changes are not clearly spelled out. The recommended changes include overhauling training for future priests, greater lay involvement in selecting bishops, expansion of women's ministries and a revision to church law to require greater transparency and accountability throughout the Church. The report did not propose certain dramatic changes which many reform groups sought during the three years of discussions. Such changes as restoration of the female diaconate, or greater recognition of LGBTQ Catholics, were not in the final report. However, the possibility of such dramatic changes were not dismissed either, but instead remained open for continued discussions. Each of the 151 paragraphs of the final report were voted on by the Synod's voting members, and each paragraph had to receive a 2/3 approval vote to be included in the report. The section on women deacons received the most no votes. The Synod called for a "significant presence of women" in Catholic seminaries. The Synod said that despite a centuries-long practice of accountability to one's superiors in church life, Church authorities being held accountable to the community is "in need of restoration." The Synod recommended the "establishment everywhere" of finance councils, involvement of laity in pastoral and financial planning, preparation of an audited annual report for both financial matters and safeguarding policies and performance evaluations of all ministers and ministries. The Synod said that more study is needed to determine what matters of doctrinal authority should be reserved to the pope and what matters can be decided or enacted by episcopal conferences. Another Synod proposal was to have more formation and training for those working with minors and vulnerable adults to improve the Church's safeguarding efforts. At the final Mass for the Synod, Pope Francis said "A sedentary church, that inadvertently withdraws from life and confines itself to the margins of reality, is a church that risks remaining blind and becoming comfortable with its own unease." "If we remain stuck in our blindness, we will continuously fail to grasp urgency of giving a pastoral response to the many problems of our world." It is now time for the Church to "get its hands dirty" and "carry the joy of the Gospel through the streets of the world." Sources:ncronline.org,, catholicnewagency.com


