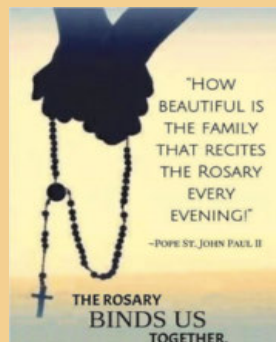

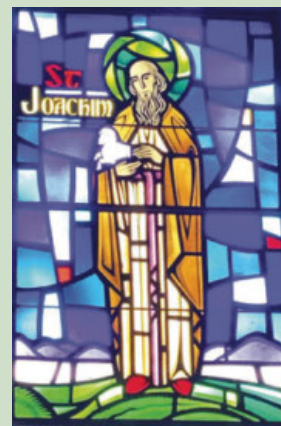

## VATICAN CORNER

Last month, the Pope named 21 new cardinals. Among the group were two Divine Word Missionaries—Archbishop Ladislav Némét, SVD of Belgrade and Archbishop Isao Tarcisio Kikuchi, SVD of Tokyo. They are the first Divine Word Missionaries to be named cardinals in nearly 80 years. The previous Divine Word Missionary cardinal, Thomas Cardinal Tien Ken-sin, SVD of Beijing, was appointed to the cardinalate in 1946 and served until his death in 1967. He was the Catholic Church's first cardinal of Asian descent. He was expelled from China by the Communist regime in 1951. Cardinal Tien participated in the conclave of 1958, which elected St. Pope John XXIII. On December 16, 1959 he was appointed by Pope John XXIII as the Apostolic Administrator of Taipei, Taiwan. Cardinal Tien served as Chairman of the Board of Trustees at Fu Jen Catholic University, Taipei, Taiwan from 1960 to 1967 (run by the Divine Word Missionaries). From 1962-1965, he attended the Second Vatican Council and in 1963, he participated in the conclave which elected Pope Paul VI. Archbishop Kikuchi and Archbishop Némét are the second and third cardinals from the Society of the Divine Word in the congregation's 150-year history. Archbishop Némét was installed as leader of the Archdiocese of Belgrade in Serbia in 2022. Before that, he was the bishop of Zrenjanin, also in Serbia. As a Divine Word Missionary, he served in the Philippines, Poland, Austria and Croatia prior to his work in Serbia. He was born in Yugoslavia.

Archbishop Kikuchi was installed as the leader of the Archdiocese of Tokyo in 2017. Before that, he was the bishop of Niigata, Japan. As a Divine Word Missionary, he served in Ghana prior to his work in Japan, his home country. He is currently president of Caritas Internationalis, the umbrella organization for the Catholic Church's global charity initiatives.

The two Divine Word Missionaries will become cardinals during a Vatican consistory on Dec. 8, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. Please join us in congratulating our two new cardinals and pray for them as they take on their important new roles in the leadership of the Catholic Church.

El mes pasado, el Papa nombró 21 nuevos cardenales. Entre el grupo había dos Misioneros del Verbo Divino: el Arzobispo Ladislav Némét, SVD de Belgrado y el Arzobispo Isao Tarcisio Kikuchi, SVD de Tokio. Son los primeros Misioneros del Verbo Divino en ser nombrados cardenales en

casi 80 años. El anterior cardenal Misionero del Verbo Divino, el Cardenal Thomas Tien Ken-sin, SVD de Beijing, fue nombrado cardenalato en 1946 y sirvió hasta su muerte en 1967. Fue el primer cardenal de ascendencia asiática de la Iglesia Católica. Fue expulsado de China por el régimen comunista en 1951. El cardenal Tien participó en el cónclave de 1958, que eligió a San Papa Juan XXIII. El 16 de diciembre de 1959 fue designado por el Papa Juan XXIII Administrador Apostólico de Taipei, Taiwán. El cardenal Tien se desempeñó como presidente de la junta directiva de la Universidad Católica Fu Jen, Taipei, Taiwán, de 1960 a 1967 (dirigida por los Misioneros del Verbo Divino). De 1962 a 1965 asistió al Concilio Vaticano II y en 1963 participó en el cónclave que eligió al Papa Pablo VI.

El arzobispo Kikuchi y el arzobispo Némét son el segundo y tercer cardenal de la Sociedad del Verbo Divino en los 150 años de historia de la congregación. El arzobispo Némét fue instalado como líder de la Arquidiócesis de Belgrado en Serbia en 2022. Antes de eso, fue obispo de Zrenjanin, también en Serbia. Como Misionero del Verbo Divino, sirvió en Filipinas, Polonia, Austria y Croacia antes de trabajar en Serbia. Nació en Yugoslavia.

El arzobispo Kikuchi fue instalado como líder de la Arquidiócesis de Tokio en 2017. Antes de eso, fue obispo de Niigata, Japón. Como Misionero del Verbo Divino, sirvió en Ghana antes de trabajar en Japón, su país de origen. Actualmente es presidente de Caritas Internacionales, la organización que agrupa las iniciativas caritativas globales de la Iglesia Católica.

Los dos Misioneros del Verbo Divino se convertirán en cardenales durante un consistorio en el Vaticano el 8 de diciembre, Fiesta de la Inmaculada Concepción. Únase a nosotros para felicitar a nuestros dos nuevos cardenales y oremos por ellos mientras asumen sus nuevos e importantes roles en el liderazgo de la Iglesia Católica.
