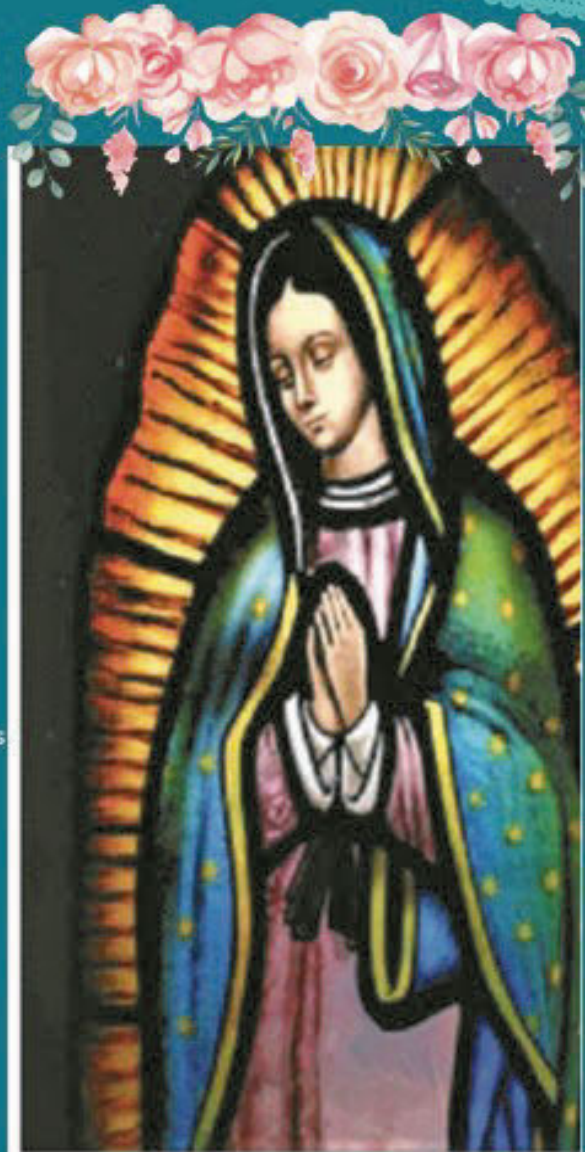

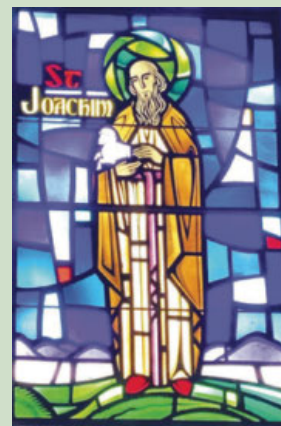

On November 9, 2024, Tens of



thousands of Germans celebrated the 35th anniversary of the fall of the Berlin Wall. It was a large 96 mile long concrete wall and wire fence barrier that encircled West Berlin from 1961 to 1989. It had guard towers, armed soldiers, antivehicle trenches, minefields, and barbed wire. After World War II in Europe, the county of Germany was divided up between the four occupying powers: the United State, the United Kingdom, France and the Soviet Union. Berlin,

the German capital was also similarly divided up, even though it was completely within the Soviet section of Germany. In 1961 the Soviet Union controlled regime of communist East Germany constructed the Berlin Wall in order to prevent the flow of East German citizens from fleeing to the West. The constructed wall stopped free movement within Berlin and split many families, cut off people from their jobs and isolated West Berlin in a hostile land. The wall came to physically symbolize communist tyranny, and symbolize the “Iron Curtain” that separated the Western block countries, which united under NATO, from the Eastern satellite states that later formed the Warsaw Pact. Over 100,000 people attempted to escape over the wall and suffered heavy penalties as a result. Over 5,000 succeeded in escaping, while it is estimated that between 100 and 200 were murdered by East German authorities when trying to escape. Saint John Paul II played a crucial role in bringing about the peaceful revolution that transformed Europe, brought about the reunification of Germany and the fall of the Berlin Wall. In 1979 with less than a year as Pope, John Paul II returned to his home country of Poland which was then under communist rule and under great religious oppression. More than a third of the entire population of Poland came to see him, the first Polish pope. He proclaimed not only religious hope but also patriotic and political hope to the enthusiastic crowds. He said “that there can be no just Europe without the independence of Poland marked on its map!” He also said “at any longitude and latitude of geography, the exclusion of Christ from the history of man is an act against man.” The crowd sang “We want God.” John Paul II continued to encourage the Polish Catholic Church and the labor union from Rome. He survived an assassination attempt on his life in 1981 – widely believed to have been orchestrated by Soviet – bloc security services. He decided to consecrate the Soviet Union to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, fulfilling a request made by Our Lady at Fátima. The Polish trade union Solidarity was born, and it soon spanned the country, representing millions of Poles, and became a center for the nation’s anticommunist resistance. Under a banner frequently with John Paul’s face, the union members battled for the right to organize, liberalize and democratize. Within a decade, despite a brutal crackdown, the union succeeded in its goals, Poland held its first semi-free parliamentary elections. One Soviet bloc country after another followed, culminating in the formal dissolution of the USSR. The Berlin Wall was knocked down by the Germans. Cardinal Stanislaw Dziwisz, who served as John Paul II’s personal secretary for decades explained: “From the moment of that consecration of the USSR to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, a process began that culminated in freedom for nations oppressed by communism and Marxism. Our Lady had both requested this consecration and promised that freedom would follow.” “After this event, the world became different. Not only did the Iron Curtain fall, but also Marxism in the world, which was especially rooted in universities and circles worldwide.” Cardinal Joachim Meisner of Cologne, a close friend of John Paul II had said in a 2017 interview that “John Paul II’s contribution to communism’s collapse cannot be overestimated.” Surprisingly, Mikhail Gorbachev, the last leader of the Soviet Union made a similar observation. He said that without John Paul II’s influence, the peaceful revolution of 1989 might never have occurred. *.Sources: Wikipedia.org,, catholicnewsagency.com ,*

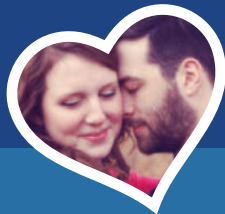
