



VATICAN CORNER The Vatican Christmas

tree this year is a

towering 29-meter (95 feet) tall red pine donated to the Vatican by the small mountain town of Ledro in the province of Trentino in northern Italy. The tree lighting will take place in St. Peter's Square on December 7, 2024, and will remain there through January 12, 2025, the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. This tree was chosen not only for its beauty but for it being part of a sustainable working forest that follows strict forest management practices. Those practices include thinning out towering older trees to open up the canopy and facilitate the growth of multiple younger trees below. In addition to the main tree, Ledro and its surrounding community also donated smaller trees to the Vatican and decorated some as well as did other



towns in Italy, Germany, and the Czech Republic. The smaller trees will adorn various Vatican buildings and offices. A local Italian wildlife protection group named Bears-and-Others has caused a controversy about the donated trees by posting an online petition in mid-October protesting the chopping down of the trees and arguing that it contradicts Pope Francis' promotion of protection for the environment. The protest gathering 53,000 signatures, and it's open letter to Pope Francis, to the Vatican, and to local Italian officials complained that the cutting live trees is a "solely consumerist practice ... for ephemeral (fleeting) use, for mere advertising purposes, and for "a few ridiculous selfies." The letter also argued that the Christmas tree is a pagan tradition that has nothing to do with Christ's birth. The petition also opposed the estimated 60,000 euros (\$63,000 +/-) spent by the town of Ledro on cutting and transporting the donated trees to Rome. The petition said the money should have been spent on something for the "common good" like offering shelter to someone living on the street. The petition said "We are asking your help to send a strong message of reflection on the importance of valuing and respecting the role of the plant world in the anthropocentric era (humankind most important as opposed to God or animals) of increasingly dramatic climate anomalies." The Vatican responded in a press release saying the trees chosen are more mature trees, arguing that their removal is in line with natural replacement. The Vatican Christmas tree is a tradition that started with St. John Paul II in 1982. The mayor Renato Girardi of Ledro responded to the controversy by saying "The trees that get cut here in Trentino area are all this same dimension and age (60 years) as the tall red pine going to Rome. "If this (tree) here doesn't go to St. Peter's, it will end up as boards or to make wooden pallets." He said the town had offered to donate the tree back in 2015, and just this year a gardener from the Vatican visited to look at about 10 trees that were destined for cutting. He said the tree in question was chosen because it did not have a big canopy and so its branches were thinner, making its transportation easier. The petition implied that the 39 other donated trees were old trees also being cut from the forest, but mayor Girardi said those trees are smaller, younger trees grown on a tree farm elsewhere because the Vatican wanted a different kind of evergreen that did not shed its needles. He said his town follows the same strict timber harvesting laws in effect for the entire province of Trento. "Our program calls for 3 cubic tons of new growth each year and we cut 2 cubic tons a year, which is part of our local economy. Trees have always been cut, it's part of harvesting a forest." After January 12, the tall red pine will be shipped back to Ledro where the town will hold a wood-sculpting contest. Professional sculptors will carve the tree based on the winning design, and it will be permanently displayed in the town.
