






## VATICAN CORNER Traditionally

Traditionally every year

the pope invites an Italian town to create a nativity scene (or crèche) typical of its region to be displayed in Saint Peter's Square. For Christmas 2024, that town is Grado, a small island and adjacent peninsula, between Venice and Trieste in the northern Adriatic Sea. Knight officer Mr. Antonio Boemo of Grado had the original idea for a nativity scene featuring the lagoon of Grado. His proposal to the Vatican in 2016 was accepted, and he became the coordinator and leader of the project, while Mr. Andrea de Walderstein



became the architect, designer and construction manager. The ambitious display turned out to be nearly 100 feet long, over 45 feet wide, and is the first time that a Vatican nativity scene featured a large body of water. The perimeter is formed with 102 Styrofoam bricks with a liner inside forming the lagoon. The Nativity scene depicts the first years of the last century where fishermen used to live in reed huts called "casone" on the islands, and the traditional figures of Mary, Joseph and the child Jesus are inside one of the huts. There is a beach, islands, traditional flat-bottom boats, fishing nets, wise men arriving, animals, birds and statues of the people of the town. Mr. Boemo said "What we are interested in is that people will admire, become curious, and understand the feelings that we have when we go to the lagoon. The project tries to captures the essence of the town's heritage. He said the project to create this Nativity involved the whole community of Grado, with 40 volunteers being physically involved in its construction and approximately 500 people from the town are expected to attend the unveiling. The funding for the purchase of material came from the Friuli Venezia Giulia Region and the Municipality of Grado along with the Diocese of Gorizia and Grado's archpriestly parish. A big concern that the Vatican had with a large body of water brought to St. Peter's Square was the attraction it would have to Rome's seagulls, turning it into a giant birdbath. The solution found was a system of ultrasonic machines to keep the gulls away. Architect de Walderstein said after being originally brought on just to design the project, he got



involved also with the building of it with his own hands. He said he was really happy with this adventure. On Saturday December 7, Pope Francis will attend the traditional inauguration of the Nativity and illumination of the Christmas tree in Saint Peter's Square. As this article goes to print they are still working on completing this and the picture reflects the work in progress. —

# Simbang Gabi: Our "Aguinaldo" to God

**S**imbang Gabi is one of the traditions of the Filipinos in preparation for Christmas. It starts on the 16th of December to the 24th. Simbang Gabi is a novena of masses commonly held before sunrise and for pastoral reasons, may also be celebrated at night.

The "Aguinaldo Masses" were recognized by Pope Sixtus the V in the 16th century when he granted a plenary indulgence to those who participated in it. "Aguinaldo" is a Spanish word which means "Christmas gift". The Catholic faithful offer to God nine (9) Masses as a gift on the occasion of the Birth of Jesus Christ as the whole Church rejoices at receiving from God, the gift of His Son.

Filipinos around the world especially here in the United States brought this religious tradition into their parishes as their "Aguinaldo" or "religious gift" to their new community. At present, Simbang Gabi is considered one of the most common celebrations during Advent and is participated in by different cultural and generational groups in the parishes.

Here at St. Joachim Church, Simbang Gabi has been celebrated for 24 years now and counting. We gather for mass as one community of faith every 5:30 in the morning from December 16th to the 24th and continue our celebration in the gymnasium with a breakfast reception.

**W**e also keep the tradition of offering our special "Aguinaldo" or "gift" to God for all the graces our families have received throughout the year or for a special petition. This "Aguinaldo" comes in the form of sacrifices for waking up in the morning and participating in the masses or monetary offerings by being a Hermano/Hermana or Mass Sponsors. The money collected will be used to sustain the different ministries in our church and the upkeep of our facilities.

As part of our projects this year, we are so excited to host the Loboc Children's Choir from Bohol, Philippines. In cooperation with the Bohol Circle, Inc., we will present this world-renowned children's choir with their angelic voices as they tour the whole United States. They are scheduled to perform at St. Joachim Gym on January 10, 2025 at 7PM. We look forward to see you in the concert. Tickets will be available soon.

The Filipino-American Ministry of St. Joachim Church is the lead organization of the Simbang Gabi celebration. We encourage each family in our parish to be a sponsor (Hermano/Hermana) of a Mass as our "gift/present" to God for all the blessings we have received from his bounty: our life, our health and our family. May we all come together and have a meaningful celebration of Simbang Gabi and Christmas Season this year.


